SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped their fourth straight game with a 2-1 loss to the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, who completed a three-game sweep. Nash Knight hit a solo homer for New Hampshire's first run in the top of the fifth inning. The Flying Squirrels tied the score in the bottom of the seventh with an RBI single. In the top of the ninth, Forrest Wall broke the tie with a go-ahead RBI double. New Hampshire starter Yennsy Diaz allowed one unearned run over his 8.0 innings. Bryan Baker closed out the save for the Fisher Cats. Alfred Gutierrez allowed one run over 5.0 innings and struck out seven.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a three-game series at ARM & HAMMER Park against the Trenton Thunder, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is also the first of a six-game road trip to Trenton and Binghamton. The two teams met for a three-game series in Richmond from May 6-8, a three-game sweep by the Thunder. On the year, the Thunder have outscored the Flying Squirrels, 21-5. This series is the only visit to Trenton this season for the Flying Squirrels and the final series between these two teams.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost seven of the last eight since June 8 in New Hampshire after winning four of the previous five games from June 3-7. Over the last eight games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .158 (40-for-253) and have scored 19 runs. Since May 2, the Flying Squirrels have gone 12-31. The Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .225 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.84 team ERA, which is 10th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost ten of the last 13 series, with the exceptions being two four-game splits against Akron and winning two of three at Portland this week. Richmond's -69 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -40). Richmond is 0-27 when trailing through five innings, the only team in the league without at least one win in such games, and 0-31 when trailing through seven innings.

THE THUNDER can clinch the Eastern League Eastern Division first-half title with a win tonight or losses by both Reading and Hartford. Trenton has six of the last ten games, including dropping two of three over the weekend against Bowie. Trenton is ranked fourth in the league with a .241 team batting average and tied for seventh with a 3.57 ERA. Trenton's roster includes six of MLB.com's Top-30 prospects, including Albert Abreu (3), Deivi Garcia (4), Trevor Stephan (8), Nick Nelson (11), Garrett Whitlock (16) and Domingo Acevedo (22).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Garrett Williams** takes the mound for his 13th start of the season for the Flying Squirrels. In his last outing, Williams allowed one hit over 5.0 scoreless innings against Harrisburg on Wednesday. He has not allowed a run in his last two starts (11.0 IP) despite issuing four walks each time out. Over his previous four starts from May 17-June 1, Williams went 0-4 with a 6.75 ERA (12 ER/16 IP). He made 14 starts for Richmond last season and went 2-6 with a 6.00 ERA before moving to the bullpen when the calendar turned to July. As a reliever, he posted a 5.96 ERA in 18 appearances. Williams is ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 21 Giants prospect and No. 20 by MLB.com. **For more on Williams, see page two.**

FOR TRENTON: Right-hander Deivi Garcia makes his eighth start of the season for the Thunder. Last time out, he matched a season high with four runs allowed over 5.2 innings at Binghamton last Tuesday. Over his previous three starts from May 20-June 5, Garcia went 1-0 with a 1.65 ERA (3 ER/16.1 IP). He began the season with A-Adv. Tampa and went 0-2 with a 3.06 ERA in four starts. Garcia is ranked by MLB.com as the Yankees' No. 4 prospect.

HITS FOR HOUCHINS: Over his last 19 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .352 (25-for-71) with six homers, five doubles and 18 RBIs. He has collected multiple hits in 10 of those 19 games. On June 10, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 (11-for-26) with four homers, two doubles, three walks, 12 RBIs and eight runs scored over seven games from June 3-9, with multiple hits in five of those games. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 66 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 23 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. **C.J. McElroy** is 6-for-7 in steal attempts and third on the team in stolen bases. Over the last 11 games, the team has combined for 17 steals.

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 33 homers on the road (T-1st in EL) in 31 games (1.07 per game - 1st in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game).

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit 13 home runs at home this season through 35 games (0.37 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game). Richmond has one homer in each of the last three home games.

HOLD ON: In losing 15 of their last 21 games, the Flying Squirrels have held a lead at some point in all but five of those games, including four-run leads in two of the losses. On the year, the Flying Squirrels are 16-19 when scoring first. The Flying Squirrels have lost three games this year when leading after eight innings, tied with New Hampshire for the most in the league, and have lost eight games when tied after eight innings, most in the league.

EAST FEAST: From May 28-June 23, the Flying Squirrels play 23 of 26 games against teams from the Eastern Division, with the only exclusion being the three-game series with Harrisburg from June 11-13. The Flying Squirrels are 5-11 against the East in that cross-divisional span. Richmond is 11-23 against the opposite division this year.

THERE'S ALWAYS NEXT YEAR HALF: With a June 4 loss to the Sea Dogs, the Flying Squirrels were mathematically eliminated from playoff contention for the Eastern League's first half. However, the second half of the 2019 season begins on Wednesday, June 19, and the records will reset for all teams. This year is the league's first season using a split-season format, and the postseason participants are clinched with the divisional champions of the first and second halves of the season. Prior to this year, the Eastern League was the only full-season league below Triple-A not adopting the split-season format, and playoff teams were decided by each division's champion and one runner-up wild-card team from each division.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Five players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).
