YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped the series rubber game to the Reading Fightin Phils, 6-1. Reading pulled ahead in the first inning with an RBI double by Darick Hall. In the fourth, Henri Lartigue added an RBI single to extend Reading's lead to 2-0. The Fightin Phils added four runs in the fifth with a two-run double by Mickey Moniak and a two run double by Austin Lisiti. Richmond scored its lone run in the eighth inning with an RBI single by **Jonah Arenado**. Flying Squirrels starter **Brandon Lawson** allowed six runs (three earned) over 5.0 innings. Relievers **Carlos Navas** and **Ryan Halstead** each pitched two scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a four-game road series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. It is Richmond's first trip to Canal Park this season. The two teams met for a four-game series at The Diamond, Akron's only trip to Richmond this year, last week, a series that saw Akron win the first two games and Richmond win the last two games for a series split. The Flying Squirrels return to Canal Park for one more series this year, a four-game set from August 22-25.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost their last two games by a combined score of 15-2. The two losses followed a three-game winning streak, which was tied for the longest this year for the Flying Squirrels. Since May 16, the Flying Squirrels have gone 10-25. The Richmond offense ranks ninth in the league with a .226 batting average and are tied for fourth with 34 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 4.25 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost five of the last six series, with the lone exception being a four-game split against Akron at home last week. The last series win for Richmond came when it won two of three in Bowie from April 29-May 1.

THE RUBBERDUCKS have won three straight games and six of the last eight since May 15. The only two losses in that stretch were back-to-back defeats by the Flying Squirrels on May 18 and 19 at The Diamond. In its last series, Akron swept three games at home against Harrisburg, who leads the Western Division, by a combined score of 19-6. The RubberDucks are hitting .236 as a team, which is ranked sixth in the league, and are third in the E.L. with 35 total homers. The Akron pitching staff has posted a 3.37 ERA, which is fourth in the league. Akron's roster includes five of MLB.com's Top-30 Indians prospects, including Sam Hentges (10), Ernie Clement (15), Nick Sandlin (17), Daniel Johnson (22) and Aaron Civale (24).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Caleb Baragar** makes his third start and fourth overall appearance for the Flying Squirrels this season. Last time out, he faced the RubberDucks on Sunday at The Diamond and worked 6.0 innings, allowing two runs on three hits with no walks and two strikeouts. In his previous outing on May 14 at Erie, Baragar became the first Richmond starter this year to pitch into the seventh inning. He ended that outing with seventh strikeouts and one walk. Baragar made one start with Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. He began the season with A-Adv. San Jose and went 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA in four starts and one relief outing. Baragar was drafted by the Giants in the ninth round in 2016 out of Indiana University and is in his fourth professional season. **For more on Baragar, see page two.**

FOR AKRON: Left-hander Tanner Tully makes his ninth start of the year for the RubberDucks and second straight against the Flying Squirrels. On Saturday at The Diamond, Tully was hit with a loss after allowing five runs (one earned) on a season-high-tying eight hits over 5.1 innings. Over his last three starts, Tully is 1-2 with a 2.16 ERA (4 ER/16.2 IP), but has surrendered five unearned runs. Tully was drafted by the Indians in the 26th round in 2016 out of Ohio State.

RISPROBLEMS: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .209 (70-for-335) with runners in scoring position, which is ranked last in the Eastern League. With runners in scoring position and two outs, Richmond is batting .201 (33-for-164) for the season, which is also last in the league. When the bases are empty, the Flying Squirrels are batting .245 (187-for-763), which is second in the circuit. Overall with runners on base, the team is batting .206 (118-for-574), which is also last in the E.L. However, over the last five games, the Richmond offense has hit .343 (12-for-35) with runners in scoring position.

HEYWARD HEATS UP: Since May 15, **Jacob Heyward** is batting .346 (9-for-26) with a homer, four RBIs and six walks. That streak followed a span where Heyward went hitless for five games, combining to go 0-for-19 with 13 strikeouts, including ten straight plate appearances with a strikeout. Heyward is ranked second in the league in on-base percentage (.432), sixth in OPS (.912) and fifth in walks (26). Heyward has walked in 20.8 percent of his plate appearances this season, which is the highest in Double-A and ranks third in all of minor league baseball. His .426 BABIP is second in the league.

ARENADO COMES ALIVE: Over his last eight games since May 14, **Jonah Arenado** has hit .355 (11-for-31) with one homer, two doubles, six RBIs and four walks. Arenado was hitting .329 through May 4, but hit .136 (3-for-22) over his next seven games, which dipped his average to .288. His current surge has raised his batting average to .304, which leads the qualified hitters on the Flying Squirrels roster and eighth in the Eastern League.

BRUSA IS BACK: After going hitless over his first five Double-A games, **Gio Brusa** has hit safely in each of his last seven games started since May 13. During that span, Brusa is hitting .385 (10-for-26) with two homers, a double and four RBIs. Brusa was with the Flying Squirrels for the first series of the season before being assigned to A-Adv. San Jose, where he hit .115 over 19 games. He joined Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 for one game before returning to the Flying Squirrels the next day.

SHAWESOME: Over his last 12 games, **Chris Shaw** is batting .333 (14-for-42) with two homers, eight RBIs and eight runs scored, which has raised his batting average from .255 to .279. For the season, Shaw is tied for the team lead with seven homers, which is tied for eighth in the league. He is also ranked eighth in the league with a .515 slugging percentage and eighth with an .874 OPS.

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit 10 home runs at home this season through 26 games (0.39 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 24 homers on the road in 16 games (1.50 per game), more than any other team in the league. Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

PITCH IT: Through April 22 in the first 15 games of the season, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 2.62 ERA (37 ER/127.0 IP), which was second-best in the Eastern League. Richmond starters had a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) and relievers had a 2.70 ERA (18 ER/60.0 IP). Over the last 27 games dating back to April 23, Richmond pitchers have posted a 5.12 ERA (134 ER/235.1 IP).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).

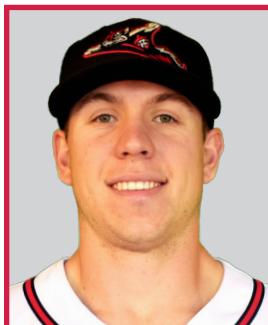
