YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped their third straight game with a 2-1 loss in 13 innings to the Akron RubberDucks. It was the first game to extend beyond 11 innings for the Flying Squirrels since MiLB instituted the new extra-inning pace-of-play rules. Richmond went 1-for-19 with runners in scoring position in the game. Akron won on a walk-off single in the bottom of the 13th by Ernie Clement. The Flying Squirrels scored their lone run on an RBI single by **Jonah Arenado** in the fourth inning. Akron evened the score with a bases-loaded walk Nellie Rodriguez in the fifth. Richmond starter **Caleb Baragar** worked 5.0 innings and allowed one run with six strikeouts. Relievers **Sam Wolff**, **Melvin Adon** and **Raffi Vizcaino** each pitched 2.0 scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a four-game road series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. It is Richmond's first trip to Canal Park this season. The two teams met for a four-game series at The Diamond, Akron's only trip to Richmond this year, last week, a series that saw Akron win the first two games and Richmond win the last two games for a series split. The Flying Squirrels return to Canal Park for one more series this year, a four-game set from August 22-25. The Flying Squirrels are looking to avoid a losing streak reaching at least four games for the fourth time this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost their last three games by a combined score of 17-3. The three losses followed a three-game winning streak, which was tied for the longest this year for the Flying Squirrels. Since May 16, the Flying Squirrels have gone 10-26. The Richmond offense ranks ninth in the league with a .226 batting average and are tied for fourth with 34 homers. The pitching staff has combined for a 4.13 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost five of the last six series, with the lone exception being a four-game split against Akron at home last week. The last series win for Richmond came when it won two of three in Bowie from April 29-May 1.

THE RUBBERDUCKS have won four straight games and seven of the last nine since May 15. The only two losses in that stretch were back-to-back defeats by the Flying Squirrels on May 18 and 19 at The Diamond. In its last series, Akron swept three games at home against Harrisburg, who leads the Western Division, by a combined score of 19-6. The RubberDucks are hitting .234 as a team, which is ranked seventh in the league, and are third in the E.L. with 35 total homers. The Akron pitching staff has posted a 3.28 ERA, which is third in the league. Akron's roster includes five of MLB.com's Top-30 Indians prospects, including Sam Hentges (10), Ernie Clement (15), Nick Sandlin (17), Daniel Johnson (22) and Aaron Civale (24).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Conner Menez** makes his ninth start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his second against Akron. He faced the RubberDucks in his last start last Thursday in a no-decision, matching a season-high nine strikeouts while allowing two runs in six innings. For the season, Menez is ranked eighth in the Eastern League in ERA (2.38), eighth in strikeouts (51), fourth in opponents' batting average (.184) and eighth in WHIP (0.98). Last year, Menez spent most of the season with Richmond, going 6-4 with a 4.38 ERA in 15 starts. He also pitched 11 games with A-Adv. San Jose and one with Triple-A Sacramento, combining to go 9-10 with a 4.46 ERA in 28 total starts across the three levels. Menez led the Giants organization with 171 total strikeouts, 32 ahead of second-place John Gavin. It was also tied for the fourth-most strikeouts in the minors (led by Dean Kremer of the Orioles organization). Menez is in his fourth professional season and was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 14th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of the Master's University. He entered this season ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 25 Giants prospect. *For more on Menez, see page two.*

FOR AKRON: Right-hander **Jake Paulson** makes his eighth start of the year for the RubberDucks and his second straight against the Flying Squirrels. On Sunday, Paulson picked up a loss after allowing five runs (two earned) over 5.2 innings at The Diamond. Over his last three starts, Paulson is 0-2 with a 3.24 ERA (6 ER/16.2 IP). He has also made one start for Triple-A Columbus, allowing four runs over 5.2 innings on April 26 against Durham. Paulson led the Eastern League with a 3.04 ERA in 2018 and ranked second in the circuit with a 1.18 WHIP, earning Eastern League All-Star honors. He was drafted by the Cincinnati Reds in the 27th round in 2014 out of Oakland University.

RISPROBLEMS: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .201 (71-for-354) with runners in scoring position, which is ranked last in the Eastern League. With runners in scoring position and two outs, Richmond is batting .194 (33-for-170) for the season, which is also last in the league. When the bases are empty, the Flying Squirrels are batting .245 (192-for-785), which is second in the circuit. Overall with runners on base, the team is batting .201 (120-for-596), which is also last in the E.L. Over the last three games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .077 (2-for-26) with runners in scoring position.

ARENADO COMES ALIVE: Over his last ten games since May 14, **Jonah Arenado** has hit .343 (12-for-35) with one homer, two doubles, seven RBIs and five walks. Arenado was hitting .329 through May 4, but hit .136 (3-for-22) over his next seven games, which dipped his average to .288. His current surge has raised his batting average to .302, which leads the qualified hitters on the Flying Squirrels roster and tenth in the Eastern League.

BRUSA IS BACK: After going hitless over his first five Double-A games, **Gio Brusa** has hit safely in each of his last eight games started since May 13. During that span, Brusa is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with two homers, two doubles and four RBIs. Brusa was with the Flying Squirrels for the first series of the season before being assigned to A-Adv. San Jose, where he hit .115 over 19 games. He joined Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 for one game before returning to the Flying Squirrels the next day.

SHAWESOME: Over his last 13 games since May 10, **Chris Shaw** is batting .333 (16-for-47) with two homers, five doubles, eight RBIs and nine runs scored, which has raised his batting average from .255 to .284. For the season, Shaw is tied for the team lead with seven homers, which is tied for eighth in the league. He is also ranked seventh in the league with a .518 slugging percentage, sixth with an .883 OPS and ninth with 73 total base.

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit 10 home runs at home this season through 26 games (0.39 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 24 homers on the road in 17 games (1.42 per game), more than any other team in the league. Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

PITCH IT: Through April 22 in the first 15 games of the season, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 2.62 ERA (37 ER/127.0 IP), which was second-best in the Eastern League. Richmond starters had a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) and relievers had a 2.70 ERA (18 ER/60.0 IP). Over the last 28 games dating back to April 23, Richmond pitchers have posted a 4.90 ERA (135 ER/247.2 IP).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).
