YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped a six-game losing streak with an 8-5 win over the Altoona Curve. **Jonah Arenado** hit a solo homer in the second to give Richmond an early 1-0 lead. Altoona answered in the bottom of the inning, but **Brock Stassi** scored on an error in the third to give the Squirrels a 2-1 lead. Altoona scored twice in the third to pull ahead, 3-2, but **Chris Shaw** knocked a two-run single in the fourth to give the lead back to Richmond. The Curve again scored a run to tie the score at 4-4 in the fourth, but Stassi crossed home on a wild pitch in the fifth. After the Curve tied the game again in the sixth, Shaw hit a go-ahead, two-run triple in the eighth. **Heath Quinn** brought in an additional insurance run in the top of the ninth. **Rodolfo Martinez** pitched a scoreless ninth for his first save in Double-A since 2016. **Brandon Lawson** worked 3.2 innings and allowed four runs (two earned) in his Giants organization debut.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of three games against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The game is also the third game of a six-game road trip to Altoona (1-1) and Bowie. Richmond hosted Altoona in a four-game series last weekend, winning the first game before dropping the final three. The two teams are scheduled to meet 21 total times this season, including 11 at PNG Field.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS ended a season-worst six-game losing streak with Saturday's win. The Squirrels have dropped eight of the last 10 games overall since April 16 in Hartford. Over the last 10 games, Richmond has been outscored 50-27 and has hit .197 (53/269) as a team. During the six-game losing streak, the Flying Squirrels scored five total runs before erupting for eight runs on Saturday. Richmond's team batting average has dropped to .210, which is 11th in the league, ahead of only Bowie (.205). The pitching staff holds a 3.17 ERA on the year, which is fifth in the league.

THE CURVE have won four of the last seven games and three-of-four against the Flying Squirrels, with shutouts in all three wins. Altoona snapped a season-long six-game losing streak last Saturday with a double-header sweep of the Squirrels at The Diamond, tossing one-hit shutouts in both games. The Altoona pitching staff has a 3.15 ERA on the year, which is fourth in the league. The Curve's .243 batting average is fourth in the league.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Alfred Gutierrez** makes his fourth start of the season and his first against Altoona. Last time out, he pitched into the fourth before departing with an apparent injury on Monday against Reading. In that outing, he worked 3.2 innings and did not give up a run. Gutierrez is in his first season with the Giants organization after spending the previous seven with the Detroit Tigers. Last year, he spent time at three levels and made seven starts for the Erie SeaWolves in the Eastern League. He spent most of the season split between the starting rotation and bullpen with A-Adv. Lakeland and was named a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star. **For more on Gutierrez, see page two.**

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Yeudy Garcia makes his first start of the season. He has pitched five relief appearances and has gone through three innings twice. Today marks Garcia's first start since June 14, 2017, when he allowed five runs over 1.1 innings in a loss against Portland. He moved to the bullpen following that start and had 2.78 ERA for the remainder of the year. Garcia made 37 relief appearances for Altoona in 2018.

NO OFFENSE: Over the last seven games, the Richmond offense has been held to 13 total runs while hitting .157 (32/204). The Flying Squirrels have gone 4-for-45 (.089) with runners in scoring position and have left 45 runners on base in the last seven games. In the last seven games, the Flying Squirrels have been held to two or less runs in all but one game and four or less hits in five games.

ARENADO AWAKENS: After hitting .200 in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** is leading the Flying Squirrels with a .356 batting average on the season, which is ranked third in the Eastern League. He is also ranked fifth in the league with a .406 on-base percentage. He has at least one hit in 14 of his last 17 games.

JIN-DE'S RETURN: Flying Squirrels catcher **Jin-De Jhang** returns to Altoona, where he spent three seasons with the Curve from 2016-18. Jhang played 161 regular-season games for the Curve, posting a .271 average (158/583) with five homers. On September 14, 2017, Jhang hit a bases-clearing, three-run triple that helped lead the Curve to a 4-2 win over the Trenton Thunder in the clinching Game 3 of the Eastern League Championship Series.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27) and Miller (28).
