YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost a late lead and fell to the Erie SeaWolves, 4-3. Erie struck first with a solo homer by Kade Scivicque in the bottom of the third. In the fourth, **Heath Quinn** put Richmond ahead with a two-run triple, extending his on-base streak to 19 games. Erie jumped ahead, 3-2, with a two-out, two-strike double by Cam Gibson in the bottom of the seventh, bringing home two runs. Richmond rallied to tie the score in the eighth with an RBI double by Gio Brusa. In the bottom of the ninth, **Rodolfo Martinez** walked three batters, including Sergio Alcantara with the bases loaded, to bring home the game-winning run as Erie walked off with a 4-3 win. Making his first Double-A start, **Caleb Baragar** worked 6.2 innings, the longest outing by a Richmond starter this year, and struck out seven with three runs allowed and one walk.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the rubber game of a three-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It is also the last of a five-game road trip to Bowie (0-2) and Erie (1-1). The series is the first set of the year between the Flying Squirrels and the SeaWolves. Erie comes to Richmond for a four-game series from July 18-21 and a three-game set from August 19-21. The Flying Squirrels return to Erie for four games from August 26-29. The Flying Squirrels snapped a five-game losing streak with Monday's win. On the season, Richmond is 8-13 in games following a loss this year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost 19 of the last 26 games since April 16 and nine of 11 since May 2. The Richmond offense ranks ninth in the league with a .225 batting average and are second with 31 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 4.08 team ERA, which is ninth in the circuit. After dropping four straight series (at Hartford, vs. Altoona, vs. Reading, at Altoona) and splitting the previous two (vs. Bowie, at Reading), the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win since the first set of the year with two wins at Bowie from April 29-May 1, but lost the next three series against Altoona, Trenton and Bowie.

THE SEAWOLVES sit in second place in the Eastern League Western Division but have lost three of their last five games. Erie leads the Eastern League in team batting average (.262), is first in runs scored (167) and sit first in triples (14). The SeaWolves have a 3.23 team ERA, which is fourth in the league. The Erie roster features nine of MLB.com's Top-30 Tigers prospects, including Casey Mize (1), Matt Manning (2), Isaac Paredes (4), Alex Faedo (10), Sergio Alcantara (15), Logan Shore (16), Anthony Castro (23), Gregory Soto (26) and Jose Azocar (30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Alfred Gutierrez** makes his seventh start of the season for the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he worked a season-high 5.0 innings and allowed one earned run but was charged with a loss at Bowie on Friday. Today's outing marks the first of his career against the Tigers organization. Gutierrez is in his first season with the Giants organization after spending the previous seven with the Detroit Tigers. Last year, he spent time at three levels and made seven starts for the Erie SeaWolves in the Eastern League. He spent most of the season split between the starting rotation and bullpen with A-Adv. Lakeland and was named a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star. **For more on Gutierrez, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Casey Mize makes his fourth start of the season for the SeaWolves. Last time out, he allowed season highs in hits (7), runs (2) and earned runs (2) in a no-decision at Altoona on Friday. Mize began the season with A-Adv. Lakeland in the Florida State League, where he went 2-0 with a 0.35 ERA in four starts. He made his Double-A debut on April 29 at Altoona and pitched a nine-inning no-hitter, allowing just one walk. Today's outing marks the 13th start of Mize's career, and he is 4-1 with a 1.38 ERA in his first 12. Mize was the first overall pick in last year's MLB Draft out of Auburn and is currently ranked by MLB.com as the No. 1 Tigers prospect, the No. 1 RHP prospect in all of baseball and the No. 6 overall prospect in baseball.

PLUS/MINUS: On the season, the Flying Squirrels rank last in the Eastern League in run differential at -49 (111 runs scored / 160 runs allowed). The Erie SeaWolves have the best run differential in the league at +52 (167 runs scored / 115 runs against).

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit nine home runs at home this season through 19 games (0.42 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 22 homers on the road in 15 games (1.47 per game), more than any other team in the league. Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

PITCH IT: Through April 22 in the first 15 games of the season, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 2.62 ERA (37 ER/127.0 IP), which was second-best in the Eastern League. Richmond starters had a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) and relievers had a 2.70 ERA (18 ER/60.0 IP). Over the last 19 games dating back to April 23, Richmond pitchers have posted a 5.21 ERA (95 ER/164.0 IP).

HITS FOR HEALTH: After hitting .086 (3-for-35) through his first 13 games of the season, **Heath Quinn** has compiled a 19-game on-base streak dating back to April 22, during which he has hit .274 (17-for-62) with three doubles, a triple, two homers, eight RBIs and ten walks. The on-base streak is the longest active streak in the Eastern League and tied for the longest in the league this season. Over his last 16 games, Quinn has combined to hit .294 (15-for-51).

SHAWESOME: On Monday, **Chris Shaw** clubbed his seventh homer of the season, which is tied for the most on the team with **Jalen Miller** and tied for third in the Eastern League. For the season, Shaw is ranked fifth in the league in slugging percentage (.550), seventh in OPS (.908) and eighth in total bases (60). Over his last 18 games since April 23, Shaw is batting .290 (20-for-69) with five homers, four doubles, a triple, 14 RBIs, seven walks and 12 runs scored. Shaw has homered five times over his last 13 games since April 30.

MILLER TIME: With his home run on Friday, **Jalen Miller** now has seven homers on the season, which is tied for third in the Eastern League and tied with **Chris Shaw** for the Flying Squirrels team lead. Miller is also tied for first in the Eastern League with 10 stolen bases.

FARGAS ON FIRE: Outfielder **Johneshwy Fargas** hit .185 through his first 16 games of the year through April 28. In his last 11 games since April 29, Fargas has hit .343 (12-for-35) with two homers, five RBIs, four runs scored and five stolen bases. Fargas is tied for fifth in the Eastern League with eight stolen bases this year. On Tuesday, he collected three hits in a game for the first time this year.

HEY NOW, WE'VE GOT ALL-STARS: The 2019 Flying Squirrels roster has included five players who have been named as an Eastern League All-Star in previous seasons: **Ryan Howard** (2018), **Will Maddox** (2018), **Levi Michael** (2018), **Tyler Cyr** (2017) and **Brock Stassi** (2015).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).
