YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost the series opener to the Baysox, 8-5, in 10 innings for their second straight loss overall. Bowie's Ryan McKenna hit a go-ahead triple in the top of the tenth, followed by RBI hits by Rylan Bannon and Anderson Feliz to open a three-run lead against **Melvin Adon**. Trailing 5-2 through six, the Squirrels rallied to tie the score in the seventh with an RBI walk by **Chris Shaw**, a run-scoring groundout by **Brock Stassi** and **Ryan Howard** scored on a wild pitch. Richmond opened the scoring in the second with a two-run single by **Levi Michael** but Bowie scored four runs in the fourth against starting pitcher **Alfred Gutierrez** and added an unearned run against reliever **Connor Overton** in the fifth to pull ahead, 5-2. Howard, **Jalen Miller** and **Jacob Heyward** each had two hits for the Flying Squirrels.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of the second series of the 2019 season against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, and are looking to avoid a two-game sweep. Monday's series opener was postponed to July 22 due to rain. The two teams are scheduled to meet 22 times this season, including 13 games at The Diamond. Last year, the Squirrels went 9-11 against the Baysox and 6-6 at home.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS: After winning the first three games of the season, the Flying Squirrels have dropped the last two. The Squirrels picked up the series win over Hartford last weekend despite averaging just 1.5 runs per game. Richmond is the only team in the league without a home run through the first five games. After allowing just one run over the first three games of the year, Richmond pitching has surrendered 11 runs in the last two games.

THE BAYSOX: After dropping their first three games of the year, the Baysox avoided a sweep on Sunday afternoon with a 6-2 win at Harrisburg and won the series opener in Richmond on Tuesday. Bowie is ranked fourth in the league with a .260 team average and tied for fourth with four homers. Bowie's 5.22 ERA is the second-highest in the Eastern League. Bowie's roster includes seven of the Orioles' MLB.com top-30 prospects, including Yusniel Diaz (1), Ryan McKenna (7), Zac Lowther (8), Hunter Harvey (12), Dillon Tate (18), Zach Pop (20) and Ryan Bannon (23).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Logan Webb** makes his second start of the season. He was the Flying Squirrels' Opening Night starter on Thursday and picked up a win after allowing two hits over five scoreless innings, despite issuing a career-high five walks. Webb made six starts for the Flying Squirrels in 2018. He went 1-1 with a 2.77 ERA through his first five starts, but allowed five of his 13 total earned runs at Double-A in his final start of the season. Webb is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 5 Giants prospect and the second-highest rated pitcher in the organization on that list. **For more on Webb, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander Bruce Zimmermann makes his 2019 debut for the Baysox. The Baltimore native was originally drafted by the Braves in the fifth round in 2017 and reached Double-A for the first time in his career last year in late-June. After six starts for the Mississippi Braves, he was traded to the Orioles along with three other players in exchange for RHPs Kevin Gausman and Darren O'Day. He joined the Baysox on August 11, 2018, and went 2-3 with a 5.06 ERA in five starts to close out the season. After posting a 2.68 ERA in his first three games with Bowie, Zimmermann allowed nine runs in 6.1 innings over his last two starts of the season. He has made one career start against the Flying Squirrels, picking up a win on August 23, 2018 at Prince George's Stadium after allowing one run over five innings.

LEADING THE WAY: **Jacob Heyward** leads the Flying Squirrels offense with a .385 batting average, which is tied for sixth in the league. He also leads the Eastern League with a .556 on-base percentage and is tied for first in the circuit with five walks. Over his last two games, Heyward is batting .500 (4-for-8) with a double. He is the only Flying Squirrels player to reach base in all five games this season.

OBP: Richmond has three players ranked in the top-five in the Eastern League in on-base percentage: **Jacob Heyward** (.556/1st), **Chris Shaw** (.500/T-3rd) and **Ryan Howard** (.471/5th). Howard has more walks (5) than hits (3) and is tied with Heyward for the league lead in free passes.

FAST START: With the double-header sweep on Saturday, the Flying Squirrels started a season 3-0 for the first time in franchise history. The team had previously only won back-to-back games to open a season once, which occurred during the 2015 season with 3-2 and 1-0 wins against Bowie. The team's 3-1 record was also tied for the best through the first four games of the season in franchise history (2013).

STRONG ARMS: Through the first four games of the season prior to last night's loss, the Flying Squirrels led the Eastern League with a 1.09 team ERA. Richmond pitchers allowed one run through the first three games of the season, combining for two shutouts, before Hartford scored three runs on a homer by Brian Serven on Sunday afternoon in a 3-0 loss. The eight runs scored by Bowie on Tuesday doubled the team's total scoring allowed on the season.

THE WILLIE HARRIS ERA: Willie Harris returns for a second season managing the Flying Squirrels, becoming just the second manager in franchise history to lead the club for multiple seasons (Dave Machemer - 2011-13). Harris is in his third season as a manager in the minor leagues overall and has compiled a 121-162 record. He was officially appointed as the manager of the Flying Squirrels on December 14, 2017.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (21), Howard (28) and Miller (29).
