WEDNESDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost their fifth straight game with a 7-2 loss against the Reading Fighthin Phils, who swept the three-game series. With the game tied, 2-2, Reading stormed ahead with five runs in the seventh inning. Richmond starting pitcher **Conner Menez** threw six innings and allowed two runs with a season-best nine strikeouts. The Flying Squirrels took a 2-0 lead in the second behind an RBI single by **Jin-De Jhang** and **Johnneswhy Fargas** scored on an error.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the first of three games against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The game is also the first game of a six-game road trip to Altoona and Bowie. Richmond hosted Altoona in a four-game series last weekend, winning the first game before dropping the final three. The two teams are scheduled to meet 21 total times this season, including 11 at PNG Field.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost a season-high five consecutive games and have dropped seven of the last eight games overall since April 16 in Hartford. Over the last eight games, Richmond has been outscored 38-19 and has hit .181 (42/232) as a team. In the current five-game losing streak, the Flying Squirrels have hit .124 (17/137) and have scored five runs. Richmond's team batting average has dropped to .208, which is 11th in the league, ahead of only Bowie (.191). The pitching staff holds a 2.98 ERA on the year, which is third in the league.

THE CURVE have won three of the last five games and are coming off dropped two-of-three at Harrisburg. Altoona snapped a season-long six-game losing streak on Saturday with a double-header sweep of the Squirrels at The Diamond, tossing one-hit shutouts in both games. The Altoona pitching staff has a 3.22 ERA on the year, which is fifth in the league. The Curve's .234 batting average is fifth in the league.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Garrett Williams** takes the mound for his fourth start of 2019 and his second against the Curve. He faced Altoona in his most recent start on Saturday, allowing two runs over 4.0 innings with a season-high four walks. Williams had not issued a walk in his first two starts of the season. He made 14 starts for Richmond last season and went 2-6 with a 6.00 ERA before moving to the bullpen when the calendar turned to July. As a reliever, he posted a 5.96 ERA in 18 appearances. Williams is ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 21 Giants prospect and No. 20 by *MLB.com*. **For more on Williams, see page two.**

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander James Marvel makes his fifth start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He pitched in Richmond on Saturday in the first game of the double-header and tossed a complete-game shutout, holding the Squirrels to one hit. Marvel is ranked tied for seventh in the league with 22.2 IP, tied for seventh in opponents' batting average (.167) and tied for second in WHIP (0.71). Marvel's performances against Harrisburg last Monday (4.0 IP, 1 R, 6 SO) and against Richmond on Saturday earned him Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors.

NOSEDIVE FIVE: The Flying Squirrels' five-game losing streak is the longest since the Squirrels dropped five straight from August 31-September 3, 2018 (the team also lost five straight from August 25-28, 2018 and lost 10 of the last 11 games in that season). The last time the Flying Squirrels lost six straight was part of a seven-game losing streak from July 18 (2)-July 25, 2018.

STRONG ARMS: Over the last six games dating back to Thursday, Flying Squirrels starting pitchers have combined to post a 1.57 ERA (5 ER/28.2 IP). In the last six games, opposing teams are averaging 3.5 runs per game (21 total runs), but the Flying Squirrels have gone 1-5. Starters have posted a 2.38 ERA (19 ER/72.0 IP) this season.

NO OFFENSE: Over the last five games, the Richmond offense has been held to five total runs while hitting .124 (17/137). The Flying Squirrels have gone 2-for-27 (.074) with runners in scoring position and have left 30 runners on base in the last five games.

ARENADO AWAKENS: After hitting .200 in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** is leading the Flying Squirrels with a .346 batting average on the season, which is ranked fifth in the Eastern League. He is also ranked ninth in the league with a .393 on-base percentage. He has at least one hit in 12 of his last 15 games.

KING FRIDAY'S RAIN: All three of the Flying Squirrels' attempts to play on Fridays have been postponed due to rain. The second game of the season at The Diamond on April 5 was washed out, as were the attempts to play on April 12 at Reading and April 19 at home against Altoona.

WELL RESTED: The Flying Squirrels have had three scheduled off days over the last 14 days. Tonight's game begins a stretch of 23 games over the next 24 days and 43 of the next 45 days.

JIN-DE'S RETURN: Flying Squirrels catcher **Jin-De Jhang** returns to Altoona, where he spent three seasons with the Curve from 2016-18. Jhang played 161 regular-season games for the Curve, posting a .271 average (158/583) with five homers. On September 14, 2017, Jhang hit a bases-clearing, three-run triple that helped lead the Curve to a 4-2 win over the Trenton Thunder in the clinching Game 3 of the Eastern League Championship Series.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on *MLB.com*'s top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27) and Miller (28).
