YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost their road-trip finale to the Hartford Yard Goats, 4-3, at Dunkin' Donuts Park. **Ryan Howard** put Richmond ahead in the first inning with a sac fly following a lead-off triple by **Levi Michael**, but Hartford answered with two runs in the bottom of the first on RBI knocks by Arvacent Perez and Willie Abreu. Hartford stretched the lead to 3-1 in the third with another RBI hit by Perez. In the fifth, **Logan Webb** drove home **Hamlet Marte** to pull back within a run, but Hartford answered with a solo homer by Vince Fernandez in the sixth. **Chris Shaw** closed the game back to one run with a pinch-hit, RBI single in the eighth, but the Squirrels' rally was quieted in the final inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels open a six-game homestand with the first of a three-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. Tonight's game is the first of 21 meetings between the two teams this season. Last year, Richmond went 6-9 in games against Altoona, including a 2-4 mark at The Diamond. The Flying Squirrels are 4-2 at home this year and 1-1 against Western Division opponents.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS: After opening with a 4-2 record through the first homestand of the season, the Flying Squirrels went 2-3 on the last road trip in Reading and Hartford. Over the last five games, the Flying Squirrels hit .249 as a team with five homers. The pitching staff posted a 4.07 ERA over the last five games.

THE CURVE: Altoona enters the series on a five-game losing streak. In that stretch, the Curve have been outscored 25-10 and been shut out twice. Altoona is the only team in the Eastern League to qualify for the Eastern League Postseason in each of the last four seasons and has won back-to-back Western Division titles.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Conner Menez** makes his third start of the season. In his season debut in the first game of a double-header on April 6 against Hartford, Menez worked five scoreless innings and held the Yard Goats to one hit with one walk and five strikeouts. Last time out, he picked up a loss despite allowing two unearned runs over 4.2 innings at Reading on Saturday. Last year, Menez spent most of the season with Richmond, going 6-4 with a 4.38 ERA in 15 starts. He also pitched 11 games with A-Adv. San Jose and one with Triple-A Sacramento, combining to go 9-10 with a 4.46 ERA in 28 total starts across the three levels. Menez led the Giants organization with 171 total strikeouts, 32 ahead of second-place John Gavin. It was also tied for the fourth-most strikeouts in the minors (led by Dean Kremer of the Orioles organization). Menez is in his fourth professional season and was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 14th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of the Master's University. He entered this season ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 25 Giants prospect. **For more on Menez, see page two.**

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Anthony Quinton "Scooter" Hightower makes his third start of the season and fourth overall appearance. Last time out, he threw 4.1 innings and allowed two runs in a loss against Akron on Saturday. Last season, he split the year between A-Adv. Bradenton and Double-A Altoona. With the Marauders, he went 5-0 with a 1.47 ERA in 18 outings. At Double-A, he posted a 2-1 record with a 2.41 in 11 appearances, including seven starts. Hightower was drafted by the Pirates in the 15th round in 2015 out of Columbia State Community College in Tennessee.

POWER SURGE: The Flying Squirrels went into Sunday as one of four teams in the minors without a home run hit on the year. Over the four three games, the Richmond offense has hit five homers, including two by **Chris Shaw**, two by **Jalen Miller** and one by **Ryan Howard**.

SHAWESOME: Over his last three games, **Chris Shaw** has hit .462 (6/13) with two homers, a double, a triple, six RBIs, one walk and four runs scored, raising his season average to .333. Over his first five games, Shaw hit .214 (3/14) with one RBI. He is currently ranked tied for seventh in the league in on-base percentage (.438), sixth in slugging (.667) and fourth in OPS (1.104).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (21), Howard (28) and Miller (29).
