YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost their third straight game, falling 8-3 to the Altoona Curve. Altoona jumped ahead early with a run in the second and added seven runs in the third inning, assisted by six walks from Richmond pitching. The Flying Squirrels broke into the scoring column with an RBI single by Johneshwy Fargas in the bottom of the fourth. In the fifth, Heath Quinn hit a solo homer and Jalen Miller scored on a wild pitch to close the gap to 8-3. Altoona starter Cam Vieaux allowed three runs over five innings. Richmond relievers Melvin Adon and Tyler Cyr combined for 3.0 scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a four-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, and the fourth of a seven-game homestand against Altoona (0-3) and Trenton. Today's game is the tenth of 21 games scheduled against Altoona this season and the seventh of 10 meetings at The Diamond. Altoona won two of three in the first series between the two teams from April 18-20, including two shutouts. The Curve also won two of three at PNG Field last weekend. This series marks the third consecutive weekend the two Western Division rivals have faced each other. Altoona is looking to sweep a four-game series against the Flying Squirrels for the first time since 2016.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost 13 of the last 17 games since April 16 and 11 of 14 since April 20. The Richmond offense ranks seventh in the league with a .229 batting average and has surged to third in the circuit with 22 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 4.04 team ERA, which is tenth in the circuit. After dropping four straight series (at Hartford, vs. Altoona, vs. Reading, at Altoona) and splitting the previous two (vs. Bowie, at Reading), the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win since the first set of the year with two wins at Bowie this week, but have lost the series against Altoona.

THE CURVE alternated wins and losses over seven games and picked up their third straight win on Friday. After taking two of three in Altoona last weekend against the Flying Squirrels, the Curve faced the Erie SeaWolves this week at home and dropped two of three. On Monday, Altoona was no-hit by SeaWolves pitcher and top Tigers prospect Casey Mize in his Double-A debut. Altoona pitchers have combined for a 3.19 ERA, which is fifth-best in the league. The Curve threw three straight shutouts against the Flying Squirrels, a double-header sweep on April 20 and the series opener in Altoona on April 26. Altoona's offense is ranked fourth in the Eastern League with a .246 batting average. The Curve's roster includes two of MLB.com's Top-30 Pirates prospects, including Jared Oliva (12) and Stephen Alemais (26 - on IL).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Conner Menez** makes his sixth start of the season and his second against Altoona. Last time out, he allowed a season-high four earned runs over 4.2 innings at Bowie on Tuesday. He last faced the Curve on April 18 at The Diamond and picked up his lone win of the season so far, working five innings and allowing one earned run with eight strikeouts. Menez is ranked tied for eighth in the league with 31 strikeouts. Last year, Menez spent most of the season with Richmond, going 6-4 with a 4.38 ERA in 15 starts. He also pitched 11 games with A-Adv. San Jose and one with Triple-A Sacramento, combining to go 9-10 with a 4.46 ERA in 28 total starts across the three levels. Menez led the Giants organization with 171 total strikeouts, 32 ahead of second-place John Gavin. It was also tied for the fourth-most strikeouts in the minors (led by Dean Kremer of the Orioles organization). Menez is in his fourth professional season and was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 14th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of the Master's University. He entered this season ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 25 Giants prospect. *For more on Menez, see page two.*

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander **Scooter Hightower** makes his sixth start of the season and his seventh overall appearance. He last pitched on Tuesday against Erie and worked six innings, allowing one earned run to pick up his first win of the year. Hightower faced Richmond on April 18 at The Diamond and allowed a season-high four earned runs over 4.0 innings in a loss. Last year, Hightower made seven starts and four relief outings for Altoona, combining to go 2-1 with a 2.41 ERA. For the year between Altoona and Bradenton, Hightower went 7-1 with a 1.99 ERA in 2018.

BATS ARE BACK: Over a six-game stretch from April 20-26, the Squirrels hit .126 (21/167) and scored five runs. Over the last nine games since, dating back to April 27, the Richmond offense has hit .277 (77/278) and scored 40 runs (4.4 runs per game). The team combined for 12 homers over a five-game span from April 27-May 1, but has hit one over the last three games on this homestand.

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit five home runs at home this season through 15 games (0.33 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 17 homers on the road in 11 games (1.55 per game), more than any other team in the league. Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

PITCH IT: Through April 22 in the first 15 games of the season, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 2.62 ERA (37 ER/127.0 IP), which was second-best in the Eastern League. Richmond starters had a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) and relievers had a 2.70 ERA (18 ER/60.0 IP). Over the last 11 games dating back to April 23, Richmond pitchers have posted a 5.91 ERA (63 ER/96.0 IP). In that time, starters have a 4.96 ERA (27 ER/49.0) and relievers have a 6.89 ERA (36 ER/47.0).

SAY HEYWARD: After missing eight days with a quad strain, **Jacob Heyward** returned to the lineup on Wednesday and homered on the first pitch of the game. He added a two-run homer in his next at-bat and singled later in the game. Heyward hit a home run on April 22 before going on the injured list the next day. Over his last four games played, Heyward is batting .333 (5-for-15) with three homers and four RBIs.

ARENADO AWAKENS: After hitting .200 in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** is leading the Flying Squirrels with a .329 batting average on the season, which is ranked seventh in the Eastern League. He is also ranked sixth in the league with a .402 on-base percentage. Arenado has at least one hit in 18 of his last 24 games. Against Altoona this year, Arenado is batting .407 (11-for-27) with three doubles, two homers and five RBIs over nine games.

MILLER TIME: With his home run on Monday, **Jalen Miller** now has five homers on the season, which is tied for fifth in the Eastern League and leads the Flying Squirrels. Miller is also tied for second in the Eastern League with seven stolen bases. After hitting .375 through his first nine games of the season, Miller went 2-for-25 (.080) over an eight-game span from April 17-26. Over his last eight games, Miller has hit .241 (7-for-29) with two homers, three RBIs and seven walks.

BROCK STAR: Through his first eight games of the season, **Brock Stassi** hit .300 through April 16, but he made just one start from April 17-26. In that stretch, Stassi went 1-for-7 (.143) with one walk. Over the last six games, Stassi has gone 10-for-22 (.455) with two homers, two doubles and six RBIs.

WHEN THE LEVI BREAKS OUT: After going 0-for-22 from April 18-26, **Levi Michael** has picked up nine hits in his last seven games (9-for-27 / .333). Michael is in his first season with the Flying Squirrels after spending most of last year with Binghamton, where he was an Eastern League Mid-Season and Post-Season All-Star.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27) and Miller (28).
