YESTERDAY: Early errors put the Flying Squirrels behind in a 5-1 loss to the Fightin Phils to open the road trip. Reading plated single runs in the first and third innings after a pair of fielding errors to open a 2-0 lead, with both RBIs off the bat of Darick Hall. Luke Williams and Luke Leftwich each drove in a run in the sixth and Williams scored on a misplayed pick-off try. Richmond broke the shutout in the eighth with an RBI single by **Jalen Miller**, one of his three hits on the night. **Conner Menez** started for Richmond and struck out six while allowing two unearned runs. Reading starter Ramon Rosso struck out seven over 5.1 scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels conclude the first road series of the 2019 season with the finale of a rain-shortened, two-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. Reading is looking for its first two-game sweep against Richmond since April 21-23, 2017 and the first ever at FirstEnergy Stadium. The last time the Fightin Phils swept the Flying Squirrels was in 2017, a four-game sweep in Reading. The last time Richmond was swept in any two-game series was April 23-25, 2018 at Bowie.

RAIN RAIN GO AWAY: There have already been three games postponed due to rain in the first seven game dates for the Flying Squirrels, the second most in the month of April in franchise history. The only year with more was the 2014 season, when there were four games postponed for rain in April. The Flying Squirrels have seen 10 games postponed due to weather in each of the last two seasons (2017 and 2018), which is the most in a single season in team history. Last year also saw one game canceled due to weather.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS: After starting the season 3-0, the Flying Squirrels have gone 1-3 over their last four games, being outscored in that stretch, 18-9. The lone win in that span was a 3-2, walk-off win on Wednesday against Bowie. The Richmond offense is hitting .207 (28/135) over the last four games and hit .143 (5/35) with runners in scoring position. After not committing a defensive error in the first three games, the Richmond defense has been charged with five errors over the last four games, including four in the last two games.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS: Reading's 1.58 team ERA is the best in the league. Mickey Moniak is tied for fourth in the league with eight RBIs. Luke Williams is tied for the league lead with three steals, picking up two of them in one play against Richmond on Saturday. Reading's roster includes eight of the Phillies' Top-30 prospects on MLB.com: Adonis Medina (2), Adam Haseley (3), Mickey Moniak (9), Arquimedes Gamboa (13), Mauricio Llovera (15), David Parkinson (21), Kyle Dohy (22) and Cornedilius Randolph (25).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Garrett Williams** takes the mound for his second start of 2019. In his season debut on Saturday against Hartford in the second game of a double-header, Williams worked four scoreless innings and struck out five. It was just his second scoreless outing in 16 career starts for Richmond. He made 14 starts last season and went 2-6 with a 6.00 ERA before moving to the bullpen when the calendar turned to July. As a reliever, he posted a 5.96 ERA in 18 appearances. Williams is ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 21 Giants prospect and No. 21 by MLB.com. **For more on Williams, see page two.**

FOR READING: Philadelphia's top-ranked pitching prospect (MLB.com & *Baseball America*), Adonis Medina, makes his second start of 2019. He has not pitched since his season and Double-A debut on Friday, April 5 at Portland, when he allowed three runs (one earned) over five innings in a no-decision. Last year, Medina pitched for A-Adv. Clearwater and went 10-4 with a 4.12 ERA in 22 outings (21 starts), earning a selection for the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Nationals Park in July. Medina finished the season ranked tied for fourth in the Florida State League in wins (10) and third in strikeouts (123).

MILLER TIME: **Jalen Miller** leads the Flying Squirrels hitters with a .375 batting average, which is the seventh-best in the Eastern League. He's also tied for first in the league with three stolen bases. Over the last three games, Miller has hit .539 (7/13) with a double, two RBIs and two stolen bases. He is currently riding a team-leading five-game hitting streak, during which he has hit .450 (9/20).

NEW YEAR NEW ME: **Jonah Arenado's** current .316 batting average is higher than his batting average was at any point during the 2018 season with Richmond. He has at least one hit in four of his last five games, including a 2-for-4 game on Saturday. He hit .200 with the Flying Squirrels in 2018 and missed part of the season with a shoulder injury.

STRONG ARMS: Richmond's pitchers have combined to post a 2.10 ERA through the first seven games, which is second in the Eastern League. Flying Squirrels starters have combined to post a 2.27 ERA (8 ER/31.2 IP). Returning starters **Logan Webb**, **Conner Menez** and **Garrett Williams** have combined for a 0.38 ERA (1 ER/23.2 IP).

THE WILLIE HARRIS ERA: Willie Harris returns for a second season managing the Flying Squirrels, becoming just the second manager in franchise history to lead the club for multiple seasons (Dave Machermer - 2011-13). Harris is in his third season as a manager in the minor leagues overall and has compiled a 122-163 record. He was officially appointed as the manager of the Flying Squirrels on December 14, 2017.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (21), Howard (28) and Miller (29).
