**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels saw their three-game winning streak end with a 9-1 loss to the Reading Fightin Phils. Reading opened the scoring in the first inning with RBI singles by Adam Haseley and Austin Listi. In the second, Mickey Moniak and Haseley each hit RBI singles to open a 4-0 lead and close the line on Richmond starter **Garrett Williams**, who lasted just 1.2 innings. Reading opened the lead to 5-0 with a sac fly in the third. Richmond scored its only run in the sixth inning on an RBI groundout by **Jonah Arenado**. Reading added on in the top of the eighth with an RBI single by Luke Williams and a bases-loaded walk by Moniak, and they scored a ninth run on the third RBI single of the game by Haseley in the top of the ninth. Richmond reliever **Tyler Cyr** pitched 2.0 scoreless innings with five strikeouts.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the finale and rubber game of a three-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. It is also the last of a seven-game homestand against Akron (2-2) and Reading (1-1). Richmond is aiming to win its first series since taking two of three in Bowie from May 29-April 1. The Flying Squirrels and Fightin Phils split a rain-shortened, two-game series at FirstEnergy Stadium on April 13 and 14. Reading swept a three-game series in Richmond from April 22-24. The two teams face each other again for a five-game series in Reading from May 31-June 3 and again in Richmond from July 4-7. The Flying Squirrels have won consecutive games for the third straight stretch this season and have tied a season-high three-game win streak.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** saw their season-high-tying three-game win streak snapped with Thursday's 9-1 loss. Since May 16, the Flying Squirrels have gone 10-24. The Richmond offense ranks ninth in the league with a .229 batting average and are tied for fourth with 34 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 4.28 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels are looking for their first series win since taking two of three from April 29-May 1 in Bowie and their third overall this season. They snapped a four-series losing streak with a four-game split against Akron over the weekend.

**THE FIGHTIN PHILS** had a four-game winning streak snapped with the loss to Richmond on Tuesday, but have now won five of the last six games. The Fightin Phils rank last in the league with a .216 team batting average and sit sixth with a 3.45 team ERA. Reading's roster includes eight of MLB.com's Top-30 Philadelphia prospects, including Adonis Medina (2), Adam Haseley (3), JoJo Romero (7), Mickey Moniak (9), Arquimedes Gamboa (13), Mauricio Liovera (15), David Parkinson (21) and Cornelius Randolph (25).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Brandon Lawson** makes his sixth start with the Flying Squirrels and his first against the Fightin Phils. Last time out, he worked 4.0 innings and allowed two earned runs in a no-decision against Akron. Over his last three starts, Lawson is 1-0 with a 4.50 ERA (7 ER/14.0 IP). Lawson was signed as a minor-league free agent by the Giants on April 23 after being released by the Tampa Bay Rays near the end of spring training. He was originally drafted by the Rays in the 12th round in 2016 out of the University of South Florida and reached Double-A for 14 outings (five starts) last season with the Montgomery Biscuits. **For more on Lawson, see page two.**

**FOR READING:** Left-hander Bailey Falter makes his seventh start of the season for the Fightin Phils and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He pitched at The Diamond on April 24 and allowed two unearned runs over 4.0 innings in a no-decision. Last time out, he allowed a season-high five earned runs over 5.1 innings in a loss at New Hampshire last Wednesday. Falter was drafted by the Phillies in the fifth round in 2015 out of Chino Hills (Calif.) High School.

**RISPROBLEMS:** For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .208 (69-for-331) with runners in scoring position, which is ranked last in the Eastern League. With runners in scoring position and two outs, Richmond is batting .199 (32-for-161) for the season, which is also last in the league. When the bases are empty, the Flying Squirrels are batting .246 (183-for-744), which is second in the circuit. Overall with runners on base, the team is batting .207 (116-for-560), which is also last in the E.L. However, over the last four games, the Richmond offense has hit .355 (11-for-31) with runners in scoring position.

**HEYWARD HEATS UP:** Since May 15, **Jacob Heyward** has compiled a seven-game hitting streak, during which he is batting .391 (9-for-23) with a homer, four RBIs and five walks. That streak followed a span where Heyward went hitless for five games, combining to go 0-for-19 with 13 strikeouts, including ten straight plate appearances with a strikeout. Heyward is ranked second in the league in on-base percentage (.438), ninth in slugging percentage (.495), sixth in OPS (.933) and tied for fifth in walks (25). Heyward has walked in 20.7 percent of his plate appearances this season, which is the highest in Double-A and ranks fourth in all of minor league baseball. His .426 BABIP is second in the league.

**ARENADO COMES ALIVE:** Over his last seven games since May 14, **Jonah Arenado** has hit .333 (9-for-27) with one homer, two doubles, five RBIs and four walks. Arenado was hitting .329 through May 4, but hit .136 (3-for-22) over his next seven games, which dipped his average to .288. His current surge has raised his batting average to .298, which leads the qualified hitters on the Flying Squirrels roster.

**BRUSA IS BACK:** After going hitless over his first five Double-A games, **Gio Brusa** has hit safely in each of his last seven games started since May 13. During that span, Brusa is hitting .400 (10-for-25) with two homers, a double and four RBIs. Brusa was with the Flying Squirrels for the first series of the season before being assigned to A-Adv. San Jose, where he hit .115 over 19 games. He joined Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 for one game before returning to the Flying Squirrels the next day.

**SHAWESOME:** Over his last 11 games, **Chris Shaw** is batting .316 (12-for-38) with two homers, eight RBIs and seven runs scored, which has raised his batting average from .255 to .273. For the season, Shaw is tied for the team lead with seven homers, which is tied for eighth in the league. He is also ranked eighth in the league with a .515 slugging percentage and tied for ninth with an .871 OPS.

**HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T:** The Flying Squirrels have hit 10 home runs at home this season through 25 games (0.40 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

**FREQUENT FLYERS:** In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 24 homers on the road in 16 games (1.50 per game), more than any other team in the league. Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

**PITCH IT:** Through April 22 in the first 15 games of the season, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 2.62 ERA (37 ER/127.0 IP), which was second-best in the Eastern League. Richmond starters had a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) and relievers had a 2.70 ERA (18 ER/60.0 IP). Over the last 26 games dating back to April 23, Richmond pitchers have posted a 5.21 ERA (131 ER/226.1 IP).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).
