SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels worked a series split with the Akron RubberDucks by taking the series finale, 5-2. **Chris Shaw** started the scoring in the first inning with an RBI single. Later in the inning, **Jonah Arenado** hit a sac fly and **Jin-De Jhang** added an RBI single to cap the three-run inning. In the second inning, **Johneshwy Fargas** and **Jacob Heyward** added RBI singles to open a 5-0 lead for the Flying Squirrels. Nellie Rodriguez hit a two-run homer for Akron in the third, the only runs for the RubberDucks in the game. **Caleb Baragar** picked up his first win, working 6.0 innings and allowing two runs. Relievers **Sam Wolff**, **Raffi Vizcaino** and **Melvin Adon** each pitched a scoreless inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the first of a three-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. It is also the fifth of a seven-game homestand against Akron (2-2) and Reading. The Flying Squirrels and Fightin Phils split a rain-shortened, two-game series at FirstEnergy Stadium on April 13 and 14. Reading swept a three-game series in Richmond from April 22-24. The two teams face each other again for a five-game series in Reading from May 31-June 3 and again in Richmond from July 4-7. The Flying Squirrels are looking to win a third straight game for the second time this year and the first time since opening the season 3-0.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost 22 of the last 31 games since April 16, 12 of 16 since May 2 and nine of 12 since May 6. The Richmond offense ranks tied for seventh in the league with a .230 batting average and are fourth with 33 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 4.19 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. After dropping four straight series (at Hartford, vs. Altoona, vs. Reading, at Altoona) and splitting the previous two (vs. Bowie, at Reading), the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win since the first set of the year with two wins at Bowie from April 29-May 1, but lost the next four series against Altoona, Trenton, at Bowie and at Erie. They snapped that skid with a four-game split against Akron from May 16-19.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS have won four straight games after sweeping the Portland Sea Dogs at home over the weekend. In that series, Reading outscored Portland, 19-8. The Fightin Phils rank last in the league with a .209 team batting average and sit fourth with a 3.39 team ERA. Reading's roster includes eight of MLB.com's Top-30 Philadelphia prospects, including Adonis Medina (2), Adam Haseley (3), JoJo Romero (7), Mickey Moniak (9), Arquimedes Gamboa (13), Mauricio Liovera (15), David Parkinson (2) and Cornelius Randolph (25).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Alfred Gutierrez** makes his eighth start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his second against the Fightin Phils. Last time out, he worked 5.0 innings for the second straight outing and allowed three runs in a no-decision at Erie last Wednesday. He pitched against the Fightin Phils at The Diamond on April 22 and did not see a decision after working 3.2 innings and allowing four hits with no runs scored against him. Gutierrez is in his first season with the Giants organization after spending the previous seven with the Detroit Tigers. Last year, he spent time at three levels and made seven starts for the Erie SeaWolves in the Eastern League. He spent most of the season split between the starting rotation and bullpen with A-Adv. Lakeland and was named a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star. **For more on Gutierrez, see page two.**

FOR READING: Right-hander JoJo Romero makes his first start of the season for the Fightin Phils. He has made seven total starts this season, all with the Triple-A Lehigh Valley IronPigs. Of those seven starts, Romero allowed five or more runs five times, including a season-high six runs in each of his last two starts. Last time out last Wednesday, Romero was hit with a loss at Durham after allowing six runs over 4.0 innings on seven hits. Romero was drafted by the Phillies in the fourth round in 2016 out of Yavapai College in Arizona, and he is ranked as the No. 7 Phillies prospect by MLB.com.

STRINGING THEM TOGETHER: The Flying Squirrels are 4-9 this season in games following a win. Sunday's win marked the first time the Flying Squirrels have won back-to-back games since April 14-15 (at Hartford and at Reading). The only other consecutive wins this season by the Flying Squirrels were three straight victories over the Hartford Yard Goats to open the season from April 4-6 at The Diamond.

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit nine home runs at home this season through 23 games (0.39 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 24 homers on the road in 16 games (1.50 per game), more than any other team in the league. Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

PITCH IT: Through April 22 in the first 15 games of the season, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 2.62 ERA (37 ER/127.0 IP), which was second-best in the Eastern League. Richmond starters had a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) and relievers had a 2.70 ERA (18 ER/60.0 IP). Over the last 24 games dating back to April 23, Richmond pitchers have posted a 5.14 ERA (119 ER/208.1 IP). Over the last two games since Saturday, the Flying Squirrels have posted a 2.00 ERA (4 ER/18.0 IP).

RISPROBLEMS: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .205 (65-for-317) with runners in scoring position, which is ranked last in the Eastern League. With runners in scoring position and two outs, Richmond is batting .194 (30-for-155) for the season, which is also last in the league. When the bases are empty, the Flying Squirrels are batting .248 (176-for-709), which is second in the circuit. Overall with runners on base, the team is batting .205 (110-for-536), which is also last in the E.L. However, over the last two games, the Richmond offense has hit .412 (7-for-17) with runners in scoring position.

ARENADO COMES ALIVE: Over his last six games since May 14, **Jonah Arenado** has hit .333 (7-for-21) with two doubles, one RBI and two walks. Arenado was hitting .329 through May 4, but hit .136 (3-for-22) over his next seven games, which dipped his average to .288.

BRUSA IS BACK: After going hitless over his first five Double-A games, **Gio Brusa** has compiled a six-game hitting streak dating back to May 13, during which he is batting .450 (9-for-20) with two homers, a double and four RBIs. Brusa was with the Flying Squirrels for the first series of the season before being assigned to A-Adv. San Jose, where he hit .115 over 19 games. He joined Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 for one game before returning to the Flying Squirrels the next day.

SHAWESOME: On Monday, **Chris Shaw** clubbed his seventh homer of the season, which is tied for the most on the team with **Jalen Miller** and tied for seventh in the Eastern League. For the season, Shaw is also ranked ninth in the league in slugging percentage (.504).

MILLER TIME: With his home run on Friday, **Jalen Miller** now has seven homers on the season, which is tied for seventh in the Eastern League and tied with **Chris Shaw** for the Flying Squirrels team lead. Miller is also tied for second in the Eastern League with 10 stolen bases.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).
