YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels allowed season highs in runs (13) and hits (17) in a 13-3 loss to the Hartford Yard Goats at Dunkin' Donuts Park. After **Jalen Miller** gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the first, Hartford answered with six runs in the second inning, five of which scored following a two-out error. Richmond climbed back within three with RBIs by **Chris Shaw** and **Jonah Arenado** in the fifth and sixth, but Hartford scored seven more runs over the next three inning against the bullpen. Flying Squirrels starter **Alfred Gutierrez** allowed six runs (one earned) and left with two outs in the second. The loss matched the largest deficit in team history against Hartford.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels conclude the first road trip of the 2019 season with the finale of three games at Dunkin' Donuts Park against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. The two teams met for the first series of 2019 at The Diamond, with Richmond winning the first three games before Hartford salvaged last Sunday's finale.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS: For the first time in team history, the Flying Squirrels opened the season 3-0, and they have gone 3-4 in the seven games since. Richmond's offense has combined to hit .229, which ranks fifth in the league. The pitching staff has posted a 2.72 ERA, which is fourth-best in the circuit.

THE YARD GOATS: After beginning the season 1-6, the Yard Goats have gone 4-2 over the last six games. Hartford took three-of-four against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats to open their first homestand of the 2019 season. Hartford opened the season in Richmond and lost the first three games, including being shut out twice, before winning the series finale. They were then swept in a three-game series on the road against Harrisburg.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Logan Webb** makes his third start of the season and second against Hartford. He was the Flying Squirrels' Opening Night starter on April 4 and picked up a win over Hartford after allowing two hits over five scoreless innings, despite issuing a career-high five walks. Last time out, he allowed one run in five innings against Bowie on April 10. He is currently ranked sixth in the league with a 0.90 ERA. Webb made six starts for the Flying Squirrels in 2018. He went 1-1 with a 2.77 ERA through his first five starts, but allowed five of his 13 total earned runs at Double-A in his final start of the season. Webb is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 5 Giants prospect and the second-highest rated pitcher in the organization on that list. **For more on Webb, see page two.**

FOR HARTFORD: Left-hander Ty Culbreth makes his third start of the year and his second against Richmond. Last time out, he picked up a loss after allowing four runs in 5.0 innings against New Hampshire on Friday. He faced the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond on April 7 and picked up a win with 5.0 scoreless innings in a 3-0 shutout. Culbreth is in his first Double-A season and was drafted by the Rockies in the eighth round in 2016 out of the University of Texas.

POWER SURGE: The Flying Squirrels went into Sunday as one of four teams in the minors without a home run hit on the year. Over the last three games, the Richmond offense has hit five homers, including two by **Chris Shaw**, two by **Jalen Miller** and one by **Ryan Howard**.

SHAWESOME: Over his last three games, **Chris Shaw** has hit .417 (5/12) with two homers, a double, a triple, five RBIs, one walk and four runs scored, raising his season average to .308. Over his first five games, Shaw hit .214 (3/14) with one RBI. He is currently ranked tied for eighth in the league in on-base percentage (.419), sixth in slugging (.654) and fifth in OPS (1.073).

MILLER TIME: **Jalen Miller** leads the Flying Squirrels hitters with a .375 batting average, which is the seventh-best in the Eastern League. He's also tied for first in the league with three stolen bases. Over his last five games, Miller has hit .476 (10/21) with two homers, a double, five RBIs and two stolen bases. He is currently riding a team-leading seven-game hitting streak, during which he is hitting .429 (12/28).

NEW YEAR NEW ME: After hit .200 over 102 games in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** has started 2019 with a .321 average through his nine games played. He has picked up at least one hit in seven of his last eight games overall. On the current road trip, Arenado is batting .385 (5/13) in four games.

STRONG ARMS: Flying Squirrels starters have combined to post a 2.49 ERA (12 ER/43.1 IP). Returning starters **Logan Webb**, **Conner Menez** and **Garrett Williams** have combined for a 1.26 ERA (4 ER/28.2 IP). The Flying Squirrels have held opposing teams to three or less runs in seven of the 10 games played and one or less runs four times.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (21), Howard (28) and Miller (29).
