YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels brought in a season high in runs in a 14-5 win over the Fisher Cats, their third straight win. Jacob Heyward brought in the first run of the game in the first inning and added a two-run double in the third to open a 3-0 lead. Zach Houchins and Brandon Van Horn brought in two more runs in the third. In the fifth, Van Horn and Johneshwy Fargas each brought in a run, opening an 8-0 lead. New Hampshire scored three in the fifth to pull back within five. In the sixth, Heyward led off with a homer, Houchins hit a two-run homer, Hamlet Marte hit an RBI double and C.J. McElroy drove in runs to cap the five-run inning and pushed the lead to 13-3. After a solo homer by Josh Palacios in the sixth, Jonah Arenado doubled in a run in the seventh. Brock Lundquist hit a solo homer in the eighth to make the score 14-5. Brandon Lawson worked a season-high 5.1 innings to pick up his second win of the year, allowing four runs.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is the tenth game of an 11-game, ten-day road trip to Reading (2-3), Portland (2-1) and New Hampshire (1-0), the longest road stretch of the season for Richmond. The Flying Squirrels are 8-13 this season in games following a win and 4-7 on Saturdays. Richmond is looking for its first four-game win streak of the year and first time winning back-to-back series this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won four of the last five games since Monday to move into fifth in the division, following a span of losing seven of eight from May 28-June 2. The Richmond offense ranks ninth in the league with a .234 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.96 team ERA, which is 10th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost seven of the last ten series, with the exceptions being two four-game splits against Akron and winning two of three at Portland this week. In winning four of the last five games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .382 (51-for-180) and .207 (12-for-58) with runners in scoring position, while posting a 2.74 ERA (14 ER/46.0 IP).

THE FISHER CATS are the defending Eastern League Champions but are currently in fifth in the E.L. East. They have dropped three straight games and lost two of three in their last series against the Bowie Baysox. New Hampshire's offense is ranked third in the league with a .244 batting average and tied for sixth with a 3.58 ERA. The Fisher Cats are under the direction of first-year manager Mike Mordecai, who played for the Richmond Braves in parts of five seasons (1992-94, '96-97), totaling 241 games. New Hampshire's roster includes seven of MLB.com's Top-30 Blue Jays prospects, including Nate Pearson (3), Kevin Smith (6), Hector Perez (14), Patrick Murphy (17), Yennsy Diaz (23), Riley Adams (28) and Santiago Espinal (29).

HEAD-TO-HEAD: The Flying Squirrels and Fisher Cats are facing off for the first series this season and Richmond's only trip to Manchester this season. The Fisher Cats make one trip to The Diamond this year, a three-game series from June 7-9. Last year, the Flying Squirrels lost two of three in their lone trip to New Hampshire. In the last series between these two teams, they split the first two games before the finale on August 12, 2018 was suspended after nine innings while tied, 1-1, and was never made up, resulting in an unofficial tie. Richmond has won eight of its nine regular-season all-time series in Manchester. The Flying Squirrels faced the Fisher Cats in the 2011 Eastern League Championship Series, dropping the best-of-five series in four games.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Caleb Baragar makes his sixth start and seventh overall appearance for the Flying Squirrels this season. Last time out, Baragar matched a season high with 6.2 innings pitched and allowed two runs in a win at Reading on Monday. Over his last four starts, Baragar has gone 2-0 with a 1.96 ERA (5 ER/22.2 IP). Prior to joining Richmond, Baragar made one start with Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. He began the season with A-Adv. San Jose and went 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA in four starts and one relief outing. Baragar was drafted by the Giants in the ninth round in 2016 out of Indiana University and is in his fourth professional season. **For more on Baragar, see page two.**

FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE: Left-hander Zach Logue makes his 11th start of the season for the Fisher Cats. In his last outing, Logue allowed two runs over 5.0 innings on May 29 at Harrisburg. Over his last four starts, Logue has gone 1-1 with a 3.33 ERA (9 ER/24.1 IP). Logue was drafted by the Blue Jays in the ninth round in 2017 out of Kentucky and is in his first Double-A season.

THAT'S CALLED A WINNING STREAK: Friday's win tied the longest winning streak of the season at three games (April 4-6 vs. HFD, May 18-21 vs. AKR/REA). The current stretch is the fifth time this season the team has strung together a run of consecutive wins.

THERE'S ALWAYS NEXT YEAR HALF: With Tuesday's loss to the Sea Dogs, the Flying Squirrels were mathematically eliminated from playoff contention for the Eastern League's first half. However, the second half of the 2019 season begins on Wednesday, June 19, and the records will reset for all teams. This year is the league's first season using a split-season format, and the postseason participants are clinched with the divisional champions of the first and second halves of the season. Prior to this year, the Eastern League was the only full-season league below Triple-A not adopting the split-season format, and playoff teams were decided by each division's champion and one runner-up wild-card team from each division.

ROAD WARRIOR: The Flying Squirrels are currently in a stretch of playing 15 of 18 games on the road dating back to May 24. In that span, the Flying Squirrels will travel approximately 2,288 miles (44 bus hours) around the northeast, almost long enough to cover the direct distance between Richmond and San Francisco. The current 11-game road trip is the longest of the season.

EAST FEAST: From May 28-June 23, the Flying Squirrels play 23 of 26 games against teams from the Eastern Division. Today is the 13th game against the East in that stretch. The Flying Squirrels are 5-7 against the East in this cross-divisional span. Richmond is 11-19 against the opposite division this year.

HITS FOR HOUCHINS: Over his last 11 games since May 29, Zach Houchins has hit .405 (17-for-42) with four homers, three doubles and 14 RBIs. He has collected multiple hits in even of those 11 games. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31). In his last five games, Houchins has hit .474 (9-for-19) with three homers, two doubles, 10 RBIs and two walks.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 57 stolen bases. Johneshwy Fargas leads the league with 17 steals this year, followed by Jalen Miller with 16. C.J. McElroy is 6-for-6 in steal attempts and third on the team in stolen bases. In nine games on the current road trip, the Flying Squirrels have stolen 16 bases, including eight in the last three games.

MCLEROY ATTACK: In his last four games, C.J. McElroy has hit .333 (6-for-18) with a double, a triple, two walks, two RBIs and four runs scored. Prior to that stretch, he hit .074 (2-for-27). He has also gone 3-for-3 in stolen base attempts over his last three games, bringing his season total to 6-for-6.

ARENADO AWAKENS: Since May 27 in 12 games, Jonah Arenado is batting .350 (14-for-40) with two doubles, four RBIs, two walks and two strikeouts. His .303 batting average for the season is ranked sixth in the Eastern League and second among full-season minor leaguers in the Giants organization. He is also tied for sixth in the league with 57 total hits. Arenado has struck out just three times in his last 44 at-bats over 12 games since May 26.

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 32 homers on the road (2nd in EL) in 29 games (1.10 per game - 2nd in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

HOLD ON: In losing eight of their last 3 games, the Flying Squirrels have held a lead at some point in all but one of those games, including four-run leads in two of the losses. The only game in that stretch in which the Flying Squirrels did not hold a lead was a 5-2 loss at Reading on Sunday. On the year, the Flying Squirrels are 15-16 when scoring first.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher Logan Webb (6), right-handed pitcher Melvin Adon (12), outfielder Heath Quinn (15), left-handed pitcher Garrett Williams (21), left-handed pitcher Conner Menez (25) and infielder Jalen Miller (30). Five players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).
