Yesterday's Game: The River Cats simply had no answers for the Fresno Grizzlies in last night's series and season finale with the Grizzlies. Sacramento RHP Tyler Herb got into some trouble early, allowing nine runs on 12 hits in four innings pitched. Already leading 9-1, Fresno put up six more runs in the eighth inning to eventually go on and win by the final score of 15-1. The River Cats' lone run came when INF Brock Stassi laced an RBI double to right-center field in the second inning. Stassi would go 2-for-3 on the night with a walk for his sixth multi-hit game for the River Cats.

Today's Starter: RHP Shaun Anderson (1-2, 4.33) toes the rubber for his seventh start with the River Cats. Anderson has been slightly sporadic in his starts in Triple-A after striking out a season-high seven batters on August 12, but just two in his last start on August 17. He has also had more success on the road where he earned his first win and boasts a 3.75 ERA. That seven-strikeout outing did come in Anderson's last home start so look for him to bring more K's at Raley Field.

Stassi Making a Splash: Sacramento area native Brock Stassi continues to rake since joining the River Cats. Stassi posted his sixth multi-hit performance last night with two hits including an RBI double to put Sacramento on the board. He also has six doubles to go along with a whopping .485 batting average in just eleven games played for the River Cats.

Return of the Black: RHP Ray Black returned to Sacramento after a stint with the Giants. The flamethrower reliever posted a scoreless ninth inning with one strikeout in his first appearance with the River Cats since July 5. Black appeared in 16 games, striking out 22 batters for San Francisco before being optioned back to Sacramento.

A Whole Lot of Runs: In last night's 15-1 defeat, the River Cats tied season highs for runs allowed (15) and hits allowed (19) in a game this season. Sacramento last allowed 15 runs on April 15 against the Tacoma Rainiers and 19 hits on June 24 against the El Paso Chihuahuas. 14 runs was also the River Cats' largest margin of defeat this season after their previous was 10 runs in a 12-2 loss to Albuquerque on May 25.

This Day in River Cats History: August 24, 2010: On the back of a three-run home run by OF Dallas McPherson, the River Cats topped the Salt Lake Bees 7-4 in Salt Lake...Sacramento beat current San Francisco Giants pitcher Ryan Vogelsong, who threw six innings for the Bees, allowing six runs (three earned) on five hits and four walks with three strikeouts...for McPherson, the home run was his 21st of the season and his seventh in his last 10 games...LHP John Halama picked up the win, his fifth, throwing four innings of relief, allowing one run on five hits while striking out four.

*ADVANCED HITTING STATS GLOSSARY

PA: Plate Appearances

Plate Appearances are the total number of times a hitter completes a turn batting.

OPS: On-Base Plus Slugging

On-base Plus Slugging (OPS) is the sum of a player's on-base percentage (how often a player reaches base safely) and their slugging percentage (how many bases a player reaches per at bat).

ISO: Isolated Power

Isolated Power (ISO) is a measure of a hitter's raw power. Or, to look at it another way, it measures how good a player is at hitting for extra bases. The simplest way to calculate ISO is to subtract a player's Batting Average from their Slugging Percentage, which leaves us with a measure of just a player's extra bases per at bat.

BABIP: Batting Average on Balls In Play

Batting Average on Balls In Play (BABIP) measures how many of a batter's balls in play go for hits. Affected greatly by defense and luck, BABIP can dramatically affect a hitter's batting average. If a large number of a batter's balls in play go for hits, that can boost their batting average quite high. Similarly, if a large number of balls in play get caught, it can reduce a player's total offensive value.

wRC+: Weighted Runs Created Plus

Weighted Runs Created Plus measures the total number of runs a player contributes to their team. The formula accounts for a player's ability to get on base, their total number of bases, and their baserunning. The Plus version of the stat is park and league adjusted.

wOBA: Weighted On-Base Average

Weighted On-Base Average combines all the different aspects of hitting into one metric, weighting each of them in proportion to their actual run value. While batting average, on-base percentage, and slugging percentage fall short in accuracy and scope, wOBA measures and captures offensive value more accurately and comprehensively. (Due to no constant in minor league baseball, the wOBA statistic is approximate).

K% & BB%: Strikeout Rate and Walk Rate

Strikeout rate (K%) and walk rate (BB%) measure how often a position player walks or strikes out per plate appearance. They're measured in percentage form, so it's easy to compare between players and years.

ADVANCED PITCHING STATS GLOSSARY*

TBF: Total Batters Faced

Total Batters Faced measures the total number of plate appearances hitters have made against him.

AVG: Batting Average

Batting average is the rate of hits per at bat, calculated as hits/at bats.

BABIP: Batting Average on Balls In Play

Batting Average on Balls In Play (BABIP) measures how often a ball in play goes for a hit. Typically around 30% of all balls in play fall for hits, but there are several variables that can affect BABIP rates for individual players, such as defense, luck, and talent level. Hitters have more control over their BABIP than pitchers do.

LOB%: Left On Base Percentage

Left on Base Percentage (LOB%) measures the percentage of base runners that a pitcher strands on base over the course of a season. This stat does not use the left on base numbers reported in box scores, but instead is calculated using a pitcher's actual hits, walks, and runs allowed results.

FIP: Fielding Independent Pitching

Fielding Independent Pitching (FIP) measures what a player's ERA should have looked like over a given time period, assuming that performance on balls in play and timing were league average. (Due to no constant in minor league baseball, the FIP statistic is approximate).

K% & BB%: Strikeout Rate and Walk Rate

Strikeout rate (K%) and walk rate (BB%) measure how often a pitcher walks or strikes out a player per plate appearance. They're measured in percentage form, so it's easy to compare between players and years.

xFIP: Expected Fielding Independent Pitching

Same as FIP, but it normalizes a pitcher's home runs allowed based on their fly ball rate rather than simply using the raw number of home runs allowed.
