YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels fell to the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 4-2, in the series opener. Gio Brusa hit a solo home run in the second to open the scoring. Santiago Espinal tied the score in the fifth with a solo home run for the Fisher Cats. Jalen Miller brought in a run with an RBI groundout in the fifth to put Richmond ahead, 2-1. New Hampshire tied the score in the seventh with an RBI single by Nash Knight. The Fisher Cats took the lead in the top of the ninth with a two-run single by Riley Adams. Richmond starter Caleb Baragar allowed one run over 5.0 innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is also the fourth of a six-game homestand against Harrisburg (1-2) and New Hampshire (0-1). This series is the second and final of the season between the Flying Squirrels and the Fisher Cats. Richmond dropped two of three in New Hampshire last weekend.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost five of the last six since Saturday in New Hampshire after winning four of the previous five games from June 3-7. Over the last six games, the Flying Squirrels have hit 144 (27-for-188) and have scored 12 runs. Since May 2, the Flying Squirrels have gone 12-29. The Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .225 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.84 team ERA, which is 10th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost nine of the last 12 series, with the exceptions being two four-game splits against Akron and winning two of three at Portland this week. Over the last five games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .130 (20/154) and have scored eight runs. Richmond's -67 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -40). Richmond is 0-25 when trailing through five innings, the only team in the league without at least one win in such games, and 0-30 when trailing through seven innings.

THE FISHER CATS have lost six of their last nine games, including being swept in a three-game series at Bowie in their last set. The only three wins since June 5 are against Richmond. As a team, the Fisher Cats are batting .238, which is tied for sixth in the league. New Hampshire's pitching staff is ranked eighth in the league with a 3.58 team ERA. The defending Eastern League champs, the Fisher Cats have been eliminated from the first-half postseason race. New Hampshire's roster includes seven of MLB.com's Top-30 Blue Jays prospects, including Nate Pearson (2), Kevin Smith (5), Hector Perez (13), Patrick Murphy (16), Yennsy Diaz (22), Riley Adams (27) and Santiago Espinal (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Brandon Beachy** makes his fifth start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his sixth overall appearance. Last time out, Beachy worked 5.2 innings and allowed two runs at New Hampshire on Sunday, he was charged with a loss as the Flying Squirrels were blanked, 2-0, in the series finale. Beachy is making his first start at The Diamond since April 7, his Flying Squirrels debut. Beachy made his MLB debut with the Atlanta Braves in 2010 and spent three seasons in the Majors with them, totaling 46 starts with a 14-11 record and 3.23 ERA. His best season came in 2012, when he went 5-5 with a 2.00 ERA over 13 starts, posting the best ERA in the majors until his season ended with an elbow injury, requiring Tommy John surgery. He returned in 2013 but had to undergo Tommy John surgery again prior to the 2014 season. Beachy signed with the Dodgers in 2015 and briefly returned to the majors that year. He was held to one appearance in 2016 and did not pitch at all in 2017. Last year, he made 12 appearances for the independent New Britain Bees, going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA in 12 appearances (two starts). *For more on Beachy, see page two*.

FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE: Right-hander Nate Pearson makes his eighth start of the season for the Fisher Cats. He faced the Flying Squirrels on Sunday in Manchester and allowed one hit over 5.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision. Over his last two starts, he has allowed one hit and one walk with 7.0 scoreless innings. On the year, Pearson has alternated starts of approximately 5.0 innings and 2.0 innings. Pearson was drafted by the Blue Jays in the first round (28th overall) in 2017 and is currently ranked by MLB.com as the Blue Jays' No. 2 prospect and the No. 51 prospect in baseball.

TROUBLE AT HOME: The Flying Squirrels have lost eight of nine home games since May 22. Since April 20, the Flying Squirrels are 5-21 at home, including eight straight losses from April 20-May 4. On the year, the Flying Squirrels are batting .215 at home, lowest in the league, compared to .236 on the road (5th).

HITS FOR HOUCHINS: Over his last 17 games since May 29, Zach Houchins has hit .365 (23-for-63) with six homers, five doubles and 18 RBIs. He has collected multiple hits in nine of those 17 games. On Monday, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 (11-for-26) with four homers, two doubles, three walks, 12 RBIs and eight runs scored over seven games from June 3-9, with multiple hits in five of those games. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

BRUSA BOMB: After hitting .400 (6-for-15) with four doubles over a four-game stretch from June 4-7, **Gio Brusa** went 0-for-15 over his next five games from June 8-13. He snapped the hitless slide with a solo home run on Friday night in the second inning. The homer was the fourth of the year for Brusa with the Flying Squirrels and his first batting right handed.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 66 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 23 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. **C.J. McElroy** is 6-for-7 in steal attempts and third on the team in stolen bases. In 11 games on the last road trip, the Flying Squirrels stole 21 bases. Over the last nine games, the team has combined for 17 steals. Last Saturday, Fargas stole four bases, second-most in a game in team history, and the team set a season high with five steals.

EXTRA! EXTRA!: The Flying Squirrels have played four extra-inning games over their last eight games since June 6. They have gone 2-2 in those games and 3-7 in extra-inning games overall this season. Richmond's 10 extra-inning games on the year is tied with Reading for the most in the league.

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 33 homers on the road (T-1st in EL) in 31 games (1.07 per game - 1st in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit 12 home runs at home this season through 33 games (0.36 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game).

HOLD ON: In losing 13 of their last 19 games, the Flying Squirrels have held a lead at some point in all but three of those games, including four-run leads in two of the losses. On the year, the Flying Squirrels are 16-19 when scoring first. The Flying Squirrels have lost three games this year when leading after eight innings, tied with New Hampshire for the most in the league, and have lost seven games when tied after eight innings, most in the league.

EAST FEAST: From May 28-June 23, the Flying Squirrels play 23 of 26 games against teams from the Eastern Division, with the only exclusion being the three-game series with Harrisburg from June 11-13. The Flying Squirrels are 5-10 against the East in that cross-divisional span. Richmond is 11-22 against the opposite division this year.

THERE'S ALWAYS NEXT YEAR HALF: With a June 4 loss to the Sea Dogs, the Flying Squirrels were mathematically eliminated from playoff contention for the Eastern League's first half. However, the second half of the 2019 season begins on Wednesday, June 19, and the records will reset for all teams. This year is the league's first season using a split-season format, and the post-season participants are clinched with the divisional champions of the first and second halves of the season. Prior to this year, the Eastern League was the only full-season league below Triple-A not adopting the split-season format, and playoff teams were decided by each division's champion and one runner-up wild-card team from each division.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Five players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).
