YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped their fifth straight game with a 6-0 shutout loss to the Trenton Thunder. Trenton starter Deivi Garcia struck out 15 batters over 6.0 scoreless innings, setting a new record for the most strikeouts by a pitcher against the Flying Squirrels in franchise history and tying Trenton's single-game record. It was the most strikeouts by an Eastern League pitcher since 2013 (Reading's Jesse Biddle had 16 on 4/22/13). The 19 total strikeouts by the Flying Squirrels were a franchise record for a nine-inning game and tied for the most by an Eastern League team as far back as stats are available (2005). **Gio Brusa** had the only two hits for Richmond. The Thunder scored three runs in the third and added two in the fourth to open a 5-0 lead. Chris Gittens capped the scoring with an RBI double in the seventh. The win clinched the Eastern League Eastern Division's first-half crown for the Thunder, joining the Senators as the two postseason teams from this year's first half. Both teams clinched their spots against the Flying Squirrels.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series at ARM & HAMMER Park against the Trenton Thunder, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is also the second of a six-game road trip to Trenton (0-1) and Binghamton. The two teams met for a three-game series in Richmond from May 6-8, a three-game sweep by the Thunder. On the year, the Thunder have outscored the Flying Squirrels, 27-5. This series is the only visit to Trenton this season for the Flying Squirrels and the final series between these two teams. Today also marks the first day of the Eastern League's second half. A loss today would tie the longest losing streak of the season for the Flying Squirrels (Six games from April 20-26).

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost eight of the last nine since June 8 in New Hampshire after winning four of the previous five games from June 3-7. Over the last nine games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .148 (42-for-283) and have scored 19 runs. Since May 2, the Flying Squirrels have gone 12-32. The Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .223 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.87 team ERA, which is tied for 10th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost ten of the last 13 series, with the exceptions being two four-game splits against Akron and winning two of three at Portland. Richmond's -75 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -29). Richmond is 0-28 when trailing through five innings, the only team in the league without at least one win in such games, and 0-32 when trailing through seven innings.

THE THUNDER clinched the EL East's first-half crown with Tuesday's win over the Flying Squirrels. Trenton is ranked tied for third in the league with a .242 team batting average and sixth with a 3.51 ERA. Trenton's roster includes six of MLB.com's Top-30 prospects, including Albert Abreu (3), Deivi Garcia (4), Trevor Stephan (8), Nick Nelson (11), Garrett Whitlock (16) and Domingo Acevedo (22).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Brandon Lawson** makes his 11th start with the Flying Squirrels and his second against Trenton. Last time out, he pitched 7.0 scoreless innings and allowed four hits in a no-decision against the Senators on Thursday. It was the third time in his career he has pitched 7.0 scoreless innings (May 23 and Aug. 31, 2018). Lawson faced the Thunder on May 7 and allowed three runs over 5.0 innings, scattering a season-high nine hits. He has worked at least 5.0 innings in seven of his last eight starts. In that span, he has gone 2-2 with a 3.70 ERA (17 ER/41.1 IP). For the season, Lawson has the second-lowest swinging strike percentage (6.0%) and fifth-lowest strikeout percentage (12.3%) of all pitchers in the Eastern League with at least 40 innings pitched. Lawson was signed as a minor-league free agent by the Giants on April 23 after being released by the Tampa Bay Rays near the end of spring training. He was originally drafted by the Rays in the 12th round in 2016 out of the University of South Florida and reached Double-A for 14 outings (five starts) last season with the Montgomery Biscuits. **For more on Lawson, see page two.**

FOR TRENTON: Right-hander Nick Nelson makes his fifth start of the season for the Thunder and his sixth overall this season. In his most recent start, Nelson pitched 5.0 scoreless innings at Binghamton on Thursday and picked up a win. He began the season with Trenton and made two starts before being placed on the IL on April 19. He was activated and assigned to A-Adv. Tampa, where he made one start and returned to Trenton's roster on June 7. Nelson was drafted by the Yankees in the fourth round in 2016 and is currently ranked by MLB.com as their No. 11 prospect.

THERE'S ALWAYS NEXT YEAR HALF: The Flying Squirrels finished the Eastern League's first half with a 23-44 record, worst in the league. Beginning today, records across the league reset and the second half of the league's first-ever split season begins. This year is the league's first season using a split-season format, and the postseason participants are clinched with the divisional champions of the first and second halves of the season. Prior to this year, the Eastern League was the only full-season league below Triple-A not adopting the split-season format, and playoff teams were decided by each division's champion and one runner-up wild-card team from each division. Harrisburg and Trenton clinched the league's first-half titles.

BELOW SEA LEVEL: The Flying Squirrels' overall record currently sits 21 games under .500, tied for the second-lowest in team history. The team has gone 22 games under .500 three times, all during the 2016 season (June 27, July 23 and August 10) and has never been 23 games under. The current record is the worst in team history through 67 games.

K: On Tuesday, the Flying Squirrels set the franchise record for the most strikeouts in a nine-inning game with 19. It also matched the most strikeouts by a team's offense in a single game in the Eastern League since 2005, as far back as the data is available (BIN vs. NH on 7/24/06 and POR @ ERI on 6/24/07). Trenton starting pitcher Deivi Garcia had 15 strikeouts, which surpassed the most ever by an opposing pitcher against the Flying Squirrels (14 by Harrisburg's Brad Peacock on 5/13/11 at The Diamond). It was also the most by an EL pitcher since Reading's Jesse Biddle had 16 on 4/22/2013.

HITS FOR HOUCHEINS: Over his last 20 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .338 (25-for-74) with six homers, five doubles and 18 RBIs, but is 0-for-6 in his last two games. He has collected multiple hits in 10 of those 20 games. On June 10, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 (11-for-26) with four homers, two doubles, three walks, 12 RBIs and eight runs scored over seven games from June 3-9, with multiple hits in five of those games. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

BRUSA BREAKING OUT: Over the last four games, **Gio Brusa** has hit .385 (5-for-13) with two doubles, a homer and two RBIs. On Tuesday, he had the Flying Squirrels' only two hits. Before this stretch, Brusa went 0-for-15 in his previous five games from June 8-13.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 67 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 24 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. Over the last 11 games, the team has combined for 17 steals. The Flying Squirrels have stolen 24 bases in 17 games in the month of June.

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 33 homers on the road (T-2nd in EL) in 32 games (1.03 per game - 1st in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game). The Flying Squirrels have hit 13 home runs at home this season through 35 games (0.37 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games).

HOLD ON: In losing 16 of their last 22 games, the Flying Squirrels have held a lead at some point in all but six of those games, including four-run leads in two of the losses. On the year, the Flying Squirrels are 16-19 when scoring first. The Flying Squirrels have lost three games this year when leading after eight innings, tied with New Hampshire for the most in the league, and have lost eight games when tied after eight innings, most in the league.

EAST FEAST: From May 28-June 23, the Flying Squirrels play 23 of 26 games against teams from the Eastern Division, with the only exclusion being the three-game series with Harrisburg from June 11-13. The Flying Squirrels are 5-12 against the East in that cross-divisional span. Richmond is 11-24 against the opposite division this year.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Five players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28).
