Yesterday's Game: The River Cats dropped the second game of this four-game series by the final score of 7-2. LHP **Matt Gage** allowed five runs (four of them earned), in five innings pitched and struck out three batters. Sacramento was held scoreless until the seventh inning when OF **Austin Slater** ripped his 20th double of the season and was brought home on an RBI triple from INF **Ryder Jones**. The River Cats did rack up nine hits on the night, but the early scoring by Colorado Springs was too much to overcome and Sacramento eventually fell 7-2.

Today's Starter: LHP **Daniel Camarena** has been quite a find for the Giants' organization through three outings, allowing just one earned run through 17.2 innings pitched for the River Cats, including 16 consecutive without a run — a streak which is still active. He'll make his fourth start with the club Sunday afternoon, which will be his first time pitching in a day game. Camarena joined Sacramento on May 24 after he was released by the New York Yankees.

Twenty Two-Baggers: OF **Austin Slater** continues to hit well this season and extra base hits have come easy for him. Slater has now hit 20 doubles this season and maintains his solid position of second in the Pacific Coast League in that category. Slater is also first in the PCL in on-base percentage (.447) and third in OPS (1.037).

Stolen Bases: Coming into this series, the Sky Sox and River Cats were ranked first and second in the PCL in stolen bases. Colorado Springs is far in front with 83 this season and the River Cats at 54. In the first two games of this series, the Sky Sox have not even made an attempt to steal a base and the River Cats have made one attempt and were caught stealing in last night's game.

Roster Moves: C **Trevor Brown** and LHP **Jordan Schafer** were released by the River Cats yesterday as Gage and INF **Josh Rutledge** were activated from the Disabled List. In seven appearances, Schafer was 0-1 with a 0.00 road ERA and a 5.68 ERA overall. In nine games played, Brown had a .222 batting average with six hits and three RBI.

This Day in River Cats History: June 10, 2012: The Sacramento River Cats tallied 10 hits, 10 walks, and five stolen bases in a 8-2 rout of the Colorado Springs Sky Sox. DH **Manny Ramirez** went 1-for-4 with three RBI while INF **Grant Green** had himself a game as well, going 3-for-4 with three runs scored and a RBI. On the mound, RHP **Graham Godfrey** went eight innings and allowed one earned run on two hits while walking one and striking out a pair. The win brought Sacramento's record on the year to 41-23.

ADVANCED HITTING STATS GLOSSARY*

PA: Plate Appearances

Plate Appearances are the total number of times a hitter completes a turn batting.

OPS: On-Base Plus Slugging

On-base Plus Slugging (OPS) is the sum of a player's on-base percentage (how often a player reaches base safely) and their slugging percentage (how many bases a player reaches per at bat).

ISO: Isolated Power

Isolated Power (ISO) is a measure of a hitter's raw power. Or, to look at it another way, it measures how good a player is at hitting for extra bases. The simplest way to calculate ISO is to subtract a player's Batting Average from their Slugging Percentage, which leaves us with a measure of just a player's extra bases per at bat.

BABIP: Batting Average on Balls In Play

Batting Average on Balls In Play (BABIP) measures how many of a batter's balls in play go for hits. Affected greatly by defense and luck, BABIP can dramatically affect a hitter's batting average. If a large number of a batter's balls in play go for hits, that can boost their batting average quite high. Similarly, if a large number of balls in play get caught, it can reduce a player's total offensive value.

wRC+: Weighted Runs Created Plus

Weighted Runs Created Plus measures the total number of runs a player contributes to their team. The formula accounts for a player's ability to get on base, their total number of bases, and their baserunning. The Plus version of the stat is park and league adjusted.

wOBA: Weighted On-Base Average

Weighted On-Base Average combines all the different aspects of hitting into one metric, weighting each of them in proportion to their actual run value. While batting average, on-base percentage, and slugging percentage fall short in accuracy and scope, wOBA measures and captures offensive value more accurately and comprehensively. (Due to no constant in minor league baseball, the wOBA statistic is approximate).

K% & BB%: Strikeout Rate and Walk Rate

Strikeout rate (K%) and walk rate (BB%) measure how often a position player walks or strikes out per plate appearance. They're measured in percentage form, so it's easy to compare between players and years.

ADVANCED PITCHING STATS GLOSSARY*

TBF: Total Batters Faced

Total Batters Faced measures the total number of plate appearances hitters have made against him.

AVG: Batting Average

Batting average is the rate of hits per at bat, calculated as hits/at bats.

BABIP: Batting Average on Balls In Play

Batting Average on Balls In Play (BABIP) measures how often a ball in play goes for a hit. Typically around 30% of all balls in play fall for hits, but there are several variables that can affect BABIP rates for individual players, such as defense, luck, and talent level. Hitters have more control over their BABIP than pitchers do.

LOB%: Left On Base Percentage

Left on Base Percentage (LOB%) measures the percentage of base runners that a pitcher strands on base over the course of a season. This stat does not use the left on base numbers reported in box scores, but instead is calculated using a pitcher's actual hits, walks, and runs allowed results.

FIP: Fielding Independent Pitching

Fielding Independent Pitching (FIP) measures what a player's ERA should have looked like over a given time period, assuming that performance on balls in play and timing were league average. (Due to no constant in minor league baseball, the FIP statistic is approximate).

K% & BB%: Strikeout Rate and Walk Rate

Strikeout rate (K%) and walk rate (BB%) measure how often a pitcher walks or strikes out a player per plate appearance. They're measured in percentage form, so it's easy to compare between players and years.

xFIP: Expected Fielding Independent Pitching

Same as FIP, but it normalizes a pitcher's home runs allowed based on their fly ball rate rather than simply using the raw number of home runs allowed.
