YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped a five-game losing streak with a 6-5 win over the Erie SeaWolves, despite committing a franchise-record seven errors and striking out 15 times. Facing his former team for the first time, **Will Maddox** hit a home run on the first pitch of the game from Tigers prospect Alex Faedo. Erie knotted the score at 1-1 in the bottom of the first. In the second, **Jin-De Jhang** hit a go-ahead RBI single. **Gio Brusa** hit a solo home run in the fourth for his first Double-A hit. In the fifth, **Chris Shaw** clubbed a three-run homer to open a 6-1 lead. Erie scored three runs in the bottom of the fifth and added a run in the seventh to close within a run, but **Melvin Adon** finished the ninth to pick up his third save. Richmond starter **Brandon Lawson** allowed four runs (two earned) over 5.0 innings to pick up his first win.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It is also the fourth of a five-game road trip to Bowie (0-2) and Erie (1-0). The series is the first set of the year between the Flying Squirrels and the SeaWolves. Erie comes to Richmond for a four-game series from July 18-21 and a three-game set from August 19-21. The Flying Squirrels return to Erie for four games from August 26-29. The Flying Squirrels snapped a five-game losing streak with Monday's win. On the season, Richmond is 3-8 in games following a win. Richmond is also 0-5 on Tuesdays this year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost 18 of the last 25 games since April 16 and eight of ten since May 2. The Richmond offense ranks eighth in the league with a .225 batting average and are second with 31 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 4.07 team ERA, which is tenth in the circuit. After dropping four straight series (at Hartford, vs. Altoona, vs. Reading, at Altoona) and splitting the previous two (vs. Bowie, at Reading), the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win since the first set of the year with two wins at Bowie from April 29-May 1, but lost the next three series against Altoona, Trenton and Bowie.

THE SEAWOLVES sit in a tie for second place in the Eastern League Western Division but have lost three of their last four games. Erie leads the Eastern League in team batting average (.264), is tied for first in runs scored (158) and sit first in triples (14). The SeaWolves have a 3.24 team ERA, which is fourth in the league. The Erie roster features 10 of MLB.com's Top-30 Tigers prospects, including Casey Mize (1), Matt Manning (2), Isaac Paredes (4), Alex Faedo (10), Jake Rogers (13), Sergio Alcantara (15), Logan Shore (16), Anthony Castro (23), Gregory Soto (26) and Jose Azocar (30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Caleb Baragar makes the first start of his Double-A career. He made his Double-A debut in Bowie on Friday and allowed four unearned runs in 0.2 IP. He made one start with Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. He began the season with A-Adv. San Jose and went 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA in four starts and one relief outing. Baragar was drafted by the Giants in the ninth round in 2016 out of Indiana University and is in his fourth professional season. **For more on Baragar, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Anthony Castro makes his fourth start of the season and his eighth overall appearance of the year for the SeaWolves. Last time out, Castro worked 2.0 innings against Akron on Thursday and allowed three runs (two earned) with four walks and one strikeout. He began the season in the bullpen and posted a 6.48 ERA before moving to the rotation on April 27. As a starter, Castro has gone 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA. He spent most of 2018 with A-Adv. Lakeland, but made three starts for Erie in June, posting an 8.10 ERA with no wins or losses.

PLUS/MINUS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels rank last in the Eastern League in run differential at -48 (108 runs scored / 156 runs allowed). The Erie SeaWolves have the best run differential in the league at +51 (163 runs scored / 112 runs against).

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit nine home runs at home this season through 19 games (0.42 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 22 homers on the road in 14 games (1.57 per game), more than any other team in the league. Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

PITCH IT: Through April 22 in the first 15 games of the season, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 2.62 ERA (37 ER/127.0 IP), which was second-best in the Eastern League. Richmond starters had a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) and relievers had a 2.70 ERA (18 ER/60.0 IP). Over the last 18 games dating back to April 23, Richmond pitchers have posted a 5.25 ERA (91 ER/156.0 IP).

LOOKING FOR LENGTH: Of the Flying Squirrels' 33 games this season, starting pitchers have failed to work at least 5.0 innings in 17 games. Over the last 16 games since April 26, Richmond starters have failed to reach the fifth inning 10 times. On the year, Richmond starters have gone 6.0 IP five times, 5.0 IP 11 times, 4.2 IP twice, 4.1 IP twice, 4.0 IP six times, 3.2 IP twice, 3.0 IP once, 2.1 IP once, 1.2 IP twice and 1.0 IP once.

HITS FOR HEATH: After hitting .086 (3-for-35) through his first 13 games of the season, **Heath Quinn** has compiled an 18-game on-base streak dating back to April 22, during which he has hit .267 (16-for-60) with three doubles, two homers, six RBIs and ten walks. The on-base streak is the longest active streak in the Eastern League and the third-longest in the league this season. Over his last 15 games, Quinn has combined to hit .286 (14-for-49).

SHAWESOME: On Monday, **Chris Shaw** clubbed his seventh homer of the season, which is tied for the most on the team with **Jalen Miller** and tied for third in the Eastern League. For the season, Shaw is ranked seventh in the league in slugging percentage (.552), eighth in OPS (.914) and tied for eighth in total bases (58). Over his last 17 games since April 23, Shaw is batting .292 (19-for-65) with five homers, three doubles, a triple, 14 RBIs, seven walks and 11 runs scored. Shaw has homered five times over his last 12 games since April 30.

MILLER TIME: With his home run on Friday, **Jalen Miller** now has seven homers on the season, which is tied for third in the Eastern League and tied with **Chris Shaw** for the Flying Squirrels team lead. Miller is also first in the Eastern League with 10 stolen bases. After hitting .375 through his first nine games of the season, Miller went 2-for-25 (.080) over an eight-game span from April 17-26. Over his last 15 games, Miller has hit .250 (14-for-56) with four homers, seven RBIs, ten walks and five stolen bases.

FARGAS ON FIRE: Outfielder **Johneshwy Fargas** hit .185 through his first 16 games of the year through April 28. In his last nine games since April 29, Fargas has hit .290 (9-for-31) with two homers, five RBIs, four runs scored and three stolen bases. Fargas is tied for tenth in the Eastern League with six stolen bases this year.

HEY NOW, WE'VE GOT ALL-STARS: The 2019 Flying Squirrels roster has included five players who have been named as an Eastern League All-Star in previous seasons: **Ryan Howard** (2018), **Will Maddox** (2018), **Levi Michael** (2018), **Tyler Cyr** (2017) and **Brock Stassi** (2015).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).
