THURSDAY: The Flying Squirrels clubbed three homers and ran away from the Altoona Curve, 8-4. Altoona struck first for a run in the first inning, but the Squirrels plated a pair in the second with RBIs by **Johan Arenado** and **Hamlet Marte**. Altoona evened the score in the third, but in the bottom of the inning, **Ryan Howard** drove a solo homer to put Richmond ahead for good. Marte and **Conner Menez** brought home runs in the fourth to open a 5-2 lead. The Curve plated a run in the seventh to close within 5-3, but **Jalen Miller** hit a solo homer in the eighth and Arenado added a two-run shot to expand the advantage to 8-3. On the mound, Menez struck out eight over 5.0 innings and allowed two runs (one earned).

TODAY'S GAMES: The Flying Squirrels continue a six-game homestand with the second and third of a three-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. Tonight's games are the second and third of 21 meetings between the two teams this season. Last year, Richmond went 6-9 in games against Altoona, including a 2-4 mark at The Diamond. The Flying Squirrels are 4-2 at home this year and 1-1 against Western Division opponents.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS: After opening with a 4-2 record through the first homestand of the season, the Flying Squirrels went 2-3 on the last road trip in Reading and Hartford. The Richmond offense has combined to hit .239, which is third-best in the Eastern League. Richmond's 2.88 team ERA is ranked in the league, trailing only the Western Division-leading Harrisburg Senators (2.43).

THE CURVE: Altoona is riding a six-game losing streak. In that stretch, the Curve have been outscored 33-14 and been shut out twice. Altoona is the only team in the Eastern League to qualify for the Eastern League Post-season in each of the last four seasons and has won back-to-back Western Division titles. The Altoona roster includes three of MLB.com's Top-30 Pirates prospects: Jared Oliva (12), Stephen Alemas (26) and Gage Hinsz (30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Garrett Williams** takes the mound for his third start of 2019. Last time out, Williams worked five innings and allowed three runs at Reading on Sunday afternoon, collecting six strikeouts. In his season debut on April 6 in the second game of a double-header against Hartford, Williams threw four scoreless innings with five strikeouts. He has not issued a walk through his first two starts. He made 14 starts for Richmond last season and went 2-6 with a 6.00 ERA before moving to the bullpen when the calendar turned to July. As a reliever, he posted a 5.96 ERA in 18 appearances. Williams is ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 21 Giants prospect and No. 20 by MLB.com. **For more on Williams, see page two.**

Right-hander **Brandon Beachy** makes his third start for the Flying Squirrels in Game 2. Last time out, Beachy worked 5.0 scoreless innings and allowed one hit in a win at Hartford on Monday. Beachy is pitching in affiliated baseball for the first time since 2016 when he was a member of the Dodgers organization. He made his MLB debut with the Atlanta Braves in 2010 and spent three seasons in the Majors with them, totaling 46 starts with a 14-11 record and 3.23 ERA. His best season came in 2012, when he went 5-5 with a 2.00 ERA over 13 starts, posting the best ERA in the majors until his season ended with an elbow injury, requiring Tommy John surgery. He returned in 2013 but had to undergo Tommy John surgery again prior to the 2014 season. Beachy signed with the Dodgers in 2015 and briefly returned to the majors that year. He was held to one appearance in 2016 and did not pitch at all in 2017. Last year, he made 12 appearances for the independent New Britain Bees, going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA in 12 appearances (two starts). **For more on Beachy, see page three.**

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **James Marvel** makes his fourth start of the season for the Curve. Last time out, he worked four innings and allowed one run against Harrisburg. Marvel was the Opening Night starter for the Curve on April 4 at Akron and threw six scoreless innings with nine strikeouts and no walks. He spent most of 2018 with A-Adv. Bradenton before a late-season promotion to Altoona. With the Curve, he made five starts, going 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA. Marvel was drafted by the Pirates in the 36th round in 2015 out of Duke University.

Right-hander Pedro Vasquez makes his third start and his fourth overall appearance for Altoona in Game 2. He last pitched on Saturday against Akron and allowed two runs over 5.0 innings in a no-decision. Vasquez spend most of 2018 with Altoona, but was limited to 13 outings (12 starts) due to missing time for a forearm strain. With the Curve, he went 2-6 with a 5.12 ERA. Today's outing marks the first of his career against Richmond.

POWER SURGE: The Flying Squirrels went into Sunday as one of four teams in the minors without a home run hit on the year. Over the last five games, the Richmond offense has hit eight homers, including three by **Jalen Miller**, two by **Chris Shaw**, two by **Ryan Howard** and one by **Jonah Arenado**. Richmond hit a season-high three homers on Thursday night against Altoona, the first three at home this season.

MILLER TIME: Over his last seven games, **Jalen Miller** has hit .392 (11/28) with three homers, a double and six RBIs. He has clubbed three homers over his last four games. Miller is ranked tied for fourth in the Eastern League with three homers and tied for third with three stolen bases. He has picked up at least one hit in eight of his last nine games and at least one RBI in five of his last six games.

ARENADO: After hitting .200 in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** is leading the Flying Squirrels with a .361 batting average on the season, which is ranked seventh in the Eastern League. He is also ranked 10th in the league with a .410 on-base percentage. On Thursday, he went 4-for-4 with three RBIs, a double and a two-run homer, his first long-ball of the year. He has at least one hit in eight of his last 10 games.

TAKE A WALK: **Jacob Heyward's** 10 walks on the season are second in the Eastern League he is ranked first in the circuit with a .514 on-base percentage. Heyward's walk percentage (27%) leads all of Minor League Baseball. He is also hitting .333 (9/27) with 11 strikeouts. On balls put in play, Heyward is batting .563, which leads the Eastern League by 77 points over Hartford's Alan Trejo and New Hampshire's Alberto Mineo (.486).

SHAWESOME: Over his last five games, **Chris Shaw** has hit .412 (7/17) with two homers, a double, a triple, six RBIs, one walk and five runs scored. Over his first five games, Shaw hit .214 (3/14) with one RBI. He is currently ranked eighth in the league in on-base percentage (.417), ninth in slugging (.613) and eighth in OPS (1.030).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27) and Miller (28).

THIS DATE IN HISTORY
