**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost the homestand opener to the Altoona Curve, 9-2. **Hamlet Marte** gave the Flying Squirrels a 1-0 lead with an RBI double in the bottom of the second. Richmond starter **Brandon Lawson** faced the minimum over his first three innings before exiting after being struck by a line drive in the top of the fourth. Beginning in the third, Altoona scored in each inning through the eighth to open a 9-1 lead against the Flying Squirrels bullpen. **Jonah Arenado** hit a two-out RBI single in the ninth to pull within 9-2, but Altoona reliever Vicente Campos got the game's final out. Curve starter Pedro Vasquez allowed one run over 5.0 innings to pick up his second win of the year.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the second of a four-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, and the second of a seven-game homestand against Altoona (0-1) and Trenton. Tonight's game is the eighth of 21 games scheduled against Altoona this season and the fifth of 10 meetings at The Diamond. Altoona won two of three in the first series between the two teams from April 18-20, including two shutouts. The Curve also won two of three at PNG Field last weekend. This series marks the third consecutive weekend the two Western Division rivals have faced each other.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost 11 of the last 15 games since April 16 and nine of 12 since April 20, but have picked up wins in three of their last six games since Saturday. The Richmond offense ranks 10th in the league with a .221 batting average, but has surged to third in the circuit with 21 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.60 team ERA, which is eighth in the circuit. After dropping four straight series (at Hartford, vs. Altoona, vs. Reading, at Altoona) and splitting the previous two (vs. Bowie, at Reading), the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win since the first set of the year with two wins at Bowie this week.

**THE CURVE** have alternated wins and losses over their last seven games. After taking two of three in Altoona last weekend, the Curve faced the Erie SeaWolves this week at home and dropped two of three. On Monday, Altoona was no-hit by SeaWolves pitcher and top Tigers prospect Casey Mize in his Double-A debut. Altoona pitchers have combined for a 3.04 ERA, which is third-best in the league. The Curve threw three straight shutouts against the Flying Squirrels, a double-header sweep on April 20 and the series opener in Altoona on April 26. Altoona offense is ranked third in the Eastern League with a .243 batting average. Altoona has posted a 2.90 ERA (19 ER/59.0 IP) against Richmond on the year. The Curve's roster includes two of MLB.com's Top-30 Pirates prospects, including Jared Oliva (12) and Stephen Alemas (26 - on IL).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Alfred Gutierrez** makes his fifth start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his second straight against the Curve. Last time out, he threw 4.1 innings and allowed two earned runs in a no-decision at PNG Field on Sunday. Gutierrez is in his first season with the Giants organization after spending the previous seven with the Detroit Tigers. Last year, he spent time at three levels and made seven starts for the Erie SeaWolves in the Eastern League. He spent most of the season split between the starting rotation and bullpen with A-Adv. Lakeland and was named a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star. **For more on Gutierrez, see page two.**

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander Yeudy Garcia makes his second start of the season for the Curve. He made his first start on Sunday against the Flying Squirrels at PNG Field and threw 3.2 innings, allowing two earned runs in a no-decision. In five relief appearances this season Garcia posted a 0.82 ERA. Sunday was Garcia's first start since June 14, 2017, when he allowed five runs over 1.1 innings in a loss against Portland. He moved to the bullpen following that start and had 2.78 ERA for the remainder of the year. Garcia made 37 relief appearances for Altoona in 2018.

**BATS ARE BACK:** Over a six-game stretch from April 20-26, the Squirrels hit .126 (21/167) and scored five runs. Over the last five games since, the Richmond offense has hit .267 (56/210) and scored 30 runs (5.0 runs per game).

**POWER SURGE:** Through April 14, the Flying Squirrels were one of just four teams in all of minor league baseball without a home run hit. Since April 15, the Richmond offense has combined for 21 homers, which has moved the team into third in the Eastern League in home runs. Over the last six games, the Flying Squirrels have hit 12 homers. The team homered in a season-high five straight games from Saturday through Wednesday, including back-to-back three homer games on Sunday in Altoona and Monday in Bowie. On Wednesday at Bowie, the Flying Squirrels matched a franchise record with four homers in a single game (Two by **Jacob Heyward**, one each by **Brock Stassi** and **Chris Shaw**). It was the first four-homer game for the Flying Squirrels since 2016.

**SAY HEYWARD:** After missing eight days with a quad strain, **Jacob Heyward** returned to the lineup on Wednesday and homered on the first pitch of the game. He added a two-run homer in his next at-bat and singled later in the game. Heyward hit a home run on April 22 before going on the injured list the next day. Over his last four games played, Heyward is batting .367 (4-for-11) with three homers and four RBIs.

**ARENADO AWAKENS:** After hitting .200 in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** is leading the Flying Squirrels with a .338 batting average on the season, which is ranked third in the Eastern League. Arenado has at least one hit in 17 of his last 22 games. Against Altoona this year, Arenado is batting .474 (9-for-19) with a double, two homers and five RBIs over seven games.

**MILLER TIME:** With his home run on Monday, **Jalen Miller** now has five homers on the season, which is tied for fifth in the Eastern League and leads the Flying Squirrels. Miller is also second in the Eastern League with six stolen bases. After hitting .375 through his first nine games of the season, Miller went 2-for-25 (.080) over an eight-game span from April 17-26. Over his next five games, Miller hit 6-for-20 (.300) with two homers, a double and three RBIs, but he went 0-for-4 on Friday.

**BROCK STAR:** Through his first eight games of the season, **Brock Stassi** hit .300 through April 16, but he made just one start from April 17-26. In that stretch, Stassi went 1-for-7 (.143) with one walk. Over the last four starts, Stassi has gone 7-for-17 (.412) with two homers, two doubles and four RBIs.

**WHEN THE LEVI BREAKS OUT:** After going 0-for-22 from April 18-26, **Levi Michael** has picked up eight hits in his last five games (8-for-19) and has added his first two stolen bases of the season. Michael is in his first season with the Flying Squirrels after spending most of last year with Binghamton, where he was an Eastern League Mid-Season and Post-Season All-Star.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27) and Miller (28).
