YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels won their third straight game, tying the longest winning streak of the year, with an 8-4 win over the Reading Fightin Phils. Richmond scored five runs in the first inning. **Jonah Arenado** brought home the game's first run with an RBI groundout. **Hamlet Marte** hit a bases-clearing, three-run double and later scored on an RBI single by **Brandon Van Horn**. Reading broke onto the scoreboard with a solo homer by Darick Hall in the fourth and closed back within two with two runs in the fifth. **Chris Shaw** extended the lead to 6-3 with an RBI single in the bottom of the fifth. Reading plated a run in the sixth to pull within 6-4, but Arenado clubbed a two-run homer in the bottom of the seventh. **Connor Overton** improved to 3-0 working 1.2 relief innings and allowing one run. **Sam Moll**, **Sam Wolff**, **Ryan Halstead** and **Melvin Adon** combined for three scoreless innings to finish the game. Van Horn had three hits on the night.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. It is also the sixth of a seven-game homestand against Akron (2-2) and Reading (1-0). The Flying Squirrels and Fightin Phils split a rain-shortened, two-game series at FirstEnergy Stadium on April 13 and 14. Reading swept a three-game series in Richmond from April 22-24. The two teams face each other again for a five-game series in Reading from May 31-June 3 and again in Richmond from July 4-7. The Flying Squirrels have won consecutive games for the third straight stretch this season and have tied a season-high three-game win streak.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have tied a season-high three game winning streak on the heels of losing nine of 10 games and going 7-22 from April 16-May 17. The Richmond offense ranks ninth in the league with a .231 batting average and are tied for fourth with 34 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 4.18 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels are looking for their first series win since taking two of three from April 29-May 1 in Bowie and their third overall this season. They snapped a four-series losing streak with a four-game split against Akron over the weekend.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS had a four-game winning streak snapped with the loss to Richmond on Tuesday. The Fightin Phils rank last in the league with a .212 team batting average and sit seventh with a 3.52 team ERA. Reading's roster includes eight of MLB.com's Top-30 Philadelphia prospects, including Adonis Medina (2), Adam Haseley (3), JoJo Romero (7), Mickey Moniak (9), Arquimedes Gamboa (13), Mauricio Liovera (15), David Parkinson (21) and Cornelius Randolph (25).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Garrett Williams** takes the mound for his eighth start of the season and his second against the Fightin Phils. He pitched at Reading on April 14 and allowed three runs over 5.0 innings, picking up a season-high-tying six strikeouts. Last time out, Williams tied a season high with four earned runs allowed over 4.1 innings in a loss against Akron on Friday. He made 14 starts for Richmond last season and went 2-6 with a 6.00 ERA before moving to the bullpen when the calendar turned to July. As a reliever, he posted a 5.96 ERA in 18 appearances. Williams is ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 21 Giants prospect and No. 20 by MLB.com. **For more on Williams, see page two.**

FOR READING: Left-hander David Parkinson makes his seventh start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. The Richmond native made his first-ever professional appearance at The Diamond on April 23 and picked up a win after working 5.2 innings and allowing two runs. Last time out, Parkinson worked 6.0 innings for the second straight start and allowed one run with four strikeouts. Parkinson has combined for a 2.25 ERA (3 ER/12.0 IP) over his last two starts. For his professional career, Parkinson is 15-6 with a 2.00 ERA in 30 starts and nine relief appearances. Parkinson was drafted by the Phillies in the 12th round in 2017 out of Ole Miss. He attended Mills Godwin High School in nearby Henrico County.

STRINGING THEM TOGETHER: The Flying Squirrels have won three straight games for the second time this season. Over the last three games, the Richmond offense is averaging 6.0 runs per game (18 total runs) and hitting .287 (27-for-94). The Flying Squirrels are 5-9 this season in games following a win. The current stretch is the first time the Flying Squirrels have won consecutive games since April 14-15 (at Hartford and at Reading). The only other consecutive wins this season by the Flying Squirrels were three straight victories over the Hartford Yard Goats to open the season from April 4-6 at The Diamond.

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit 10 home runs at home this season through 24 games (0.42 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 24 homers on the road in 16 games (1.50 per game), more than any other team in the league. Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

PITCH IT: Through April 22 in the first 15 games of the season, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 2.62 ERA (37 ER/127.0 IP), which was second-best in the Eastern League. Richmond starters had a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) and relievers had a 2.70 ERA (18 ER/60.0 IP). Over the last 25 games dating back to April 23, Richmond pitchers have posted a 5.09 ERA (123 ER/217.1 IP). Over the last three games since Saturday, the Flying Squirrels have posted a 2.67 ERA (8 ER/27.0 IP).

RISPROBLEMS: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .210 (69-for-328) with runners in scoring position, which is ranked last in the Eastern League. With runners in scoring position and two outs, Richmond is batting .200 (32-for-160) for the season, which is also last in the league. When the bases are empty, the Flying Squirrels are batting .248 (179-for-723), which is second in the circuit. Overall with runners on base, the team is batting .209 (115-for-551), which is also last in the E.L. However, over the last three games, the Richmond offense has hit .393 (11-for-28) with runners in scoring position.

ARENADO COMES ALIVE: Over his last six games since May 14, **Jonah Arenado** has hit .348 (8-for-23) with one homer, two doubles, four RBIs and four walks. Arenado was hitting .329 through May 4, but hit .136 (3-for-22) over his next seven games, which dipped his average to .288. His current surge has raised his batting average to .299, which leads the qualified hitters on the Flying Squirrels roster.

BRUSA IS BACK: After going hitless over his first five Double-A games, **Gio Brusa** compiled a six-game hitting streak from May 13-19, during which he is hit .450 (9-for-20) with two homers, a double and four RBIs. That streak was snapped with an 0-for-1 pinch-hitting appearance on Tuesday. Brusa was with the Flying Squirrels for the first series of the season before being assigned to A-Adv. San Jose, where he hit .115 over 19 games. He joined Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 for one game before returning to the Flying Squirrels the next day.

SHAWESOME: Over his last 10 games, **Chris Shaw** is batting .316 (12-for-38) with two homers, eight RBIs and seven runs scored, which has raised his batting average from .255 to .273. For the season, Shaw is tied for the team lead with seven homers, which is tied for eighth in the league. He is also ranked eighth in the league with a .515 slugging percentage and tied for ninth with 68 total bases.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).
