**YESTERDAY:** Strong pitching performances by **Brandon Beachy**, **Yoanys Quiala** and **Connor Overton** helped fuel a 5-1 win over the Hartford Yard Goats at Dunkin' Donut Park. **Chris Shaw** opened the scoring with a solo homer in the second, his second in as many games. **Hamlet Marte** added an RBI single in the third before **Ryan Howard** hit his first homer, a solo shot, in the sixth to open a 3-0 lead. **Brock Stassi** brought in a run in the sixth and added another RBI knock in the eighth to extend the lead to 5-0. Hartford broke the shutout in the ninth when a run scored on a wild pitch. Beachy earned his first win on the mound since July 1, 2015 with five scoreless innings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels continue the first road trip of the 2019 season with the second of three games at Dunkin' Donuts Park against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. The two teams met for the first series of 2019 at The Diamond, with Richmond winning the first three games before Hartford salvaged last Sunday's finale.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS:** For the first time in team history, the Flying Squirrels opened the season 3-0, and they have gone 3-3 in the six games since. Richmond's offense has combined to hit .230, which ranks fourth in the league. The pitching staff has posted a 2.03 ERA, which is second-best in the circuit.

**THE YARD GOATS:** After beginning the season 1-6, the Yard Goats took three-of-four against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats to open their first homestand of the 2019 season. Hartford opened the season in Richmond and lost the first three games, including being shut out twice, before winning the series finale. They were then swept in a three-game series on the road against Harrisburg. Over the last four games prior to this series, the Yard Goats hit .308 (40/130) as a team with seven homers and averaged 6.0 runs per game (24 total) before Richmond held them to one run and four hits on Monday.

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Alfred Gutierrez** makes his second start as a member of the Giants organization after spending the previous seven seasons with the Detroit Tigers. In his season debut last Tuesday, Gutierrez faced the minimum over his first three innings before allowing four runs in the fourth. Last year, he spent time at three levels and made seven starts for the Erie SeaWolves in the Eastern League. He spent most of the season split between the starting rotation and bullpen with A-Adv. Lakeland and was named a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star. **For more on Gutierrez, see page two.**

**FOR HARTFORD:** Right-hander Brandon Gold makes his third start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He made his season debut on April 6 at The Diamond and pitched five scoreless innings before Richmond stormed back for a walk-off win in extras against the bullpen. Last time out, he surrendered five earned runs on 11 hits over 3.1 innings in a no-decision against New Hampshire on Thursday. Gold was drafted by the Rockies in the 12th round in 2016 out of Georgia Tech and is in his first Double-A season.

**POWER SURGE:** The Flying Squirrels went into Sunday as one of four teams in the minors without a home run hit on the year. Over the last two games, the Richmond offense has hit four homers, including two by **Chris Shaw**, one by **Jalen Miller** and one by **Ryan Howard**.

**SHAWESOME:** Over his last two games, **Chris Shaw** has hit .500 (4/8) with two homers, one triple, four RBIs, one walk and four runs scored, raising his season average to .318. Over his first five games, Shaw hit .214 (3/14) with one RBI. He is currently ranked tied for eighth in the league in on-base percentage (.444), eighth in slugging (.682) and eighth in OPS (1.126).

**MILLER TIME:** **Jalen Miller** leads the Flying Squirrels hitters with a .357 batting average, which is the tenth-best in the Eastern League. He's also tied for first in the league with three stolen bases. Over his last four games, Miller has hit .471 (8/17) with a double, two RBIs and two stolen bases. He is currently riding a team-leading six-game hitting streak, during which he is hitting .417 (10/24).

**NEW YEAR NEW ME:** After hit .200 over 102 games in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** has started 2019 with a .333 average through his eight games played. He has picked up at least one hit in six of his last seven games overall, all singles. On the current road trip, Arenado is batting .444 (4/9) in three games.

**STRONG ARMS:** Richmond's pitchers have combined to post a 2.03 ERA through the first nine games, which is ranked second in the Eastern League. Flying Squirrels starters have combined to post a 2.38 ERA (11 ER/41.2 IP). Returning starters **Logan Webb**, **Conner Menez** and **Garrett Williams** have combined for a 1.26 ERA (4 ER/28.2 IP). The Flying Squirrels have held opposing teams to three or less runs in seven of the nine games played and one or less runs four times.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (21), Howard (28) and Miller (29).
