**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost their third straight game with a 5-2 defeat by the Reading Fightin Phils. Reading's Ali Castillo scored the games' first run in the first inning on a passed ball. **Logan Webb** matched a career high over 5.0 innings with nine strikeouts and allowed just the one unearned run. Reading added to its lead in the sixth when Adam Haseley scored on a wild pitch and Henri Lartigue added an RBI single. The Flying Squirrels broke the shutout in the bottom of the sixth when **Jalen Miller** scored on a wild pitch. Later in the inning, **Heath Quinn** doubled home **Chris Shaw** to pull the Flying Squirrels back within a run. Castillo added two runs with a single in the top of the ninth to extend Reading's lead to 5-2. Richmond native David Parkinson started for Reading and picked up a win after allowing two runs in 5.2 innings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels wrap up a six-game homestand with the finale of three games against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. The two teams split a rain-shortened, two-game series in Reading on April 13 and 14. Richmond and Reading are scheduled to face off in 17 games this season, including 10 at The Diamond.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS:** Dating back to last Tuesday in Hartford, the Flying Squirrels have dropped six of the last seven games. In that stretch, Richmond has been outscored 31-17 and has hit .185 (38/205) as a team. In the current four-game losing streak, the Flying Squirrels have hit .118 (13/110) and have scored three runs. Richmond's team batting average has dropped to .211, which is 11th in the league. The pitching staff holds a 2.71 ERA on the year, which is second in the league. Monday's loss dropped the Flying Squirrels' record under .500 for the first time this season.

**THE FIGHTIN PHILS:** Prior to this series, Reading was swept in a rain-shortened two-game set by Harrisburg. The Fightin Phils had lost four of five prior to this set, but picked up wins in the first two games of the series. Reading's pitching has combined for a 3.01 ERA, third-best in the Eastern League. The team's .218 batting average is 10th in the circuit. Reading's roster includes eight of the Phillies' Top-30 prospects on MLB.com: Adonis Medina (2), Adam Haseley (3), Mickey Moniak (9), Arquimedes Gamboa (13), Mauricio Llovera (15), David Parkinson (21), Kyle Dohy (22) and Cornelius Randolph (25).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Conner Menez** makes his fourth start of the season. Last time out, he picked up his first win of 2019 after working five innings and allowing one earned run with eight strikeouts on Thursday against Altoona. His 0.61 ERA is ranked second in the Eastern League and third in Double-A. He is also ranked seventh in the league in opponents' batting average (.176) and ninth in WHIP (0.89). Last year, Menez spent most of the season with Richmond, going 6-4 with a 4.38 ERA in 15 starts. He also pitched 11 games with A-Adv. San Jose and one with Triple-A Sacramento, combining to go 9-10 with a 4.46 ERA in 28 total starts across the three levels. Menez led the Giants organization with 171 total strikeouts, 32 ahead of second-place John Gavin. It was also tied for the fourth-most strikeouts in the minors (led by Dean Kremer of the Orioles organization). Menez is in his fourth professional season and was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 14th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of the Master's University. He entered this season ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 25 Giants prospect. **For more on Menez, see page two.**

**FOR READING:** Left-hander Bailey Falter makes his third start of the season for the Fightin Phils. Last time out, he picked up a win over Portland on April 16 after allowing one earned run over six innings. In his Double-A debut on April 7, Falter allowed 10 hits, tied for the second-most in his career, and surrendered five runs over 5.1 innings. Falter was a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star last year with A-Adv. Clearwater. He was drafted by the Phillies in the fifth round in 2015 out of Chino Hills (Calif.) High School.

**STRONG ARMS:** Over the last five games dating back to Thursday, Flying Squirrels starting pitchers have combined to post a 1.19 ERA (3 ER/22.2 IP). The Richmond pitching staff as a whole has posted a 1.70 ERA (7 ER/37.0 IP) this season. In the last five games, opposing teams are averaging 2.8 runs per game (14 total runs), but the Flying Squirrels have gone 1-4. Starters have posted a 2.38 ERA (19 ER/72.0 IP) this season.

**NO OFFENSE:** Over the last four games, the Richmond offense has been held to three total runs while hitting .118 (13/110). The Flying Squirrels have gone 1-for-23 (.044) with runners in scoring position and have left 26 runners on base in the last four games.

**ARENADO AWAKENS:** After hitting .200 in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** is leading the Flying Squirrels with a .354 batting average on the season, which is ranked sixth in the Eastern League. He is also ranked ninth in the league with a .404 on-base percentage. On Thursday, Arenado went 4-for-4 with three RBIs, a double and a two-run homer, his first longball of the year. He has at least one hit in 11 of his last 14 games.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27) and Miller (28).
