**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels dropped the series opener against the Sea Dogs, 5-2. Richmond struck for the game's first run with an RBI single by **Gio Brusa** in the second inning. Joey Curletta hit a sac fly in the fourth to tie the score. In the fifth, **Johneshwy Fargas** put the Flying Squirrels back in front with an RBI single. Curletta tied the game in the sixth with a solo home run. Jerry Downs added a sac fly in the seventh to put Portland ahead and Tate Matheny hit a two-run single to extend the lead to 5-2 in the eighth. **Conner Menez** allowed three runs over six innings but was hit with his third loss of the season.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. It is the seventh game of an 11-game, ten-day road trip to Reading (2-3), Portland (0-1) and New Hampshire, the longest road stretch of the season for Richmond. The series is Richmond's first and only trip to Hadlock Field this season. Portland comes to The Diamond from July 30-August 1. Last year, the Flying Squirrels went 4-2 against the Sea Dogs, winning two of three in sets at home and on the road. The Flying Squirrels are 12-23 in games following a loss this season and 2-6 on Wednesdays.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost eight of their last ten games since May 27 and 11 of 15 games since May 22. Since April 16, the Flying Squirrels have gone 13-32, and they're 9-23 since May 2. The Richmond offense ranks ninth in the league with a .231 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 4.07 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost seven of the last nine series, with the exceptions being two four-game splits against Akron. The last series win for Richmond came when it won two of three in Bowie from April 29-May 1. The Flying Squirrels were mathematically eliminated from first-half playoff contention with Tuesday's loss.

**THE SEA DOGS** have won four straight games dating back to Friday, but had two of their games at Binghamton over the weekend postponed due to rain. In the rain-shortened set, they picked up their first series sweep of the year, starting with a 20-2 win on Friday. Since May 9, the Sea Dogs have gone 9-16, including an eight-game losing streak from May 14-20. The Sea Dogs rank sixth in the league with a .239 team batting average and last with a 4.15 team ERA. The Sea Dogs roster includes seven of MLB.com's Top-30 Red Sox prospects, including Bobby Dalbec (2), Darwinzon Hernandez (3), Tanner Houck (6), C.J. Chatham (8 - on IL), Jarren Duran (9), Durbin Feltman (11) and Denyi Reyes (18).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Alfred Gutierrez** makes his 11th start of the season for the Flying Squirrels. Last time out on Friday in Reading, he matched a season high with 5.2 inning pitched and allowed a season-high eight hits, but held the Fightin' Phils to three runs and picked up his second straight win. Over his last two starts, Gutierrez is 2-0 with a 3.18 ERA (4 ER/11.1 IP). Gutierrez is in his first season with the Giants organization after spending the previous seven with the Detroit Tigers. Last year, he spent time at three levels and made seven starts for the Erie SeaVolves in the Eastern League. He spent most of the season split between the starting rotation and bullpen with A-Adv. Lakeland and was named a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star. **For more on Gutierrez, see page two.**

**FOR PORTLAND:** Right-hander Denyi Reyes makes his 11th start of the season for the Sea Dogs. In his most recent start, Reyes pitched six scoreless innings at Hartford in a no-decision on Thursday. After starting the season 0-6 with a 5.49 ERA, Reyes has pitched back-to-back scoreless outings (12.0 total IP, 4 H, 2 BB, 15 SO) and picked up his first win on May 24 against Altoona. Reyes is in his first Double-A season and is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 18 Red Sox prospect.

**THERE'S ALWAYS NEXT YEAR HALF:** With Tuesday's loss to the Sea Dogs, the Flying Squirrels were mathematically eliminated from playoff contention for the Eastern League's first half. However, the second half of the 2019 season begins on Wednesday, June 19, and the records will reset for all teams. This year is the league's first season using a split-season format, and the postseason participants are clinched with the divisional champions of the first and second halves of the season. Prior to this year, the Eastern League was the only full-season league below Triple-A not adopting the split-season format, and playoff teams were decided by each division's champion and one runner-up wild-card team from each division.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Flying Squirrels are currently in a stretch of playing 15 of 18 games on the road dating back to May 24. In that span, the Flying Squirrels will travel approximately 2,288 miles (44 bus hours) around the northeast, almost long enough to cover the direct distance between Richmond and San Francisco. The current 11-game road trip is the longest of the season.

**EAST FEAST:** From May 28-June 23, the Flying Squirrels play 23 of 26 games against teams from the Eastern Division. Today is the tenth game against the East in that stretch. The Flying Squirrels are 2-7 against the East in this cross-divisional span. Richmond is 8-19 against the opposite division this year.

**FARGAS ON FIRE:** In his last ten games, **Johneshwy Fargas** is batting .346 (9-for-26) with a double, two triples, two RBIs, five walks and five runs scored. He has five stolen bases on the current road trip, bringing his season total to 16, which leads the Eastern League and leads the Giants organization.

**ARENADO AWAKENS:** Since May 27 in ten games, **Jonah Arenado** is batting .387 (12-for-31) with a double, three RBIs, one walk and two strikeouts. His .307 batting average for the season is ranked seventh in the Eastern League and third among full-season minor leaguers in the Giants organization. He is also seventh in the league with 55 total hits. Arenado has struck out just two times in his last 35 at-bats over ten games since May 26.

**HITS FOR HOUCHINS:** Over his last eight games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .387 (12-for-31) with two homers, two doubles and five RBIs. He has collected multiple hits in five of those seven games. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

**FREQUENT FLYERS:** In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 29 homers on the road (2nd in EL) in 26 games (1.12 per game - 1st in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

**HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T:** The Flying Squirrels have hit 10 home runs at home this season through 29 games (0.35 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

**PITCH IT:** Over the last eight games since May 29, Richmond pitchers have combined for a 4.99 ERA (36 ER/65.0 IP). Over the previous five games from May 24-28, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff combined for a 1.49 ERA (8 ER/48.1 IP). The Flying Squirrels have lost eight of their last ten games and have held a lead at some point in all but one of them, including four-run leads in two of the losses.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Five players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).
