**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost in 10 innings to the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, 2-1. Richmond led 1-0 with two outs in the ninth, but Jason Krizan hit a game-tying single to force extras. In the tenth, Andres Gimenez hit a two-out single to bring in the go-ahead run. Austin McGeorge worked through the bottom of the tenth without allowing a run to pick up his first save. Richmond starter **Brandon Lawson** worked 5.0 scoreless innings and allowed four hits with five strikeouts. **Jalen Miller** broke the scoreless tie in the sixth with an RBI single to bring in **Chris Shaw**. Binghamton starter Harol Gonzalez did not allow an earned run over his 7.0 innings. **Ryan Halstead** and **Raffi Vizciano** combined to work 3.0 scoreless relief innings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the middle game of a three-game home series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. The series is Binghamton's only visit to Richmond this season. The two teams meet for a three-game set at NYSEG Stadium from June 21-23 for the first full series of the season's second half. The Flying Squirrels are 10-19 in games following a loss this year and 2-5 on Wednesdays.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have dropped two straight after winning two straight in Akron on Saturday and Sunday. Since April 16, the Flying Squirrels have gone 12-28. The Richmond offense ranks tied for tenth in the league with a .227 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.92 team ERA, which is tenth in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost five of the last seven series, with the exception being two four-game splits against Akron. The last series win for Richmond came when it won two of three in Bowie from April 29-May 1.

**THE RUMBLE PONIES** sit a half-game behind the Trenton Thunder for first place in the Eastern Division standings. Prior to this series, Binghamton split a four-game home series against the Trenton Thunder. The Rumble Ponies have won seven of their last 10 games. Binghamton ranks tied for second in the league in team batting average (.245) and rank second in the league in team ERA (3.05). Binghamton's roster includes eight of MLB.com's Top-30 Mets prospects, including Andres Gimenez (1), David Peterson (5), Anthony Kay (7), Will Toffey (15), Ryley Gilliam (20), Patrick Mazeika (25), Ali Sanchez (26) and Luis Caprio (28).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Caleb Baragar** makes his fourth start and fifth overall appearance for the Flying Squirrels this season. In his last start, Baragar pitched in Akron on Friday and allowed one earned run over 5.0 innings, holding the 'Ducks to two hits, but did not pick up a decision as Richmond lost in 13 innings. Baragar made one start with Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. He began the season with A-Adv. San Jose and went 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA in four starts and one relief outing. Baragar was drafted by the Giants in the ninth round in 2016 out of Indiana University and is in his fourth professional season. *For more on Baragar, see page two.*

**FOR BINGHAMTON:** Left-hander David Peterson makes his ninth start of the season for the Rumble Ponies. Last time out, Peterson worked 5.0 innings and allowed two unearned runs in a win at Bowie last Tuesday. Over his last four starts, Peterson is 1-0 with a 1.31 ERA (3 ER/20.2 IP), lowering his season ERA from 7.31 to 3.93. Peterson is ranked by MLB.com as the Mets' No. 5 prospect. He was drafted in the first round (20th overall) by the Mets in 2017 out of the University of Oregon.

**BRIEF HOMECOMING:** This three-game series is sandwiched in the middle of a long stretch of road games for the Flying Squirrels. After the series, the Flying Squirrels embark on an 11-game road trip, the longest of the season for the team, which includes stops in Reading, Portland and New Hampshire. Dating back to May 24 and rolling through June 9, the Flying Squirrels play 15 of 18 games on the road. In that span, the Flying Squirrels will travel approximately 2,288 miles (44 bus hours) around the northeast, almost long enough to cover the direct distance between Richmond and San Francisco.

**A LITTLE RELIEF:** Over the last 10 games dating back to May 18, the Richmond bullpen has combined for a 1.40 ERA (7 ER/45.0 IP). Prior to that stretch, Flying Squirrels relievers had combined for a 5.05 ERA, but the team bullpen ERA has now dropped to 4.19 for the season. On Tuesday, the bullpen saw a scoreless streak snapped at 25.1 innings with a game-tying, two-out single by Binghamton's Jason Krizan in the top of the ninth inning. Over the last five games, the Flying Squirrels bullpen has allowed six unearned runs, at least one per game.

**EXTRA! EXTRA!** For the season, the Flying Squirrels have gone 1-4 in five extra-inning games. After winning their first game in extras on April 6 with a walk-off sac fly by **Heath Quinn**, Richmond has lost its last four. With the runner placed at second base as per MiLB's pace-of-play rules, the Flying Squirrels offense has failed to score in its last seven extra frames. For the season, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .048 (1-for-21) in extra innings with 12 strikeouts.

**STOLEN BASE RACE:** This series features three of the top-five base stealers in the Eastern League this season. Binghamton's Sam Haggerty leads the league with 14 thefts this year. Richmond's **Jalen Miller** is tied for second with 12, which is a new career high and leads the Giants organization. Teammate **Johneshwy Fargas** is tied for fourth in the league, one behind Miller with 11 stolen bases this season.

**RISPROBLEMS:** For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .204 (80-for-392) with runners in scoring position, which is ranked last in the Eastern League. With runners in scoring position and two outs, Richmond is batting .199 (38-for-191) for the season, which is also last in the league. When the bases are empty, the Flying Squirrels are batting .242 (210-for-868), which is second in the circuit. Overall with runners on base, the team is batting .208 (135-for-650), which is also last in the E.L. Over the last six games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .172 (11-for-64) with runners in scoring position.

**BRUSA IS BACK:** After going hitless over his first five Double-A games, **Gio Brusa** has hit safely in 10 of his 12 games started since May 13. During that span, Brusa is hitting .341 (15-for-44) with three homers, three doubles and seven RBIs. Brusa was with the Flying Squirrels for the first series of the season before being assigned to A-Adv. San Jose, where he hit .115 over 19 games. He joined Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 for one game before returning to the Flying Squirrels the next day.

**SHAWESOME:** Over his last 17 games since May 10, **Chris Shaw** is batting .333 (21-for-63) with two homers, five doubles, eight RBIs, 11 runs scored and eight walks, which has raised his batting average from .255 to .287. In that stretch, he has hit safely in 14 of 17 games played. For the season, Shaw is tied for the team lead with seven homers. Shaw is ranked eighth in the league in slugging percentage (.503), seventh in OPS (.870) and tied for seventh in total bases (79).

**HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T:** The Flying Squirrels have hit 10 home runs at home this season through 27 games (0.37 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

**FREQUENT FLYERS:** In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 26 homers on the road in 19 games (1.37 per game), more than any other team in the league. Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

**PITCH IT:** Through April 22 in the first 15 games of the season, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 2.62 ERA (37 ER/127.0 IP), which was second-best in the Eastern League. Richmond starters had a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) and relievers had a 2.70 ERA (18 ER/60.0 IP). Over the last 31 games dating back to April 23, Richmond pitchers have posted a 4.51 ERA (142 ER/283.2 IP). However, over the last six games, Richmond pitchers have combined for a 1.73 ERA (11 ER/57.1 IP).

**ROAD TO THE SHOW:** On Sunday, former Flying Squirrels pitcher **Sam Coonrod** made his MLB debut for the Giants, working a scoreless relief inning against the Diamondbacks. Coonrod pitched in 37 games (31 starts) for the Flying Squirrels in 2016 and 2017, going 8-14 with a 3.98 ERA. He is the 63rd Flying Squirrels alum to reach the majors and the second this year, joining Shaun Anderson (2018 Flying Squirrels).

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** For the year, the Flying Squirrels are leading all Double-A teams in total attendance (152,408) and average attendance (6,096). Through the same number of scheduled home dates, attendance at The Diamond is up 5% (7,652) over 2018 (144,756), 9% (12,996) over 2017 (139,412) and 13% (17,776) over 2016 (134,632).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), outfielder **Chris Shaw** (11), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Shaw (11), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).
