YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels got off to a hot start but allowed three runs in the fifth and lost to the Bowie Baysox, 6-4. Chris Shaw led off the game with a solo homer in the top of the first inning, but Bowie answered in the bottom of the first inning when Rylan Bannon stole home on a pick-off throw to first base. The Baysox took a 2-1 lead in the second with a sac fly by lan Evans. In the third, Brock Stassi had an RBI double to tie the game, Jonah Arenado put the Flying Squirrels ahead with an RBI single and Hamlet Marte pushed the lead to 4-2 with a sac fly. Bowie closed back within a run in the fourth with an RBI double by Ryan McKenna. In the fifth, the Baysox tied the game with a solo homer by Jesmuel Valentin and Alexis Torres put Bowie ahead for good with a two-run homer by Alexis Torres. Conner Menez allowed a season-high four earned runs over 4.2 innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of three games against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The game is also the sixth game of a six-game road trip to Altoona (1-2) and Bowie (1-1). The Flying Squirrels hosted the Baysox for a rain-shortened, two-game series at The Diamond on April 9 and 10, with the Squirrels taking the finale, 3-2, on a walk-off single by **Johneswhy Fargas**. In today's rubber game, the Flying Squirrels are aiming to pick up their first series win since their season-opening set against the Hartford Yard Goats. The Baysox are looking to pick up their first series win of the year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost 10 of the last 13 games since April 16 and eight of 10 since April 20, but have picked up wins in two of their last four games since Saturday. The Richmond offense ranks 10th in the league with a .223 batting average, but has surged to third in the circuit with 17 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.51 team ERA, which is sixth in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have dropped four straight series (at Hartford, vs. Altoona, vs. Reading, at Altoona) and split the previous two (vs. Bowie, at Reading). The Flying Squirrels have not won a series since their season-opening set against Hartford at The Diamond.

THE BAYSOX hold the Eastern League's worst record and have lost 12 of the last 15 games. Bowie ranks 11th in the Eastern League with a .213 team batting average and last with a 4.38 team ERA. They Baysox have lost every series on the season so far except for a rain-shortened, two-game split with the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond on April 9 and 10. Bowie's roster features 10 of MLB.com's Top-30 Baltimore prospects, including Yusniel Diaz (1 - on IL), Ryan McKenna (7), Zac Lowther (8), Dean Kremer (9 - on IL), Hunter Harvey (12), Dillon Tate (18), Zach Pop (20), Rylan Bannon (23), Brett Cumberland (25) and Alex Wells (27).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Garrett Williams takes the mound for his fifth start of the season and his first against the Baysox. Last time out on Friday, Williams allowed season highs in earned runs (4) and hits (7) over four innings and was charged with his second straight loss. After posting a 3.00 ERA (3 ER/9.0 IP) over his first two starts with no walks, Williams has gone 0-2 with a 6.75 ERA (6 ER/8.0 IP) with five walks in his last two starts. He made 14 starts for Richmond last season and went 2-6 with a 6.00 ERA before moving to the bullpen when the calendar turned to July. As a reliever, he posted a 5.96 ERA in 18 appearances. Williams is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 21 Giants prospect and No. 20 by MLB.com. For more on Williams, see page two.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Hunter Harvey makes his fifth start of 2019 and his first against the Flying Squirrels this year. Last time out, he worked his first scoreless outing of the year, tossing 5.0 innings and allowing one hit in an no-decision against Akron on Thursday. Harvey surrendered at least four runs in each of his first three starts this season. Drafted in the first round by the Orioles in 2013 out of Bandys (N.C.) High School, Harvey is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 12 Orioles prospect. Harvey pitched in the Futures Game in 2014 at age 19, but injuries cost him time in nearly every season since. Harvey missed time with elbow injuries in 2014 and 2015 and had Tommy John surgery in 2016. After returning in 2017, he was shut down in June last year with a shoulder injury and was limited to nine starts with Bowie.

APRIL WRAP: For the month of April, the Flying Squirrels went 9-13 and sit fifth in the West, 10.5 games behind Harrisburg (21-4). **Jonah Arenado** ranked fifth in the league in batting average (.348), tied for seventh in on-base percentage (.400) and tenth in OPS (.907). **Jalen Miller** ranked tied for fourth in homers (5) and second in stolen bases (6). **Ryan Howard** ranked tied for seventh in walks (15). **Logan Webb** ranked tenth in the league in innings pitched (27.0) and tied with **Conner Menez** for third in the league with 31 strikeouts.

RISE AND SHINE: The Flying Squirrels are playing their second straight morning start and their fifth overall game starting before noon. In the four previous morning games on the season, the Squirrels have gone 1-3 and have lost each of the last three.

BATS ARE BACK: Over a six-game stretch from April 20-26, the Squirrels hit .126 (21/167) and scored five runs. Over the last four games since, the Richmond offense has hit .288 (42/146) and scored 21 runs. On Sunday, the Flying Squirrels tied a season high with three homers (Jalen Miller, Hamlet Marte and Brock Stassi) and matched that total on Monday in Bowie (Miller, Heath Quinn and Johneswhy Fargas). The Flying Squirrels have hit at least one homer in four consecutive games (8 total homers), the longest streak of the year.

ARENADO AWAKENS: After hitting .200 in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** is leading the Flying Squirrels with a .348 batting average on the season, which is ranked fifth in the Eastern League. Arenado has at least one hit in 16 of his last 20 games. He is also ranked tied for seventh in the league with a .400 on-base percentage and tenth with a .907 OPS.

MILLER TIME: With his home run on Monday, Jalen Miller now has five homers on the season, which is tied for fourth in the Eastern League and leads the Flying Squirrels. Miller is also second in the Eastern League with six stolen bases. After hitting .375 through his first nine games of the season, Miller went 2-for-25 (.080) over an eight-game span from April 17-26. Over his last four games since, Miller is 6-for-17 (.356) with two homers, a double and three RBIs.

BROCK STAR: Through his first eight games of the season, **Brock Stassi** hit .300 through April 16, but he made just one start from April 17-26. In that stretch, Stassi went 1-for-7 (143) with one walk. Over the last three starts, Stassi has gone 6-for-13 (.462) with a homer, two doubles and three RBIs.

WHEN THE LEVI BREAKS OUT: After going 0-for-22 from April 18-26, Levi Michael has picked up five hits in his last three games (5-for-12) and has added his first two stolen bases of the season. Michael is in his first season with the Flying Squirrels after spending most of last year with Binghamton, where he was an Eastern League Mid-Season and Post-Season All-Star.

HARRIS RETURNS TO BOWIE: Flying Squirrels manager Willie Harris played 133 games for the Bowie Baysox in the 2001 season, the third year of his professional career. That season, Harris hit .305 with nine homers and stole 54 bases. His 54 steals are ranked second in Baysox franchise history behind the 59 swipes by Curtis Goodwin in the 1994 season. Harris was named an Eastern League Post-Season All-Star in 2001 and went on to make his MLB debut that year for the Baltimore Orioles.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher Logan Webb (6), outfielder Chris Shaw (11), right-handed pitcher Melvin Adon (12), outfielder Heath Quinn (15), left-handed pitcher Garrett Williams (21), infielder Ryan Howard (24), left-handed pitcher Conner Menez (25) and infielder Jalen Miller (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27) and Miller (28).
