YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels were hit with their first loss of the 2019 season in the series finale against the Hartford Yard Goats, falling 3-0. **Brandon Beachy** made his first start in affiliated baseball since the 2016 season, and allowed three runs over four innings. All three runs scored on a three-run homer by Brian Serven in the top of the second. Richmond, led by a two-hit game by **Jacob Heyward**, outhit Hartford, 6-5. **Nolan Riggs** tossed 3.0 scoreless innings with four strikeouts and **Sam Selman** struck out four in his 2.0 innings of work.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels open the second series of the 2019 season with the first of three games against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The two teams are scheduled to meet 22 times this season, including 13 games at The Diamond. Last year, the Squirrels went 9-11 against the Baysox and 6-6 at home.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS: After winning the first three games of the season, the Squirrels lost in the series finale on Sunday against Hartford. The Squirrels picked up the series win despite averaging just 1.5 runs per game. Richmond is the only team in the league without a home run through the first four games and have scored the second-fewest runs in the circuit.

THE BAYSOX: After dropping their first three games of the year, the Baysox avoided a sweep on Sunday afternoon with a 6-2 win at Harrisburg. Bowie is ranked fourth in the league with a .228 team average and tied for second with four homers. Bowie's 5.76 ERA is the second-highest in the Eastern League. Bowie's roster includes seven of the Orioles' MLB.com top-30 prospects, including Yusniel Diaz (1), Ryan McKenna (7), Zac Lowther (8), Hunter Harvey (12), Dillon Tate (18), Zach Pop (20) and Ryan Bannon (23).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Alfred Gutierrez** makes his first start as a member of the Giants organization after spending the previous seven seasons with the Detroit Tigers. Last year, he spent time at three levels and made seven starts for the Erie SeaWolves in the Eastern League. He spent most of the season split between the starting rotation and bullpen with A-Adv. Lakeland and was named a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star. **For more on Gutierrez, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Former Flying Squirrels right-hander Tyler Herb makes his first start as a member of the Baltimore Orioles organization. Originally drafted by the Mariners in the 29th round in 2014 out of Coastal Carolina, Herb was traded to San Francisco on July 3, 2017 and assigned to Richmond, where he went 2-3 with a 2.76 ERA over 10 starts. On March 23, 2019, he traded to the Orioles for long-time Baysox outfielder Mike Yastrzemski. Last year, Herb made 13 starts for Triple-A Sacramento, going 2-8 with a 5.35 ERA.

FAST START: With the double-header sweep on Saturday, the Flying Squirrels started a season 3-0 for the first time in franchise history. The team had previously only won back-to-back games to open a season once, which occurred during the 2015 season with 3-2 and 1-0 wins against Bowie. Even with a loss on Sunday, Richmond's 3-1 record is the best in franchise history through four games to open a season.

STRONG ARMS: Through the first four games of the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with a 1.09 team ERA. Richmond pitchers allowed one run through the first three games of the season, combining for two shutouts, before Hartford scored three runs on a homer by Brian Serven on Sunday afternoon in a 3-0 loss. Squirrels pitchers have held opposing batters to a league-best .124 average.

THE WILLIE HARRIS ERA: Willie Harris returns for a second season managing the Flying Squirrels, becoming just the second manager in franchise history to lead the club for multiple seasons (Dave Machemer - 2011-13). Harris is in his third season as a manager in the minor leagues overall and has compiled a 118-160 record. He was officially appointed as the manager of the Flying Squirrels on December 14, 2017.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (21), Howard (28) and Miller (29).

THIS DATE IN HISTORY

In 2010, the Flying Squirrels played their first-ever game at Prince George's Stadium in Bowie, Md. In the top of the fourth inning, Thomas Neal lined a two-out double down the right-field line against Bowie left-hander Zach Britton for the first hit in franchise history. Jackson Williams drove in the team's first run, which was scored by Michael Ambort, in the fifth inning. Ronnie Ray recorded the first strikeout in the fifth. The Squirrels went on to lose the game, 6-4.
