YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels rallied late but lost to the Altoona Curve, 8-6, in the series finale at PNG Field. Trailing 6-2 entering the eighth, **Hamlet Marte** clubbed a solo homer, his first of the season. Later in the frame, **Chris Shaw** brought home a run with a double and **Brock Stassi** tied the score with a two-run homer, his first of the year. Altoona answered in the bottom of the eighth with a two-run double by Bligh Madris. **Jalen Miller** hit his team-leading fourth homer of the year in the fourth to open the scoring. He brought in a second run with a bases-loaded walk in the top of the fourth. In the bottom of the inning, Altoona scored twice to tie the game. The Curve jumped ahead with a solo homer by Mitchell Tolman in the sixth and Jared Oliva brought in two more runs with a double later in the inning. Hunter Owen stretched the Curve lead to four with a solo homer in the seventh. Richmond starter **Alfred Gutierrez** worked 4.1 innings and allowed two runs on six hits.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of three games against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The game is also the fourth game of a six-game road trip to Altoona (1-2) and Bowie. The Flying Squirrels hosted the Baysox for a rain-shortened, two-game series at The Diamond on April 9 and 10, with the Squirrels taking the finale, 3-2, on a walk-off single by **Johneswhy Fargas**.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost nine of the last 11 games since April 16 and seven of eight since April 20. The Richmond offense ranks 10th in the league with a .216 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.44 team ERA, which is sixth in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have dropped four straight series (at Hartford, vs. Altoona, vs. Reading, at Altoona) and split the previous two (vs. Bowie, at Reading). The Flying Squirrels have not won a series since their season-opening set against Hartford at The Diamond.

THE BAYSOX hold the Eastern League's worst record and have lost 11 of the last 13 games, including dropping three-of-four against Akron at home in the previous series over the weekend. Bowie ranks last in the Eastern League with a .209 team batting average and last with a 4.46 team ERA. They Baysox have lost every series on the season so far except for a rain-shortened, two-game split with the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond on April 9 and 10. Bowie's roster features 10 of MLB.com's Top-30 Baltimore prospects, including Yusniel Diaz (1 - on IL), Ryan McKenna (7), Zac Lowther (8), Dean Kremer (9 - on IL), Hunter Harvey (12), Dillon Tate (18), Zach Pop (20), Rylan Bannon (23), Brett Cumberland (25) and Alex Wells (27).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Logan Webb** makes his fifth start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and second against the Baysox this year. He last faced Bowie on April 10 at The Diamond and allowed one earned run over 5.0 innings with four strikeouts in a no-decision. Last time out, he tied a career high with nine strikeouts and did not allow an earned run over 5.0 innings against Reading, but was charged with a loss. Webb is currently ranked 10th in the Eastern League with a 2.14 ERA. Webb made six starts for the Flying Squirrels in 2018. He went 1-1 with a 2.77 ERA through his first five starts, but allowed five of his 13 total earned runs at Double-A in his final start of the season. Webb is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 5 Giants prospect and the second-highest rated pitcher in the organization on that list. **For more on Webb, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander Bruce Zimmermann makes his fourth start of the season for the Baysox and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He pitched at The Diamond on April 10 and allowed one earned run over 5.0 innings in a no-decision. In his most recent start, Zimmermann faced Erie on the road and worked 5.0 innings, allowing one unearned run with a season-high seven strikeouts. A Baltimore native, Zimmermann was drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the fifth round in 2017 and was traded to the Orioles on August 11, 2018 along with RHP Evan Phillips, 3B Jean Carlos Encarnacion, C Brett Cumberland and future considerations in exchange for RHP Kevin Gausman and RHP Darren O'Day.

BATS ARE BACK: Over a six-game stretch from April 20-26, the Squirrels hit .126 (21/167) and scored five runs. Over the last two games since, the Richmond offense has hit .307 (23/75) and scored 14 runs. On Sunday, the Flying Squirrels tied a season high with three homers (**Jalen Miller**, **Hamlet Marte** and **Brock Stassi**).

ARENADO AWAKENS: After hitting .200 in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** is leading the Flying Squirrels with a .344 batting average on the season, which is ranked fourth in the Eastern League. He is also ranked fifth in the league with a .403 on-base percentage and ninth with a .911 OPS. Arenado has at least one hit in 14 of his last 18 games.

MILLER TIME: With his home run on Sunday, **Jalen Miller** now has four homers on the season, which is tied for fifth in the Eastern League and leads the Flying Squirrels. Miller is also tied for second in the Eastern League with five stolen bases. After hitting .375 through his first nine games of the season, Miller went 2-for-25 (.080) over an eight-game span from April 17-26. Over his last two games since, Miller is 3-for-9 (.333) with a homer and two RBIs.

BROCK STAR: Through his first eight games of the season, **Brock Stassi** hit .300 through April 16, but he made just one start from April 17-26. In that stretch, Stassi went 1-for-7 (.143) with one walk. Back in the starting lineup over the last two games, Stassi has gone 5-for-9 (.556) with a homer, a double and two RBIs.

HEEEEEATH: Over his first 16 games of the year, **Heath Quinn** hit .109 (5-for-46). In his last three games, Quinn has gone 5-for-13 (.385) with a double and an RBI, raising his season average by 50 points and has picked up his first two multi-hit games of the year.

HARRIS RETURNS TO BOWIE: Flying Squirrels manager **Willie Harris** played 133 games for the Bowie Baysox in the 2001 season, the third year of his professional career. That season, Harris hit .305 with nine homers and stole 54 bases. His 54 steals are ranked second in Baysox franchise history behind the 59 swipes by Curtis Goodwin in the 1994 season. Harris was named an Eastern League Post-Season All-Star in 2001 and went on to make his MLB debut that year for the Baltimore Orioles.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27) and Miller (28).
