**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels saw their three-game winning streak end with a 4-3 loss to the Fisher Cats in 10 innings. In the bottom of the tenth with the bases loaded and two outs, Santiago Espinal completed a straight steal of home to score the walk-off winning run. Richmond opened a 1-0 lead in the second with an RBI single by **Brandon Van Horn**. Richmond starter **Caleb Baragar** did not allow a run through his first 6.2 innings until an RBI single by Josh Palacios in the seventh. **Raffi Vizcaino** hit Nash Knight with a pitch to give New Hampshire a 2-1 lead later in the inning. In the eighth, **Johneshwy Fargas** stole third, his fourth steal of the game, and came in to score on a wild pitch to tie the score at 2-2. **Zach Houchins** hit a two-run homer to give the Flying Squirrels a 4-2 lead. Vizcaino threw a wild pitch in the eighth that brought in a run and Alberto Mineo tied the score at 4-4 with a sac fly later in the eighth.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a three-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is the last game of an 11-game, ten-day road trip to Reading (2-3), Portland (2-1) and New Hampshire (1-1), the longest road stretch of the season for Richmond. The Flying Squirrels are 13-23 this season in games following a loss, 4-3 on Sundays, 7-8 in last games of a series and 2-5 in series rubber games. The Flying Squirrels are looking for their fourth series win of the year and second straight series win for the first time this season.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won four of the last six games since Monday following a span of losing seven of eight from May 28-June 2. The Richmond offense ranks ninth in the league with a .233 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.95 team ERA, which is 10th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost seven of the last ten series, with the exceptions being two four-game splits against Akron and winning two of three at Portland this week. In winning four of the last six games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .269 (58-for-216) and .186 (13-for-70) with runners in scoring position, while posting a 2.91 ERA (18 ER/55.2 IP).

**THE FISHER CATS** are the defending Eastern League Champions but are currently in fifth in the E.L. East. They have dropped three straight games and lost two of three in their last series against the Bowie Baysox. New Hampshire's offense is ranked tied for third in the league with a .244 batting average and tied for seventh with a 3.57 ERA. The Fisher Cats are under the direction of first-year manager Mike Mordecai, who played for the Richmond Braves in parts of five seasons (1992-94, '96-97), totaling 241 games. New Hampshire's roster includes seven of MLB.com's Top-30 Blue Jays prospects, including Nate Pearson (3), Kevin Smith (6), Hector Perez (14), Patrick Murphy (17), Yennsy Diaz (23), Riley Adams (28) and Santiago Espinal (29).

**HEAD-TO-HEAD:** The Flying Squirrels and Fisher Cats are facing off for the first series this season and Richmond's only trip to Manchester this season. The Fisher Cats make one trip to The Diamond this year, a three-game series from June 7-9. Last year, the Flying Squirrels lost two of three in their lone trip to New Hampshire. In the last series between these two teams, they split the first two games before the finale on August 12, 2018 was suspended after nine innings while tied, 1-1, and was never made up, resulting in an unofficial tie. Richmond has won eight of its nine regular-season all-time series in Manchester. The Flying Squirrels faced the Fisher Cats in the 2011 Eastern League Championship Series, dropping the best-of-five series in four games.

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Brandon Beachy** makes his fourth start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his fifth overall appearance. In his last start, Beachy allowed two runs over 4.0 innings in the second game of a double-header last Saturday in Reading. He pitched in relief on Thursday at Portland, working a scoreless inning with three strikeouts and stranded the bases loaded. Beachy made his MLB debut with the Atlanta Braves in 2010 and spent three seasons in the Majors with them, totaling 46 starts with a 14-11 record and 3.23 ERA. His best season came in 2012, when he went 5-5 with a 2.00 ERA over 13 starts, posting the best ERA in the majors until his season ended with an elbow injury, requiring Tommy John surgery. He returned in 2013 but had to undergo Tommy John surgery again prior to the 2014 season. Beachy signed with the Dodgers in 2015 and briefly returned to the majors that year. He was held to one appearance in 2016 and did not pitch at all in 2017. Last year, he made 12 appearances for the independent New Britain Bees, going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA in 12 appearances (two starts). *For more on Beachy, see page two.*

**FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE:** Right-hander Nate Pearson makes his seventh start of the season for the Fisher Cats. He last pitched on Tuesday against the Bowie Baysox and worked 2.0 perfect innings. This season, he has alternated outings of 2.0 innings and 4.0-5.0 innings. Pearson was drafted by the Blue Jays in the first round (28th overall) in 2017 and is currently ranked by MLB.com as Toronto's No. 2 prospect. In his first full season last year, he was limited to one appearance after being hit by a line drive that fractured his forearm. He returned to pitch in the Arizona Fall League last year.

**MOVING UP:** Left-hander **Conner Menez** was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento after his outing on Tuesday in Portland. He leaves the Eastern League ranked eighth in ERA (2.72), third in strikeouts (70), tenth in innings pitched (59.2), fourth in opponents' batting average (.179) and sixth in WHIP (0.96). He was also ranked fifth in SO/9 IP ratio (10.56). He picked up at least eight strikeouts in five of his 11 starts for the Flying Squirrels. Over his two seasons with the Flying Squirrels, Menez combined to go 9-7 with a 3.64 ERA in 26 starts and struck out 162 batters in 133.2 IP, a ratio of 10.91 strikeouts per nine innings, which is the highest in Flying Squirrels franchise history.

**ROAD WARRIOR:** The Flying Squirrels are currently in a stretch of playing 15 of 18 games on the road dating back to May 24. In that span, the Flying Squirrels will travel approximately 2,288 miles (44 bus hours) around the northeast, almost long enough to cover the direct distance between Richmond and San Francisco. The current 11-game road trip is the longest of the season.

**EAST FEAST:** From May 28-June 23, the Flying Squirrels play 23 of 26 games against teams from the Eastern Division. Today is the 14th game against the East in that stretch. The Flying Squirrels are 5-8 against the East in this cross-divisional span. Richmond is 11-20 against the opposite division this year.

**HITS FOR HOUCHINS:** Over his last 12 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .413 (19-for-46) with five homers, three doubles and 16 RBIs. He has collected multiple hits in eight of those 12 games. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31). In his last six games, Houchins has hit .478 (11-for-23) with four homers, two doubles, 12 RBIs and three walks.

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 62 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 21 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 17. **C.J. McElroy** is 6-for-7 in steal attempts and third on the team in stolen bases. In ten games on the current road trip, the Flying Squirrels have stolen 21 bases, including 13 in the last four games. On Saturday, Fargas stole four bases, second-most in a game in team history, and the team set a season high with five steals.

**McELROY ATTACK:** In his last five games, **C.J. McElroy** has hit .349 (8-for-23) with a double, a triple, two walks, two RBIs and four runs scored. Prior to that stretch, he hit .074 (2-for-27).

**ARENADO AWAKENS:** Since May 27 in 13 games, **Jonah Arenado** is batting .333 (15-for-45) with two doubles, four RBIs, two walks and two strikeouts. His .301 batting average for the season is ranked fifth in the Eastern League and second among full-season minor leaguers in the Giants organization. He is also tied for sixth in the league with 58 total hits.

**FREQUENT FLYERS:** In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 33 homers on the road (T-1st in EL) in 30 games (1.10 per game - 1st in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

**HOLD ON:** In losing nine of their last 14 games, the Flying Squirrels have held a lead at some point in all but one of those games, including four-run leads in two of the losses. The only game in that stretch in which the Flying Squirrels did not hold a lead was a 5-2 loss at Reading last Sunday. On the year, the Flying Squirrels are 15-17 when scoring first.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Five players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).

- Attended Northwestern High School in Kokomo, Ind.
- Attended Indiana Wesleyan University, where he was a third baseman and a closer
- Originally signed by the Braves as a non-drafted free agent in 2008
- Made MLB debut with Atlanta on Sept. 20, 2010
- In 2011, led Braves staff and ranked second among MLB rookies with 169 strikeouts, the most by a Braves rookie in modern-era franchise history at the time and 10.74 K/9 IP was fourth all-time among rookie starting pitchers (min. 25 starts) in MLB history behind Kerry Wood (1998), Dwight Gooden (1984) and Hideo Nomo (1995)
- Made 13 MLB starts in 2012 and went 5-5 with a 2.00 ERA (T-1st in MLB at time) and .171 BAA (1st in MLB) before being placed on DL on 6/16, undergoing Tommy John surgery on 6/21
- Had second Tommy John surgery in March 2014
- Signed with Dodgers for 2015 and made two MLB starts
- Limited to one appearance in AZL in 2016 with elbow injury
- Made only 25 total appearances from 2014-2017
- Spent 2018 season with independent New Britain Bees of the Atlantic League and made 12 appearances (2 starts), going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA in 12.2 IP
