**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Trenton Thunder, 8-3. Trenton opened an early lead with a three-run homer by Rashad Crawford in the second inning. The Flying Squirrels chipped away with a run in the fifth on a sac fly by Jalen Miller. In the sixth, Hamlet Marte tripled and Johneshwy Fargas followed with a two-run homer to tie the score. Trenton moved back in front with an RBI triple by Omar Carrizales in the top of the seventh and later scored on a single from Angel Aguilar. In the eighth, Chris Gittens extended the lead with an RBI single and Bradon Wagner added a run to open an 8-3 Thunder lead. Richmond starter Brandon Lawson worked 5.0 inning and allowed three runs.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a three-game series against the Trenton Thunder, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, and the last of a seven-game homestand against Altoona (1-3) and Trenton (0-2). The Thunder and the Flying Squirrels face each other in six games this year, including this three-game series at The Diamond and a three-game series at Trenton's ARM & HAMMER Park from June 18-20. Last year, the Flying Squirrels went 8-7 against the Thunder, including a 2-2 mark and home.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost 15 of the last 20 games since April 16 and 13 of 17 since April 20. The Richmond offense ranks seventh in the league with a .231 batting average and has surged to second in the circuit with 25 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 4.00 team ERA, which is tenth in the circuit. After dropping four straight series (at Hartford, vs. Altoona, vs. Reading, at Altoona) and splitting the previous two (vs. Bowie, at Reading), the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win since the first set of the year with two wins at Bowie this week, but lost the next two series against Altoona and Trenton.

**THE THUNDER** are in first place in the Western Division. After winning five straight games from April 27-30, the Thunder have gone 3-3 in May so far, including dropping two of three at Harrisburg over the weekend. The Thunder are ranked eighth in the league with a 3.74 team ERA and second offensively with a .251 team batting average. The Trenton roster features six of MLB.com's Top-30 Yankees prospects, including Albert Abreu (3), Deivi Garcia (4), Trevor Stephan (8 - on IL), Nick Nelson (11 - on IL), Garrett Whitlock (16 - on IL) and Domingo Acevedo (23).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander Andrew Moore makes his Giants organizational debut. He began the season in the Tampa Bay organization with Triple-A Durham, where he went 0-2 with a 12.98 ERA in five appearances, four of which were starts. He last pitched on April 28 at Columbus and allowed three runs over 2.2 innings with a season-high five walks. Moore was originally drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the second round (Competitive Balance Round B - 72nd overall). He made 11 MLB appearances, including nine starts, with the Mariners in 2017. Moore was traded along with RHP Tommy Romero to the Rays for RHP Alex Colome and LF Denard Span on May 25, 2018. **For more on Moore, see page two.**

**FOR TRENTON:** Rated by MLB.com as the No. 4 Yankees prospect, right-hander Deivi Garcia makes his second start for the Thunder. In his first Trenton start of the year last Wednesday, Garcia allowed four runs over four innings with five walks and 11 strikeouts against New Hampshire. Garcia made four starts for A-Adv. Tampa, going 0-2 with a 3.06 ERA before being promoted to Double-A. He also made one start with the Thunder last year, working 5.0 scoreless innings against Reading with seven strikeouts.

**BATS ARE BACK:** Over a six-game stretch from April 20-26, the Squirrels hit .126 (21/167) and scored five runs. Over the last 11 games since, dating back to April 27, the Richmond offense has hit .269 (102/379) and scored 51 runs (4.6 runs per game). The team has also combined to hit 17 homers during that span.

**HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T:** The Flying Squirrels have hit nine home runs at home this season through 18 games (0.50 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

**FREQUENT FLYERS:** In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 17 homers on the road in 11 games (1.55 per game), more than any other team in the league. Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

**PITCH IT:** Through April 22 in the first 15 games of the season, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 2.62 ERA (37 ER/127.0 IP), which was second-best in the Eastern League. Richmond starters had a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) and relievers had a 2.70 ERA (18 ER/60.0 IP). Over the last 14 games dating back to April 23, Richmond pitchers have posted a 5.41 ERA (74 ER/123.0 IP). In that time, starters have a 4.43 ERA (30 ER/61.0) and relievers have a 6.39 ERA (44 ER/62.0).

**BROCK STAR:** Through his first eight games of the season, Brock Stassi hit .300 through April 16, but he made just one start from April 17-26. In that stretch, Stassi went 1-for-7 (.143) with one walk. Over the last nine games, Stassi has gone 12-for-32 (.375) with two homers, two doubles and seven RBIs. He currently leads all qualified Richmond batters with a .319 average, which is tied for ninth in the Eastern League.

**HITS FOR HEALTH:** After hitting .086 (3-for-35) through his first 13 games of the season, Heath Quinn has compiled a 14-game on-base streak dating back to April 22, during which he has hit .320 (16-for-50) with three doubles, two homers, six RBIs and five walks, raising his season batting average to .224. Over his last 11 games, Quinn has combined to hit .359 (14-for-39).

**SAY HEYWARD:** After missing eight days with a quad strain, Jacob Heyward returned to the lineup last Wednesday and homered on the first pitch of the game. He added a two-run homer in his next at-bat and singled later in the game. Heyward hit a home run on April 22 before going on the injured list the next day. Over his last eight games played, Heyward is batting .370 (10-for-27) with four homers and 10 RBIs. Heyward was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday.

**ARENADO AWAKENS:** After hitting .200 in 2018, Jonah Arenado is second on the Flying Squirrels with a .301 batting average on the season. Arenado has at least one hit in 19 of his last 27 games.

**MILLER TIME:** With his home run on Sunday, Jalen Miller now has six homers on the season, which is tied for fifth in the Eastern League and leads the Flying Squirrels. Miller is also first in the Eastern League with nine stolen bases and ranks fourth in the league in TPA/SO ratio (8.14). After hitting .375 through his first nine games of the season, Miller went 2-for-25 (.080) over an eight-game span from April 17-26. Over his last 11 games, Miller has hit .244 (10-for-41) with three homers, five RBIs, seven walks and five stolen bases.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher Logan Webb (6), outfielder Chris Shaw (11), right-handed pitcher Melvin Adon (12), outfielder Heath Quinn (15), left-handed pitcher Garrett Williams (21), infielder Ryan Howard (24), left-handed pitcher Conner Menez (25) and infielder Jalen Miller (30). Seven players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27) and Miller (28).
