**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels dropped their sixth straight game and were shut out for the third time in the last seven days with a 7-0 loss to the Altoona Curve. Logan Hill hit a sac fly to give the Curve a 1-0 lead in the first and an error scored another run in the second. Altoona scored three runs in the third inning with a two-run double by Hunter Owen and a triple by Mitchell Tolman. Arden Pabst hit an RBI single in the fifth and Logan Hill brought in a run with another sac fly in the sixth. **Garrett Williams** allowed a season-high five runs over four innings. Altoona's James Marvel threw seven scoreless innings for the second straight start against Richmond.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the second of three games against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The game is also the second game of a six-game road trip to Altoona (0-1) and Bowie. Richmond hosted Altoona in a four-game series last weekend, winning the first game before dropping the final three. The two teams are scheduled to meet 21 total times this season, including 11 at PNG Field.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost a season-high six consecutive games and have dropped eight of the last nine games overall since April 16 in Hartford. Over the last nine games, Richmond has been outscored 45-19 and has hit .181 (42/232) as a team. In the current five-game losing streak, the Flying Squirrels have hit .126 (21/167) and have scored five runs. Richmond's team batting average has dropped to .204, which is 11th in the league, ahead of only Bowie (.197). The pitching staff holds a 3.18 ERA on the year, which is fifth in the league.

**THE CURVE** have won four of the last six games and three straight against the Flying Squirrels, all shutouts. Altoona snapped a season-long six-game losing streak last Saturday with a double-header sweep of the Squirrels at The Diamond, tossing one-hit shutouts in both games. The Altoona pitching staff has a 3.05 ERA on the year, which is third in the league. The Curve's .241 batting average is fourth in the league.

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Alfred Gutierrez** makes his fourth start of the season and his first against Altoona. Last time out, he pitched into the fourth before departing with an apparent injury on Monday against Reading. In that outing, he worked 3.2 innings and did not give up a run. Gutierrez is in his first season with the Giants organization after spending the previous seven with the Detroit Tigers. Last year, he spent time at three levels and made seven starts for the Erie SeaWolves in the Eastern League. He spent most of the season split between the starting rotation and bullpen with A-Adv. Lakeland and was named a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star. **For more on Gutierrez, see page two.**

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander Pedro Vasquez makes his fourth start of the season and his fifth overall appearance. He faced the Flying Squirrels in his most recent outing last Saturday (Game 2) at The Diamond, tossing six scoreless innings in a combined shutout. Vasquez has not allowed more than two runs in an outing this season. He made 12 starts and one relief appearance for Altoona last season, going 2-6 with a 5.12 ERA. He was originally a member of the Seattle Mariners organization and was traded to the Pirates on September 1, 2016 along with LHP Jake Brentz to complete a previous trade for Arquimedes Caminero.

**STREAK HITS SIX:** The Flying Squirrels' six-game losing streak is the longest of the season and the longest for the franchise since the team dropped seven straight from July 18 (2)-July 25, 2018.

**NO OFFENSE:** Over the last six games, the Richmond offense has been held to five total runs while hitting .126 (21/167). The Flying Squirrels have gone 2-for-34 (.059) with runners in scoring position and have left 37 runners on base in the last six games. In the last six games, the Flying Squirrels have been held to two or less runs in each game and four or less hits in five games.

**ARENADO AWAKENS:** After hitting .200 in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** is leading the Flying Squirrels with a .352 batting average on the season, which is ranked fourth in the Eastern League. He is also ranked sixth in the league with a .407 on-base percentage. He has at least one hit in 13 of his last 16 games.

**JIN-DE'S RETURN:** Flying Squirrels catcher **Jin-De Jhang** returns to Altoona, where he spent three seasons with the Curve from 2016-18. Jhang played 161 regular-season games for the Curve, posting a .271 average (158/583) with five homers. On September 14, 2017, Jhang hit a bases-clearing, three-run triple that helped lead the Curve to a 4-2 win over the Trenton Thunder in the clinching Game 3 of the Eastern League Championship Series.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27) and Miller (28).
