YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped their third straight game with a 2-1 loss to the Reading Fightin Phils. **Jacob Heyward** hit a solo home run in the fourth inning for the Flying Squirrels. Richmond held a 1-0 lead through the first seven innings before game-tying, solo homer by Darick Hall in the top of the eighth. Later in the inning with two outs, Luke Williams hit a go-ahead, pinch-hit single. Reading closer Kyle Dohy worked the final two innings and struck out five for the save. Richmond starter **Alfred Gutierrez** worked 3.2 innings before leaving in the fourth with an apparent injury. **Connor Overton** entered with the bases loaded that inning and stranded them full. He worked 2.1 scoreless frames in the game. **Tyler Cyr** pitched around a hit and a walk allowed for a scoreless seventh inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels continue a six-game homestand with the second of three games against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. The two teams split a rain-shortened, two-game series in Reading on April 13 and 14. Richmond and Reading are scheduled to face off in 17 games this season, including 10 at The Diamond.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS: Dating back to last Tuesday in Hartford, the Flying Squirrels have dropped five of the last six games. In that stretch, Richmond has been outscored 26-15 and has hit .179 (31/173) as a team. In the current three-game losing streak, the Flying Squirrels have hit .077 (6/78) and have scored one run. Richmond's team batting average has dropped to .211, which is 11th in the league. The pitching staff holds a 2.62 ERA on the year, which is second in the league. Monday's loss dropped the Flying Squirrels' record under .500 for the first time this season.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS: Prior to this series, Reading was swept in a rain-shortened two-game set by Harrisburg. The Fightin Phils have lost four of their last six games dating back to April 14. Reading's pitching has combined for a 3.09 ERA, fourth-best in the Eastern League. The team's .215 batting average is 10th in the circuit. Reading's roster includes eight of the Phillies' Top-30 prospects on MLB.com: Adonis Medina (2), Adam Haseley (3), Mickey Moniak (9), Arquimedes Gamboa (13), Mauricio Llovera (15), David Parkinson (21), Kyle Dohy (22) and Cornelius Randolph (25).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Logan Webb** makes his fourth start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and second of his career against Reading. Last time out, Webb allowed a season-high four runs over 6.0 innings in a loss at Hartford on Wednesday. He has faced the Fightin Phils once, a no-decision on August 28, 2018 at The Diamond, allowing three runs over 6.0 innings with seven strikeouts. He was the Flying Squirrels' Opening Night starter on April 4 and picked up a win over Hartford after allowing two hits over five scoreless innings, despite issuing a career-high five walks. Webb made six starts for the Flying Squirrels in 2018. He went 1-1 with a 2.77 ERA through his first five starts, but allowed five of his 13 total earned runs at Double-A in his final start of the season. Webb is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 5 Giants prospect and the second-highest rated pitcher in the organization on that list. **For more on Webb, see page two.**

FOR READING: Right-hander David Parkinson makes his third start of the season. A Richmond native, Parkinson is making the first start of his professional career in his home state. Parkinson was an all-metro selection during his senior season at Mills E. Godwin High School. He went on to pitch at Florence-Darlington Technical School for one season before transferring to Ole Miss, where he was drafted by the Phillies in the 12th round. Last year, Parkinson went 11-1 with a 1.45 ERA over 22 games (21 starts) between Single-A Lakewood and A-Adv. Clearwater, posting the lowest ERA in all of minor league baseball. This season, Parkinson has made two starts, both against Portland.

STRONG ARMS: Over the last four games dating back to Thursday, Flying Squirrels starting pitchers have combined to post a 1.53 ERA (3 ER/17.2 IP). The Richmond pitching staff as a whole has posted a 1.97 ERA (7 ER/32.0 IP). Opposing teams are averaging 2.25 runs per game (9 total runs), but the Flying Squirrels have gone 1-3. Starters have posted a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) this season.

NO OFFENSE: Over the last three games, the Richmond offense has been held to one total run while hitting .077 (6/78). Three of the six hits have gone for extra bases, and the lone run scored on a solo home run by **Jacob Heyward** on Monday against Reading. The Flying Squirrels have gone 0-for-16 with runners in scoring position and have left 18 runners on base in the last three games.

POWER SURGE: The Flying Squirrels went into last Sunday as one of four teams in the minors without a home run hit on the year. Over the last eight games, the Richmond offense has hit nine homers, including three by **Jalen Miller**, two by **Chris Shaw**, two by **Ryan Howard**, one by **Jonah Arenado** and one by **Jacob Heyward**. Richmond hit a season-high three homers on Thursday night against Altoona, the first three at home this season.

ARENADO AWAKENS: After hitting .200 in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** is leading the Flying Squirrels with a .364 batting average on the season, which is ranked tied for fifth in the Eastern League. He is also ranked tied for eighth in the league with a .417 on-base percentage. On Thursday, he went 4-for-4 with three RBIs, a double and a two-run homer, his first longball of the year. He has at least one hit in ten of his last 13 games.

TAKE A WALK: **Jacob Heyward's** 11 walks on the season are tied for second in the Eastern League he is ranked second in the circuit with a .488 on-base percentage. Heyward's walk percentage (25.6%) is second in the league and sixth in all of MiLB. On balls put in play, Heyward is batting .474, which is fourth in the Eastern League.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27) and Miller (28).
