**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels snapped a four-game losing streak with a 9-4 win over the Reading Fightin Phils. It was the most runs scored in a game this year by the Flying Squirrels. **Matt Winn** opened the scoring with a two-run homer in the second inning. In the third, **Johneshwy Fargas** tripled in a run and **Jalen Miller** added a sac fly to extend the lead to 4-0. In the fourth, Reading broke into the scoring an RBI double by Austin Listi. Miller hit another sac fly in the fifth and **Zach Houchins** clubbed a two-run homer in the sixth to pad the lead to 7-1. Listi hit a two-run homer in the bottom of the sixth to close Reading back within four. In the eighth, Houchins and **C.J. McElroy** drove in runs to open the lead to 8-3. Listi hit his second homer of the game in the eighth. Richmond starter **Alfred Gutierrez** picked up his second win of the season, allowing three runs in 5.2 innings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the second and third of a five-game, four-day series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. The second game of today's double-header serves as the make-up for a game rained out on April 12. It is the second day of an 11-game, ten-day road trip to Reading, Portland and New Hampshire, the longest road stretch of the season for Richmond. It is Richmond's second trip to Reading this season. The two teams split a rain-shortened, two-game set at FirstEnergy Stadium April 13 and 14. The Fightin Phils swept a three-game series at The Diamond from April 22-24 and won two of three against the Flying Squirrels in Richmond from May 21-23. The Flying Squirrels are trying to string together a stretch of consecutive wins for the fifth time this season. In games following a win, the Flying Squirrels are 6-11.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** ended a four-game losing streak with Friday's win over Reading, collecting a season-high nine runs. Since April 16, the Flying Squirrels have gone 12-28, and they're 8-19 since May 2. The Richmond offense ranks ninth in the league with a .232 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.98 team ERA, which is tenth in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost six of the last eight series, with the exceptions being two four-game splits against Akron. The last series win for Richmond came when it won two of three in Bowie from April 29-May 1. Richmond is 8-19 in May.

**THE FIGHTIN PHILS** have won 10 of their last 15 games since May 16 and had won three straight series before splitting two games against Erie in their last set. The Fightin Phils went 17-11 in May, the third-best mark in the league behind Hartford (19-8) and Binghamton (19-11). On the season, Reading has a 3.46 team ERA, which is sixth in the Eastern League, and a .220 team batting average, which is last in the league. Reading's roster includes seven of MLB.com's Top-30 Phillies prospects, including Adonis Medina (2), JoJo Romero (7), Mickey Moniak (9), Arquimedes Gamboa (13), Mauricio Llovera (15), David Parkinson (21) and Cornelius Randolph (25).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Garrett Williams** takes the mound for his tenth start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his third against Reading in Game 1. Last time out, he picked up his third straight loss after allowing three runs over 4.2 innings at Akron on Monday. He faced the Fightin Phils on April 14 at FirstEnergy Stadium and allowed three runs over 5.0 innings in a no-decision. He pitched against Reading again at home two starts ago, and he was charged with a loss after allowing four runs in 1.2 innings. Over his last six starts since April 26, Williams is 1-4 with a 6.65 ERA (16 ER/21.2 IP). He made 14 starts for Richmond last season and went 2-6 with a 6.00 ERA before moving to the bullpen when the calendar turned to July. As a reliever, he posted a 5.96 ERA in 18 appearances. Williams is ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 21 Giants prospect and No. 20 by MLB.com. **For more on Williams, see page two.**

Right-hander **Brandon Beachy** will start game two, his third start of the season for the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on April 15 at Hartford, working 5.0 scoreless inning and holding the Yard Goats to one hit to earn his first win in affiliated baseball since July 1, 2015 with Oklahoma City (AAA - Dodgers) at Memphis. He made his MLB debut with the Atlanta Braves in 2010 and spent three seasons in the Majors with them, totaling 46 starts with a 14-11 record and 3.23 ERA. His best season came in 2012, when he went 5-5 with a 2.00 ERA over 13 starts, posting the best ERA in the majors until his season ended with an elbow injury, requiring Tommy John surgery. He returned in 2013 but had to undergo Tommy John surgery again prior to the 2014 season. Beachy signed with the Dodgers in 2015 and briefly returned to the majors that year. He was held to one appearance in 2016 and did not pitch at all in 2017. Last year, he made 12 appearances for the independent New Britain Bees, going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA in 12 appearances (two starts). **For more on Beachy, see page three.**

**FOR READING:** Right-hander Adonis Medina makes his ninth start of the season for the Fightin Phils in Game 1. In his most recent start, Medina picked up his second straight win after tossing 5.0 innings and allowing one run at Harrisburg on Sunday. Over his last two starts, Medina is 2-0 with a 0.90 ERA (1 ER/10.0 IP). Medina has made two starts against the Flying Squirrels this year and has not picked up a decision. On April 14 in Reading, Medina allowed three runs over 5.0 innings. In his next start at The Diamond on April 22, he worked 5.0 innings again and allowed one run. Medina is ranked by MLB.com as the Phillies' No. 2 prospect and is in his first season at the Double-A level.

Right-hander Jose Taveras makes his second start of the season in Game 2. In his season debut on Sunday at Harrisburg, Taveras worked 5.0 scoreless innings and picked up a win, the first of his Double-A career. Last year, Taveras pitched nine games (three starts) between the GCL and Reading. With the Fightin Phils, he went 0-1 with a 5.95 ERA. For his career, Taveras has made nine appearances (six starts) with Reading over three seasons, going 1-2 with a 4.50 ERA.

**MAY WRAP:** The Flying Squirrels went 9-19 in May, worst in the league. It was tied for the second-worst record in a single month in franchise history (9-19, May 2016), behind only a 3-14 April in 2015. In the month of May, **Chris Shaw** hit .305 (9th in EL), posted a .505 SLG (9th), an .891 OPS (8th) had 29 hits (T-9th), 48 total bases (9th) and scored 17 runs (T-17th). **Johneshwy Fargas** tied the league lead with three triples and **Jacob Heyward** ranked tied for third with 16 walks. Fargas tied the league lead with five steals and **Jalen Miller** was tied for third with four. **Conner Menez** ranked tenth in ERA (2.54), first in BAA (153) and second in WHIP (0.78). **Melvin Adon** tied for first in games pitched (12) and tied for second in saves (5). As a team, the Flying Squirrels hit .238 (7th) and posted a 4.40 ERA (11th).

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Flying Squirrels are currently in a stretch of playing 15 of 18 games on the road dating back to May 24. In that span, the Flying Squirrels will travel approximately 2,288 miles (44 bus hours) around the northeast, almost long enough to cover the direct distance between Richmond and San Francisco.

**EAST FEAST:** From May 28-June 23, the Flying Squirrels play 23 of 26 games against teams from the Eastern Division. Today is the fifth game against the East in that stretch. The Flying Squirrels are 1-3 against the East in this cross-divisional span. Richmond is 7-15 against the opposite division this year.

**HEYWARD HEATING UP:** Over his last five games since May 26, **Jacob Heyward** is batting .364 (8-for-22) with a homer, a double and two RBIs. That stretch has raised his season batting average from .268 to .277, which is tied for seventh in the Giants organization. For the season, Heyward is ranked tied for fourth in the Eastern League with a .406 on-base percentage, ninth with an .860 OPS and tied for third with 27 walks. He leads all qualified Eastern League hitters with a .411 BABIP.

**FARGAS ON FIRE:** In his last five games, **Johneshwy Fargas** is batting .467 (7-for-15) with a double, two triples, two RBIs and three walks. He picked up two stolen bases on Friday night, bringing his season total to 13, which is second in the Eastern League and leads the Giants organization. He's now tied for fifth in the league with three triples on the season.

**ARENADO AWAKENS:** Since May 27, **Jonah Arenado** is batting .375 (6-for-16) with one RBI, one walk and one strikeout. On Thursday, he collected three hits. His .299 batting average for the season is ranked tied for seventh in the Eastern League and seventh in the Giants organization.

**FREQUENT FLYERS:** In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 28 homers on the road (T-1st in EL) in 21 games (1.33 per game - 1st in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

**PITCH IT:** Through April 22 in the first 15 games of the season, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 2.62 ERA (37 ER/127.0 IP), which was second-best in the Eastern League. Richmond starters had a 2.55 ERA (19 ER/67.0 IP) and relievers had a 2.70 ERA (18 ER/60.0 IP). Over the last 33 games dating back to April 23, Richmond pitchers have posted a 4.55 ERA (153 ER/302.2 IP). However, over the last eight games, Richmond pitchers have combined for a 2.62 ERA (22 ER/75.1 IP).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Five players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).
