YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels fell behind early and lost their third straight game with a 6-2 defeat to the Harrisburg Senators. Harrisburg jumped ahead 4-0 in the first inning against **Alfred Gutierrez** with an RBI double by Tres Barrera, a two-run single by Ian Sagdal and an RBI double by Dante Bichette Jr., all with two outs. Chuck Taylor added an RBI single in the second to extend the Senators' lead to 5-0. Richmond scored its only two runs in the third with an RBI double by **Jalen Miller** and an RBI single by **Zach Houchins**. Sagdal brought in a run with an RBI single in the ninth. Gutierrez saw his three-start win streak snapped with his third loss of the year, allowing five runs in 4.2 innings. **Ryan Halsead** worked 2.1 scoreless relief innings. Harrisburg reliever Jacob Condra-Bogart pitched 3.0 scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. It is also the second of a six-game homestand against Harrisburg (0-1) and New Hampshire. This series is the first of the season between the Flying Squirrels and the Senators. Last year, the Flying Squirrels went 5-14 against the Senators, their worst record against Harrisburg in franchise history, including a four-game sweep to close the season by the Senators. Richmond has lost eight consecutive games against the Senators, the second-longest losing streak for the Flying Squirrels against one team in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have dropped three straight games on the heels of winning four of five. Since May 2, the Flying Squirrels have gone 12-26, and they lost seven of eight from May 28-June 2. The Richmond offense ranks tied for ninth in the league with a .228 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.95 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost eight of the last 11 series, with the exceptions being two four-game splits against Akron and winning two of three at Portland this week. Over the last two games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .071 (4/56) and have scored two runs.

THE SENATORS are leading the Western Division by 7.0 games over Akron and Altoona with seven games remaining before the first-half champion is crowned. Prior to this series, the Senators dropped two of three at Reading. Harrisburg is 4-5 in its last nine games. The Senators are ranked third in the league with a .245 team batting average and fourth with a 3.46 team ERA. The Senators opened the season with a 21-4 record through the end of April, their best start in franchise history. The Harrisburg roster includes seven of MLB.com's Top-30 Nationals prospects, including Luis Garcia (2), Wil Crowe (4), Sterling Sharp (8 - on IL), Tres Barrera (19 - on IL), Taylor Guilbeau (22), Ben Braymer (23) and Jackson Tetra (25).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Garrett Williams** takes the mound for his 12th start of the season for the Flying Squirrels. In his last outing, he snapped a four-start losing streak with 6.0 scoreless innings at Portland on Thursday. In that appearance, he allowed four hits, four walks and hit two batters, but he was helped by four double plays and five strikeouts. Over his previous four starts, Williams went 0-4 with a 6.75 ERA (12 ER/16 IP). For his career against Harrisburg, Williams is 0-2 with a 5.59 ERA (6 ER/9.2 IP) in two starts and two relief outings, all in 2018. He made 14 starts for Richmond last season and went 2-6 with a 6.00 ERA before moving to the bullpen when the calendar turned to July. As a reliever, he posted a 5.96 ERA in 18 appearances. Williams is ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 21 Giants prospect and No. 20 by MLB.com. **For more on Williams, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Ben Braymer makes his 12th start of the season for the Senators. Last time out, he worked 4.1 innings and allowed three runs in a no-decision against Binghamton on Thursday, which snapped a three-start losing streak. Over his three previous starts from May 21-31, Braymer went 0-3 with a 2.89 ERA (6 ER/18.2 IP). From May 2-15, Braymer went 2-0 with a 1.29 ERA (3 ER/21.0 IP) and worked seven innings each time out. He posted a 2.04 ERA over six starts in May. Braymer was drafted by the Nationals in the 18th round in 2016 out of Auburn and is currently ranked by MLB.com as Washington's No. 23 prospect.

HOME: The Flying Squirrels have lost six consecutive home games since May 22. Since April 20, the Flying Squirrels are 4-19 at home, including eight straight losses from April 20-May 4. On the year, the Flying Squirrels are batting .221 at home, lowest in the league, compared to .236 on the road (7th).

HITS FOR HOUCHEINS: Over his last 14 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .377 (20-for-53) with five homers, three doubles and 17 RBIs. He has collected multiple hits in eight of those 14 games. On Monday, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 (11-for-26) with four homers, two doubles, three walks, 12 RBIs and eight runs scored over seven games from June 3-9, with multiple hits in five of those games. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

GRAND LARCY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 64 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 21 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. **C.J. McElroy** is 6-for-7 in steal attempts and third on the team in stolen bases. In 11 games on the last road trip, the Flying Squirrels stole 21 bases. Over the last six games, the team has combined for 15 steals. On Saturday, Fargas stole four bases, second-most in a game in team history, and the team set a season high with five steals.

McELROY ATTACK: In his last six games, **C.J. McElroy** has hit .308 (8-for-26) with a double, a triple, two walks, two RBIs and four runs scored. Prior to that stretch, he hit .074 (2-for-27).

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 33 homers on the road (T-1st in EL) in 31 games (1.07 per game - 1st in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit 10 home runs at home this season through 30 games (0.33 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

HOLD ON: In losing 11 of their last 16 games, the Flying Squirrels have held a lead at some point in all but three of those games, including four-run leads in two of the losses. On the year, the Flying Squirrels are 15-17 when scoring first.

EAST FEAST: From May 28-June 23, the Flying Squirrels play 23 of 26 games against teams from the Eastern Division, with the only exclusion being the current three-game series with Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels are 5-9 against the East in that cross-divisional span. Richmond is 11-21 against the opposite division this year.

THERE'S ALWAYS NEXT YEAR HALF: With a June 4 loss to the Sea Dogs, the Flying Squirrels were mathematically eliminated from playoff contention for the Eastern League's first half. However, the second half of the 2019 season begins on Wednesday, June 19, and the records will reset for all teams. This year is the league's first season using a split-season format, and the postseason participants are clinched with the divisional champions of the first and second halves of the season. Prior to this year, the Eastern League was the only full-season league below Triple-A not adopting the split-season format, and playoff teams were decided by each division's champion and one runner-up wild-card team from each division.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Five players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).

THIS DATE IN HISTORY

In 2012, the Flying Squirrels beat the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 3-2, at The Diamond. Andy Reichard picked up his first win after allowing one run in 6.0 innings. Tommy Joseph hit a single in the bottom of the third to put the Flying Squirrels ahead for good. Gary Brown went 1-for-4 and scored a run with a single in the third. It was the first of what ended up being a 36-game on-base streak for Brown, running through July 20, which is still the franchise record today.
