YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels topped the Bowie Baysox, 7-3, behind a start pitching performance by **Garrett Williams** and a four-homer game from the Richmond offense, tying a single-game franchise record. In his first game back from the I.L., **Jacob Heyward** homered on the first pitch of the game. Bowie scored a run in the bottom of the first and took a 2-1 lead in the second, but the Flying Squirrels stormed ahead in the third. Heyward hit a two-run homer and **Brock Stassi** followed him with a solo home run. Later in the inning, **Levi Michael** drove in a run and a fifth run scored on an error to open a 6-2 Squirrels lead. **Chris Shaw** hit Richmond's fourth homer of the game, a solo shot, in the seventh. Bowie pulled back within four in the eighth, but stranded the bases loaded. Williams allowed two runs over six innings for his first win of the year. Heyward finished the game with three hits, including hit two homers.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the first game of a four-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, and the first of a seven-game homestand against Altoona and Trenton. Tonight's game is the seventh of 21 games scheduled against Altoona this season and the fourth of 10 meetings at The Diamond. Altoona won two of three in the first series between the two teams from April 18-20, including two shutouts. The Curve also won two of three at PNG Field last weekend. This series marks the third consecutive weekend the two Western Division rivals have faced each other.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost 10 of the last 14 games since April 16 and eight of 11 since April 20, but have picked up wins in three of their last five games since Saturday. The Richmond offense ranks 10th in the league with a .224 batting average, but has surged to third in the circuit with 21 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.49 team ERA, which is seventh in the circuit. After dropping four straight series (at Hartford, vs. Altoona, vs. Reading, at Altoona) and splitting the previous two (vs. Bowie, at Reading), the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win since the first set of the year with two wins at Bowie this week.

THE CURVE have alternated wins and losses over their last six games. After taking two of three in Altoona last weekend, the Curve faced the Erie SeaWolves this week at home and dropped two of three. On Monday, Altoona was no-hit by SeaWolves pitcher and top Tigers prospect Casey Mize in his Double-A debut. Altoona pitchers have combined for a 3.13 ERA, which is fourth-best in the league. The Curve threw three straight shutouts against the Flying Squirrels, a double-header sweep on April 20 and the series opener in Altoona on April 26. Altoona offense is ranked fourth in the Eastern League with a .238 batting average. The Curve's roster includes two of MLB.com's Top-30 Pirates prospects, including Jared Oliva (12) and Stephen Alemais (26 - on IL).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Brandon Lawson** makes his second start with the Flying Squirrels. He faced Altoona in his season debut on Saturday and worked 3.2 innings, allowing four runs (two earned) on seven hits with four strikeouts. Lawson was signed as a minor-league free agent by the Giants on April 23 after being released by the Tampa Bay Rays near the end of spring training. He was originally drafted by the Rays in the 12th round in 2016 out of the University of South Florida and reached Double-A for 14 outings (five starts) last season with the Montgomery Biscuits. **For more on Lawson, see page two.**

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Pedro Vasquez makes his fifth start of the season for the Curve and his third against Richmond. He faced the Flying Squirrels in each of his last two starts. On April 20, he threw six scoreless innings and allowed one hit in a combined shutout in the second game of a double-header. Last Saturday, Vasquez worked five innings and allowed four earned runs in a no-decision. He made 12 starts and one relief appearance for Altoona last season, going 2-6 with a 5.12 ERA. He was originally a member of the Seattle Mariners organization and was traded to the Pirates on September 1, 2016 along with LHP Jake Brentz to complete a previous trade for Arquimedes Caminero.

BATS ARE BACK: Over a six-game stretch from April 20-26, the Squirrels hit .126 (21/167) and scored five runs. Over the last five games since, the Richmond offense has hit .285 (51/179) and scored 28 runs.

POWER SURGE: Through April 14, the Flying Squirrels were one of just four teams in all of minor league baseball without a home run hit. Since April 15, the Richmond offense has combined for 21 homers, which has moved the team into third in the Eastern League in home runs. Over the last five games, the Flying Squirrels have hit 12 homers. The team has homered in a season-high five straight games, including back-to-back three homer games on Sunday in Altoona and Monday in Bowie. On Wednesday at Bowie, the Flying Squirrels matched a franchise record with four homers in a single game (Two by **Jacob Heyward**, one each by **Brock Stassi** and **Chris Shaw**). It was the first four-homer game for the Flying Squirrels since 2016.

SAY HEYWARD: After missing eight days with a quad strain, **Jacob Heyward** returned to the lineup on Wednesday and homered on the first pitch of the game. He added a two-run homer in his next at-bat and singled later in the game. Heyward hit a home run on April 22 before going on the injured list the next day. Over his last three games played, Heyward is batting .500 (4-for-8) with three homers and four RBIs.

ARENADO AWAKENS: After hitting .200 in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** is leading the Flying Squirrels with a .333 batting average on the season, which is ranked sixth in the Eastern League. Arenado has at least one hit in 16 of his last 21 games.

MILLER TIME: With his home run on Monday, **Jalen Miller** now has five homers on the season, which is tied for fourth in the Eastern League and leads the Flying Squirrels. Miller is also second in the Eastern League with six stolen bases. After hitting .375 through his first nine games of the season, Miller went 2-for-25 (.080) over an eight-game span from April 17-26. Over his last five games since, Miller is 6-for-20 (.300) with two homers, a double and three RBIs.

BROCK STAR: Through his first eight games of the season, **Brock Stassi** hit .300 through April 16, but he made just one start from April 17-26. In that stretch, Stassi went 1-for-7 (.143) with one walk. Over the last four starts, Stassi has gone 7-for-17 (.412) with two homers, two doubles and four RBIs.

WHEN THE LEVI BREAKS OUT: After going 0-for-22 from April 18-26, **Levi Michael** has picked up six hits in his last four games (6-for-16) and has added his first two stolen bases of the season. Michael is in his first season with the Flying Squirrels after spending most of last year with Binghamton, where he was an Eastern League Mid-Season and Post-Season All-Star.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27) and Miller (28).
