**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels dropped their fourth straight game with a 10-2 loss to the Akron RubberDucks. Akron jumped out to an 8-0 lead through the first five innings before the Flying Squirrels broke the shutout in the sixth. **Brandon Van Horn** hit an RBI triple for his first hit of the season with Richmond and scored later in the inning on a sac fly by **Hamlet Marte**. Richmond reliever **Sando Cabrera** worked 1.1 scoreless innings. **Gio Brusa** collected two of Richmond's eight hits in the game.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the third of a four-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. It is also the third of a seven-game homestand against Akron (0-2) and Reading. This series is the first of the year between the Flying Squirrels and the RubberDucks.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost 22 of the last 29 games since April 16, 12 of 14 since May 2 and nine of ten since May 6. The Richmond offense ranks tenth in the league with a .226 batting average and are tied for second with 33 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 4.31 team ERA, which is last in the circuit. After dropping four straight series (at Hartford, vs. Altoona, vs. Reading, at Altoona) and splitting the previous two (vs. Bowie, at Reading), the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win since the first set of the year with two wins at Bowie from April 29-May 1, but have lost the next four series against Altoona, Trenton, at Bowie and at Erie.

**THE RUBBERDUCKS** have won five of their last six games, including taking two of three at home against Bowie prior to this series. After starting the season 0-6, the RubberDucks have gone 19-15 since April 10. The Akron pitching staff is ranked tied for seventh in the league with a 3.57 team ERA, and its offense is ranked sixth with a .234 team batting average and tied for second with 33 homers. Akron's roster features six of MLB.com's Top-30 Cleveland Indians prospects, including Triston McKenzie (1), Sam Hentges (10), Ernie Clement (15), Nick Sandlin (17), Daniel Johnson (22) and Aaron Civale (24).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Brandon Lawson** makes his fifth start with the Flying Squirrels and his first against the RubberDucks. Last time out, he matched a season high with 5.0 innings pitched at Erie on Monday to pick up his first win of 2019, holding the SeaWolves to two earned runs. It was his second straight start throwing 5.0 innings. Lawson was signed as a minor-league free agent by the Giants on April 23 after being released by the Tampa Bay Rays near the end of spring training. He was originally drafted by the Rays in the 12th round in 2016 out of the University of South Florida and reached Double-A for 14 outings (five starts) last season with the Montgomery Biscuits. **For more on Lawson, see page two.**

**FOR AKRON:** Left-hander Tanner Tully makes his eighth start of the season for the RubberDucks. In his most recent start, he picked up a win against Bowie on Monday after allowing two earned runs over 5.1 innings. He is in his second season with the RubberDucks after making three Eastern League starts in 2018, going 1-1 with a 4.32 ERA. Tully was drafted by the Indians in the 26th round in 2016 out of Ohio State.

**HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T:** The Flying Squirrels have hit nine home runs at home this season through 21 games (0.43 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

**FREQUENT FLYERS:** In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 24 homers on the road in 16 games (1.50 per game), more than any other team in the league. Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

**PITCH IT:** Through April 22 in the first 15 games of the season, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 2.62 ERA (37 ER/127.0 IP), which was second-best in the Eastern League. Richmond starters had a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) and relievers had a 2.70 ERA (18 ER/60.0 IP). Over the last 22 games dating back to April 23, Richmond pitchers have posted a 5.44 ERA (115 ER/190.1 IP) and now rank last in the league with a 4.31 team ERA.

**RISPROBLEMS:** For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .193 (58-for-300) with runners in scoring position, which is ranked last in the Eastern League. With runners in scoring position and two outs, Richmond is batting .178 (26-for-146) for the season, which is also last in the league. When the bases are empty, the Flying Squirrels are batting .246 (167-for-679), which is second in the circuit. Overall with runners on base, the team is batting .200 (100-for-501), which is also last in the E.L.

**HITS FOR HEATH:** After hitting .086 (3-for-35) through his first 13 games of the season, **Heath Quinn** has compiled a 19-game on-base streak dating back to April 22, during which he has hit .274 (17-for-62) with three doubles, a triple, two homers, eight RBIs and ten walks. The on-base streak is the longest active streak in the Eastern League and tied for the longest in the league this season. Over his last 16 games, Quinn has combined to hit .294 (15-for-51).

**SHAWESOME:** On Monday, **Chris Shaw** clubbed his seventh homer of the season, which is tied for the most on the team with **Jalen Miller** and tied for seventh in the Eastern League. For the season, Shaw is also ranked ninth in the league in slugging percentage (.521). Over his last 21 games since April 23, Shaw is batting .272 (22-for-81) with five homers, four doubles, a triple, 14 RBIs, eight walks and 12 runs scored.

**MILLER TIME:** With his home run on Friday, **Jalen Miller** now has seven homers on the season, which is tied for seventh in the Eastern League and tied with **Chris Shaw** for the Flying Squirrels team lead. Miller is also tied for first in the Eastern League with 10 stolen bases.

**BRUSA IS BACK:** After going hitless over his first five Double-A games, **Gio Brusa** has compiled a five-game hitting streak dating back to May 13, during which he is batting .500 (8-for-16) with two homers, a double and four RBIs. Brusa was with the Flying Squirrels for the first series of the season before being assigned to A-Adv. San Jose, where he hit .115 over 19 games. He joined Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 for one game before returning to the Flying Squirrels the next day.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).
