THURSDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost their fourth straight game with an 8-5 loss to the Bowie Baysox. Ademar Rifa opened the scoring in the first with an RBI double. It was the only run allowed by **Alfred Gutierrez** while working a season-high 5.0 innings. The Flying Squirrels loaded the bases in the fifth but could not plate a run. In the sixth, Brett Cumberland worked a bases-loaded walk and Ryan McKenna scored on a wild pitch. Preston Palmeiro hit a grand slam to open a 7-0 Baysox lead. In the seventh, Rylan Bannon added a run with a sac fly to extend Bowie's lead to 8-0. The Flying Squirrels chipped away with a two-run homer from **Chris Shaw** and **Jalen Miller** followed with a solo shot, the second time they have gone back-to-back this week. In the ninth, Shaw doubled home a run and Miller added a run-scoring groundout to close within three, but the Squirrels left the potential tying run in the on-deck circle.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, at Prince George's Stadium. It is also the second of a six-game road trip to Bowie (0-1) and Erie. The Flying Squirrels and Baysox have played two previous series this year, a two-game, rain-shortened split at The Diamond on April 9 and 10 and a three-game series, with two Richmond wins, in Bowie from April 29-May 1. The Baysox return to Richmond for a three-day, four-game series from July 22-24 and again from August 9-11. The Flying Squirrels are immediately back in Bowie for a three-game series from August 13-15. The two teams clash for four games in the final series of the 2019 season at The Diamond from August 30-September 2.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost 17 of the last 22 games since April 16 and six of seven since May 2. The Richmond offense ranks seventh in the league with a .229 batting average and are tied for second with 28 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 4.15 team ERA, which is tenth in the circuit. After dropping four straight series (at Hartford, vs. Altoona, vs. Reading, at Altoona) and splitting the previous two (vs. Bowie, at Reading), the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win since the first set of the year with two wins at Bowie from April 29-May 1, but lost the next two series against Altoona and Trenton.

THE BAYSOX hold the Eastern League's worst record, but won three of the last four. The Baysox won two of three at Altoona this week, outscoring the Curve 24-10. Prior to that series, the Baysox had lost eight of their nine sets this year, with the lone exception being a two-game, rain-shortened split in Richmond from April 9-10. Bowie ranks 11th in the league with a .217 team batting average and last with a 4.24 team ERA. The Bowie roster features nine of MLB.com's Top-30 Orioles prospects, including Yusniel Diaz (1 - on IL), Ryan McKenna (7), Zac Lowther (8), Hunter Harvey (12), Dillon Tate (18 - on IL), Zach Pop (20), Rylan Bannon (23), Brett Cumberland (25) and Alex Wells (27).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Conner Menez** makes his seventh start of the season and his second against the Baysox. He last pitched on Sunday against Altoona and picked up a win after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings and allowing one hit with no walks and eight strikeouts. He last faced Bowie on April 30 at Prince George's Stadium, tied for his second-shortest outing of the year (4.2 IP) and he allowed season highs in runs (4), hits (7) and walks (3). Menez is ranked tenth in the league in ERA (2.01), tied for fourth in strikeouts (39), fourth in opponents' batting average (.174) and fifth in WHIP (0.89). Last year, Menez spent most of the season with Richmond, going 6-4 with a 4.38 ERA in 15 starts. He also pitched 11 games with A-Adv. San Jose and one with Triple-A Sacramento, combining to go 9-10 with a 4.46 ERA in 28 total starts across the three levels. Menez led the Giants organization with 171 total strikeouts, 32 ahead of second-place John Gavin. It was also tied for the fourth-most strikeouts in the minors (led by Dean Kremer of the Orioles organization). Menez is in his fourth professional season and was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 14th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of the Master's University. He entered this season ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 25 Giants prospect. **For more on Menez, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander **Marcos Molina** makes his seventh start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. In his most recent start, Molina was charged with a loss while working his shortest outing of the year (3.2 IP) and matched season highs in runs allowed (4) and walks (4). Originally a member of the New York Mets organization, Molina spent the last two seasons primarily with Double-A Binghamton. Last year, Molina went 1-9 with the Rumble Ponies in 14 starts with a 6.66 ERA.

JUST THE HITS: Over a six-game stretch from April 20-26, the Squirrels hit .126 (21/167) and scored five runs. Over the last 12 games since, dating back to April 27, the Richmond offense has hit .263 (108/411) and scored 51 runs (4.3 runs per game). The team has also combined to hit 17 homers during that span.

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit nine home runs at home this season through 19 games (.042 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/.028 per game).

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 19 homers on the road in 12 games (1.58 per game), more than any other team in the league. Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

PITCH IT: Through April 22 in the first 15 games of the season, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 2.62 ERA (37 ER/127.0 IP), which was second-best in the Eastern League. Richmond starters had a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) and relievers had had a 2.70 ERA (18 ER/60.0 IP). Over the last 16 games dating back to April 23, Richmond pitchers have posted a 5.53 ERA (86 ER/140.0 IP). In that time, starters have a 5.03 ERA (36 ER/67.2) and relievers have a 6.47 ERA (52 ER/72.1).

LOOKING FOR LENGTH: Of the Flying Squirrels' 31 games this season, starting pitchers have failed to work at least 5.0 innings in 16 games. Over the last 14 games since April 26, Richmond starters have failed to reach the fifth inning nine times. In the last six games, starting pitchers have not reached the third inning three times, with outings of 2.1 IP (**Sandro Cabrera** - 5/4), 1.0 IP (**Garrett Williams** - 5/6) and 1.2 IP (**Andrew Moore** - 5/8). On the year, Richmond starters have gone 6.0 IP five times, 5.0 IP ten times, 4.2 IP twice, 4.1 IP once, 4.0 IP six times, 3.2 IP twice, 3.0 IP once, 2.1 IP once, 1.2 IP twice and 1.0 IP once.

HITS FOR HEATH: After hitting .086 (3-for-35) through his first 13 games of the season, **Heath Quinn** has compiled a 16-game on-base streak dating back to April 22, during which he has hit .286 (16-for-56) with three doubles, two homers, six RBIs and seven walks, raising his season batting average to .209. Over his last 13 games, Quinn has combined to hit .311 (14-for-45).

SAY HEYWARD: After missing eight days with a quad strain, **Jacob Heyward** returned to the lineup on May 1 and homered on the first pitch of the game. He added a two-run homer in his next at-bat and singled later in the game. Heyward hit a home run on April 22 before going on the injured list the next day. In his current 11-game on-base streak, Heyward is batting .303 (10-for-33) with four homers, 10 RBIs and nine walks. On the year, he is tied for fourth in the league with 20 walks. Heyward was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday.

SHAWESOME: On Friday, **Chris Shaw** clubbed his sixth homer of the season, which was tied for the most on the team until **Jalen Miller** went deep in the next at-bat, the second time the pair has connected on consecutive homers this week. For the season, Shaw is ranked tied for seventh in the league in homers (6), sits seventh in slugging percentage (.541), ninth in OPS (.901) and tenth in total bases (53).

ARENADO AWAKENS: After hitting .200 in 2018, **Jonah Arenado** is second on the Flying Squirrels among qualified hitters with a .299 batting average on the season. Arenado has at least one hit in 20 of his last 28 games.

MILLER TIME: With his home run on Friday, **Jalen Miller** now has seven homers on the season, which is tied for third in the Eastern League and leads the Flying Squirrels. Miller is also tied for first in the Eastern League with nine stolen bases. After hitting .375 through his first nine games of the season, Miller went 2-for-25 (.080) over an eight-game span from April 17-26. Over his last 13 games, Miller has hit .265 (13-for-49) with four homers, seven RBIs, nine walks and five stolen bases.

FARGAS ON FIRE: Outfielder **Johnheshwy Fargas** hit .185 through his first 16 games of the year through April 28. In his last eight games since April 29, Fargas has hit .286 (8-for-28) with two homers, five RBIs, four runs scored and three stolen bases. Fargas is tied for seventh in the Eastern League with six stolen bases this year.
