**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels snapped a three-game slide with a 6-0 win over the Altoona Curve in the finale of a four-game set on Sunday afternoon. **Brock Stassi** opened the scoring with an RBI single in the bottom of the third. Later in the inning, **Jacob Heyward** drove a three-run homer to open a 4-0 lead. In the fifth, **Chris Shaw** and **Jalen Miller** drove back-to-back homers to stretch the lead to 6-0. Richmond starter **Conner Menez** worked 6.0 innings without allowing a run and held Altoona to one hit with no walks and eight strikeouts. **Rodolfo Martinez** threw a scoreless seventh inning and **Ryan Halstead** threw two scoreless innings to finish the game.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the first of a three-game series against the Trenton Thunder, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, and the fifth of a seven-game homestand against Altoona (1-3) and Trenton. The Thunder and the Flying Squirrels face each other in six games this year, this three-game series at The Diamond and a three-game series at Trenton's ARM & HAMMER Park from June 18-20. Last year, the Flying Squirrels went 8-7 against the Thunder, including a 2-2 mark and home.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost 13 of the last 18 games since April 16 and 11 of 15 since April 20. The Richmond offense ranks seventh in the league with a .228 batting average and has surged to second in the circuit with 25 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.88 team ERA, which is ninth in the circuit. After dropping four straight series (at Hartford, vs. Altoona, vs. Reading, at Altoona) and splitting the previous two (vs. Bowie, at Reading), the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win since the first set of the year with two wins at Bowie this week, but lost the next series against Altoona.

**THE THUNDER** are tied for first place in the Western Division. After winning five straight games from April 27-30, the Thunder have gone 1-3 in May so far, including dropping two of three at Harrisburg over the weekend. The Thunder are ranked eighth in the league with a 3.84 team ERA and third offensively with a .247 team batting average. The Trenton roster features six of MLB.com's Top-30 Yankees prospects, including Albert Abreu (3), Deivi Garcia (4), Trevor Stephan (8 - on IL), Nick Nelson (11 - on IL), Garrett Whitlock (16 - on IL) and Domingo Acevedo (23).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Garrett Williams** takes the mound for his sixth start of the season and his first against the Thunder. Last time out, Williams picked up his first win of the season with six innings of work at Bowie on Wednesday, allowing two earned runs with no walks and six strikeouts. He made 14 starts for Richmond last season and went 2-6 with a 6.00 ERA before moving to the bullpen when the calendar turned to July. As a reliever, he posted a 5.96 ERA in 18 appearances. Williams is ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 21 Giants prospect and No. 20 by *MLB.com*. **For more on Williams, see page two.**

**FOR TRENTON:** Right-hander **Brody Koerner** makes his fifth start of the season for the Thunder. In his most recent start, Koerner worked four innings and allowed one unearned run in a no-decision against New Hampshire. He also pitched one inning in a start for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on April 26 and allowed one run. He did not allow a run over his first two starts of the season for the Thunder (totaling 8.0 IP) before allowing five runs (three earned) in a loss against Akron on April 17. Koerner is in his third season with the Thunder and made 12 appearances (two starts) in 2018, going 1-1 with a 3.33 ERA. He was drafted by the Yankees in the 17th round in 2015 out of Clemson.

**BATS ARE BACK:** Over a six-game stretch from April 20-26, the Squirrels hit .126 (21/167) and scored five runs. Over the last 10 games since, dating back to April 27, the Richmond offense has hit .257 (87/338) and scored 46 runs (4.6 runs per game). The team has also combined to hit 16 homers during that span.

**HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T:** The Flying Squirrels have hit eight home runs at home this season through 16 games (0.50 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

**FREQUENT FLYERS:** In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 17 homers on the road in 11 games (1.55 per game), more than any other team in the league. Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

**PITCH IT:** Through April 22 in the first 15 games of the season, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 2.62 ERA (37 ER/127.0 IP), which was second-best in the Eastern League. Richmond starters had a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) and relievers had a 2.70 ERA (18 ER/60.0 IP). Over the last 12 games dating back to April 23, Richmond pitchers have posted a 5.40 ERA (63 ER/105.0 IP). In that time, starters have a 4.42 ERA (27 ER/55.0) and relievers have a 6.48 ERA (36 ER/50.0).

**SAY HEYWARD:** After missing eight days with a quad strain, **Jacob Heyward** returned to the lineup on Wednesday and homered on the first pitch of the game. He added a two-run homer in his next at-bat and singled later in the game. Heyward hit a home run on April 22 before going on the injured list the next day. Over his last six games played, Heyward is batting .380 (8-for-21) with four homers and 10 RBIs. Heyward was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday.

**ARENADO AWAKENS:** After hitting .200 in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** is leading the Flying Squirrels with a .318 batting average on the season, which is ranked ninth in the Eastern League. Arenado has at least one hit in 18 of his last 25 games.

**MILLER TIME:** With his home run on Sunday, **Jalen Miller** now has six homers on the season, which is tied for fourth in the Eastern League and leads the Flying Squirrels. Miller is also tied for third in the Eastern League with seven stolen bases. After hitting .375 through his first nine games of the season, Miller went 2-for-25 (.080) over an eight-game span from April 17-26. Over his last nine games, Miller has hit .242 (8-for-33) with three homers, four RBIs and seven walks.

**BROCK STAR:** Through his first eight games of the season, **Brock Stassi** hit .300 through April 16, but he made just one start from April 17-26. In that stretch, Stassi went 1-for-7 (.143) with one walk. Over the last seven games, Stassi has gone 11-for-26 (.423) with two homers, two doubles and seven RBIs.

**SHAWESOME:** Through his first 10 games of the season, **Chris Shaw** hit .323 with two homers and seven RBIs. Over his next three games from April 20-22, Shaw went 0-for-9. In 11 games since April 23, Shaw has hit .310 (13-for-42) with two doubles, a triple, three homers and eight RBIs.

**WHEN THE LEVI BREAKS OUT:** After going 0-for-22 from April 18-26, **Levi Michael** has picked up nine hits in his last seven games (9-for-27 / .333). Michael is in his first season with the Flying Squirrels after spending most of last year with Binghamton, where he was an Eastern League Mid-Season and Post-Season All-Star.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Seven players are also on *MLB.com*'s top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27) and Miller (28).
