YESTERDAY: After being no-hit through the first 9.1 innings, the Flying Squirrels beat the Harrisburg Senators, 1-0, on a walk-off single by **Jalen Miller** in the bottom of the tenth. Miller's single broke up the no-hitter and was Richmond's lone hit in the game. It brought in **Johneshwy Fargas**, who was the runner placed at second to begin the extra frame. Richmond starter **Garrett Williams** pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, his second straight start without allowing a run. **Tyler Cyr** and **Melvin Adon** combined for 5.0 scoreless relief innings. Harrisburg starter Ben Braymer threw 8.0 hitless innings with one walk and seven strikeouts. Bryan Bonnell pitched a scoreless ninth before allowing the winning run in the tenth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a three-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. It is also the third of a six-game homestand against Harrisburg (1-1) and New Hampshire. This series is the first of the season between the Flying Squirrels and the Senators. Last year, the Flying Squirrels went 5-14 against the Senators, their worst record against Harrisburg in franchise history, including a four-game sweep to close the season by the Senators. Prior to Wednesday's win, Richmond had lost eight consecutive games against the Senators, the second-longest losing streak for the Flying Squirrels against one team in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS snapped a three-game losing streak with Wednesday's win. Since May 2, the Flying Squirrels have gone 12-27. The Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .226 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.87 team ERA, which is tied for tenth in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost eight of the last 11 series, with the exceptions being two four-game splits against Akron and winning two of three at Portland this week. Over the last three games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .059 (5/85) and have scored three runs.

THE SENATORS clinched the first-half Western Division title with Altoona's loss on Wednesday, locking them into the Eastern League postseason for the first time since 2013. Prior to this series, the Senators dropped two of three at Reading. The Senators are ranked tied for fourth in the league with a .242 team batting average and fourth with a 3.40 team ERA. The Senators opened the season with a 21-4 record through the end of April, their best start in franchise history. The Harrisburg roster includes seven of MLB.com's Top-30 Nationals prospects, including Luis Garcia (2), Wil Crowe (4), Sterling Sharp (8 - on IL), Tres Barrera (19 - on IL), Taylor Guilbeau (22), Ben Braymer (23) and Jackson Tetreault (25).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Brandon Lawson** makes his tenth start with the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he picked up his first win of the season since May 13, working 5.1 innings and allowing a season-high four earned runs. He has worked at least 5.0 innings in six of his last seven starts. In that span, he has gone 2-2 with a 4.57 ERA (17 ER/34.1 IP). For the season, Lawson has the second-lowest swinging strike percentage (5.8%) and third-lowest strikeout percentage (11.9%) of all pitchers in the Eastern League with at least 40 innings pitched. Lawson was signed as a minor-league free agent by the Giants on April 23 after being released by the Tampa Bay Rays near the end of spring training. He was originally drafted by the Rays in the 12th round in 2016 out of the University of South Florida and reached Double-A for 14 outings (five starts) last season with the Montgomery Biscuits. **For more on Lawson, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander **Wil Crowe** makes his 13th start of the season for the Senators. In his last start, Crowe allowed a season-high six earned runs over 5.0 innings in a loss at Reading on Friday. Crowe started the season 3-0 with a 0.96 ERA in his first five starts of the year through April 28. Since then, Crowe has gone 2-5 with a 5.66 ERA (26 ER/41.1 IP). Crowe was drafted by the Nationals in the second round in 2016 out of the University of South Carolina and is currently ranked as the Nationals' No. 4 prospect by MLB.com.

HOMESICK: The Flying Squirrels have lost six of seven home games since May 22. Since April 20, the Flying Squirrels are 5-19 at home, including eight straight losses from April 20-May 4. On the year, the Flying Squirrels are batting .215 at home, lowest in the league, compared to .236 on the road (7th).

HITS FOR HOUCHINS: Over his last 15 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .364 (20-for-55) with five homers, three doubles and 17 RBIs. He has collected multiple hits in eight of those 15 games. On Monday, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 (11-for-26) with four homers, two doubles, three walks, 12 RBIs and eight runs scored over seven games from June 3-9, with multiple hits in five of those games. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 64 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 21 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. **C.J. McElroy** is 6-for-7 in steal attempts and third on the team in stolen bases. In 11 games on the last road trip, the Flying Squirrels stole 21 bases. Over the last seven games, the team has combined for 15 steals. On Saturday, Fargas stole four bases, second-most in a game in team history, and the team set a season high with five steals.

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 33 homers on the road (T-1st in EL) in 31 games (1.07 per game - 1st in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit 10 home runs at home this season through 30 games (0.33 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

HOLD ON: In losing 11 of their last 17 games, the Flying Squirrels have held a lead at some point in all but three of those games, including four-run leads in two of the losses. On the year, the Flying Squirrels are 16-17 when scoring first.

EAST FEAST: From May 28-June 23, the Flying Squirrels play 23 of 26 games against teams from the Eastern Division, with the only exclusion being the current three-game series with Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels are 5-9 against the East in that cross-divisional span. Richmond is 11-21 against the opposite division this year.

THERE'S ALWAYS NEXT YEAR HALF: With a June 4 loss to the Sea Dogs, the Flying Squirrels were mathematically eliminated from playoff contention for the Eastern League's first half. However, the second half of the 2019 season begins on Wednesday, June 19, and the records will reset for all teams. This year is the league's first season using a split-season format, and the postseason participants are clinched with the divisional champions of the first and second halves of the season. Prior to this year, the Eastern League was the only full-season league below Triple-A not adopting the split-season format, and playoff teams were decided by each division's champion and one runner-up wild-card team from each division.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Five players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).

In 2015, former Flying Squirrels player and UVA star Jarrett Parker made major league debut for the San Francisco Giants. He started the game, a 4-2 Giants loss on the road against the Arizona Diamondbacks, as the left fielder. Parker played two seasons with the Flying Squirrels in 2013 and 2014 hitting .259 with 30 homers and 115 RBIs in 231 total games. He spent three MLB seasons with the Giants from 2015 through 2017 and hit .257 with 15 homers and 51 RBIs.
