YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels topped the Portland Sea Dogs, 4-3, in 11 innings to take the series. **Johneshwy Fargas** opened the scoring with an RBI single in the third inning. **Zach Houchins** added an RBI single in the fourth. Richmond starter **Garrett Williams** worked six scoreless innings, aided by four double plays. **Brandon Beachy** stranded the bases loaded in the seventh inning. Portland's Luke Tandler worked a bases-loaded walk in the eighth and Denier Lopez tied the score with an RBI groundout later in the inning. **Will Maddox** singled in a run in the tenth, but a wild pitch evened the score again in the bottom of the tenth. In the eleventh, **Jalen Miller** brought in the go-ahead run with a sac fly. **Sam Moll** worked through the bottom of the inning without allowing a run to finish the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a three-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is the ninth game of an 11-game, ten-day road trip to Reading (2-3), Portland (2-1) and New Hampshire, the longest road stretch of the season for Richmond. The Flying Squirrels are 7-13 this season in games following a win and 1-5 on Fridays.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost eight of their last 12 games since May 27, but have won three of four since Monday. The Richmond offense ranks ninth in the league with a .232 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.94 team ERA, which is 10th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost seven of the last ten series, with the exceptions being two four-game splits against Akron and winning two of three at Portland this week. In winning three of the last four games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .279 (39-for-140) and .205 (9-for-44) with runners in scoring position, while posting a 2.19 ERA (9 ER/37.0 IP).

THE FISHER CATS are the defending Eastern League Champions but are currently in fifth in the E.L. East. They have dropped two straight games and lost two of three in their last series against the Bowie Baysox. New Hampshire's offense is ranked third in the league with a .245 batting average and fourth with a 3.47 ERA. The Fisher Cats are under the direction of first-year manager Mike Mordecai, who played for the Richmond Braves in parts of five seasons (1992-94, '96-97), totaling 241 games. New Hampshire's roster includes seven of MLB.com's Top-30 Blue Jays prospects, including Nate Pearson (3), Kevin Smith (6), Hector Perez (14), Patrick Murphy (17), Yennsy Diaz (23), Riley Adams (28) and Santiago Espinal (29).

HEAD-TO-HEAD: The Flying Squirrels and Fisher Cats are facing off for the first series this season and Richmond's only trip to Manchester this season. The Fisher Cats make one trip to The Diamond this year, a three-game series from June 7-9. Last year, the Flying Squirrels lost two of three in their lone trip to New Hampshire. In the last series between these two teams, they split the first two games before the finale on August 12, 2018 was suspended after nine innings while tied, 1-1, and was never made up, resulting in an unofficial tie. The Flying Squirrels faced the Fisher Cats in the 2011 Eastern League Championship Series, dropping the best-of-five series in four games.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Brandon Lawson** makes his ninth start with the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Sunday at Reading and picked up a loss after allowing three runs over 5.0 innings. He has worked 5.0 innings in five of his last six starts. In that span, he has gone 1-2 with a 4.03 ERA (13 ER/29.0 IP). Lawson was signed as a minor-league free agent by the Giants on April 23 after being released by the Tampa Bay Rays near the end of spring training. He was originally drafted by the Rays in the 12th round in 2016 out of the University of South Florida and reached Double-A for 14 outings (five starts) last season with the Montgomery Biscuits. **For more on Lawson, see page two.**

FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE: Right-hander Patrick Murphy makes his 12th start of the season for the Fisher Cats. Last time out, he pitched 7.0 innings and allowed one run with no walks and five strikeouts in a win at Altoona on Sunday. On the year, Murphy is ranked sixth in the league in strikeouts (65), seventh in innings pitched (63.1), eighth in opponents' batting average (.201) and tied for seventh in WHIP (1.01). Murphy was drafted by the Blue Jays in the third round in 2013 out of Hamilton (Ariz.) HS and is currently ranked by MLB.com as the Blue Jays' No. 17 prospect.

WIN ONE (TODAY), THAT'S CALLED A WINNING STREAK: The Flying Squirrels have picked up back-to-back wins, marking the fifth time this season the team has strung together a run of consecutive wins. Thursday's win clinched the Flying Squirrels third series win of the season and first since winning two of three games in Bowie from April 29-May 1. Richmond is searching for a third straight win, which would tie a season high (April 4-6 vs. HFD, May 18-21 vs. AKR/REA).

THERE'S ALWAYS NEXT YEAR HALF: With Tuesday's loss to the Sea Dogs, the Flying Squirrels were mathematically eliminated from playoff contention for the Eastern League's first half. However, the second half of the 2019 season begins on Wednesday, June 19, and the records will reset for all teams. This year is the league's first season using a split-season format, and the postseason participants are clinched with the divisional champions of the first and second halves of the season. Prior to this year, the Eastern League was the only full-season league below Triple-A not adopting the split-season format, and playoff teams were decided by each division's champion and one runner-up wild-card team from each division.

ROAD WARRIOR: The Flying Squirrels are currently in a stretch of playing 15 of 18 games on the road dating back to May 24. In that span, the Flying Squirrels will travel approximately 2,288 miles (44 bus hours) around the northeast, almost long enough to cover the direct distance between Richmond and San Francisco. The current 11-game road trip is the longest of the season.

EAST FEAST: From May 28-June 23, the Flying Squirrels play 23 of 26 games against teams from the Eastern Division. Today is the 12th game against the East in that stretch. The Flying Squirrels are 4-7 against the East in this cross-divisional span. Richmond is 10-19 against the opposite division this year.

HITS FOR HOCHINS: Over his last ten games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .395 (15-for-38) with three homers, three doubles and 10 RBIs. He has collected multiple hits in six of those ten games. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

FARGAS ON FIRE: In his last 12 games, **Johneshwy Fargas** is batting .294 (10-for-34) with a double, two triples, three RBIs, five walks and six runs scored. He has six stolen bases on the current road trip, bringing his season total to 17, which leads the Eastern League and leads the Giants organization.

MCIELROY ATTACK: In his last three games, **C.J. McElroy** has hit .385 (5-for-13) with a triple, a walk and three runs scored. Prior to that stretch, he hit .074 (2-for-27). He has also gone 3-for-3 in stolen base attempts over his last two games, bringing his season total to 6-for-6.

ARENADO AWAKENS: Since May 27 in 11 games, **Jonah Arenado** is batting .343 (12-for-35) with a double, three RBIs, one walk and two strikeouts. His .301 batting average for the season is ranked eighth in the Eastern League and fourth among full-season minor leaguers in the Giants organization. He is also tied for seventh in the league with 55 total hits. Arenado has struck out just three times in his last 39 at-bats over 11 games since May 26.

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 30 homers on the road (2nd in EL) in 28 games (1.07 per game - 2nd in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit 10 home runs at home this season through 29 games (0.35 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

HOLD ON: In losing eight of their last 12 games, the Flying Squirrels have held a lead at some point in all but one of those games, including four-run leads in two of the losses. The only game in that stretch in which the Flying Squirrels did not hold a lead was a 5-2 loss at Reading on Sunday. On the year, the Flying Squirrels are 14-16 when scoring first.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Five players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).

THIS DATE IN HISTORY

In 2015, the Flying Squirrels beat the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 4-1, at Northeast Delta Dental Stadium. Matt Lujan worked 6.1 innings and allowed one run. He struck out eight batters, which is tied for the most in a game by a Flying Squirrels pitcher against the Fisher Cats in franchise history. Myles Schroder hit a three-run homer to give the Flying Squirrels a 3-1 lead in the seventh. Engel Beltre added a solo homer in the eighth to open the lead to 4-1.
