**WEDNESDAY:** The Flying Squirrels earned a series split with a 3-2 win over the Bowie Baysox. Johnneswhy Fargas lifted the Squirrels to a walk-off victory with an RBI single in the bottom of the ninth. Richmond starter Logan Webb threw five innings and allowed one run with no walks and four strikeouts. Sam Selman and Kieran Lovegrove combined for four scoreless innings and each struck out four. Richmond opened the scoring in the first with an RBI double by Jalen Miller, but the Baysox tied the score back up at 1-1 in the third. Jacob Heyward gave Richmond a 2-1 lead with an RBI double in the sixth inning, but Bowie again answered with a run in the seventh. Miller finished the game with two hits.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the first road game of the 2019 season with the first of two games against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. It is also the home opener for the Fightin Phils. Friday night's game was postponed due to rain and a make-up date will be announced at a later time.

**RAIN RAIN GO AWAY:** There have already been three games postponed due to rain in the first seven game dates for the Flying Squirrels, the second most in the month of April in franchise history. The only year with more was the 2014 season, when there were four games postponed for rain in April. The Flying Squirrels have seen 10 games postponed due to weather in each of the last two seasons (2017 and 2018), which is the most in a single season in team history. Last year also saw one game canceled due to weather.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS:** In their opening homestand, the Flying Squirrels won three-of-four against Hartford and split two games against Bowie, totaling a 4-2 record. Two games (Last Friday and Monday) were postponed due to rain. The Squirrels are the only team in the league who have not hit a home run. The team ranked third in walks (25) and tied for third in on-base percentage (.317). Richmond pitching has combined for a 1.90 ERA, the second-best in the league.

**THE FIGHTIN PHILS:** Reading opened the season on the road and won its first three games in Portland before dropping the finale on Sunday, 6-0. The Fightins have dropped two of the last three, including splitting two games at New Hampshire earlier this week. Tuesday's game in Manchester was postponed due to snow. Reading's 1.68 team ERA is the best in the league. Former Flying Squirrel Ali Castillo leads Reading and sits second in the league with a .412 average. Mickey Moniak is tied for third in the league with two homers. Reading's roster includes eight of the Phillies' Top-30 prospects on MLB.com: Adonis Medina (2), Adam Haseley (3), Mickey Moniak (9), Arquimedes Gamboa (13), Mauricio Llovera (15), David Parkinson (21), Kyle Dohy (22) and Cornelius Randolph (25).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Conner Menez** makes his second start of the season. In his season debut in the first game of a double-header on Saturday against Hartford, Menez worked five scoreless innings and held the Yard Goats to one hit with one walk and five strikeouts. It is the third start of his career against Reading and his first at FirstEnergy Stadium. He went 0-0 with a 1.74 (2 ER/10.1 IP) in two starts against the Fightin Phils in 2018. Last year, Menez spent most of the season with Richmond, going 6-4 with a 4.38 ERA in 15 starts. He also pitched 11 games with A-Adv. San Jose and one with Triple-A Sacramento, combining to go 9-10 with a 4.46 ERA in 28 total starts across the three levels. Menez led the Giants organization with 171 total strikeouts, 32 ahead of second-place John Gavin. It was also tied for the fourth-most strikeouts in the minors (led by Dean Kremer of the Orioles organization). Menez is in his fourth professional season and was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 14th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of the Master's University. He entered this season ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 25 Giants prospect. **For more on Menez, see page two.**

**FOR READING:** Right-hander Ramon Rosso makes his second start of the season. In his Double-A debut on Opening Night in Portland last Thursday, Rosso picked up a win after tossing five scoreless innings with four strikeouts. He split 2018 between Single-A Lakewood and A-Adv. Clearwater, going 11-3 with a 2.04 ERA in 23 outings (22 starts). He was named a South Atlantic League Mid-Season All-Star with Lakewood last season.

**LEADING THE WAY:** **Jacob Heyward** leads the Flying Squirrels offense with a .353 batting average, which is eighth in the league. He also ranked tied for first in the Eastern League with a .500 on-base percentage and is tied for third in the circuit with five walks. Over his last three games, Heyward is batting .417 (5-for-12) with two doubles. He is the only Flying Squirrels player to reach base in all six games this season.

**FAST START:** With the double-header sweep on Saturday, the Flying Squirrels started a season 3-0 for the first time in franchise history. The team had previously only won back-to-back games to open a season once, which occurred during the 2015 season with 3-2 and 1-0 wins against Bowie. The team's current 4-2 record is tied for the best start in team history through six games (2011, 2013, 2018). The Flying Squirrels have never started a season 5-2.

**STRONG ARMS:** Richmond's pitchers have combined to post a 1.90 ERA through the first six games, which is second in the Eastern League. It's also the best ERA in team history through the first six games to start a season. The Squirrels have held opponents to two or less runs in four of the six games.

**THE WILLIE HARRIS ERA:** Willie Harris returns for a second season managing the Flying Squirrels, becoming just the second manager in franchise history to lead the club for multiple seasons (Dave Machemer - 2011-13). Harris is in his third season as a manager in the minor leagues overall and has compiled a 122-162 record. He was officially appointed as the manager of the Flying Squirrels on December 14, 2017.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (21), Howard (28) and Miller (29).
