**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels dropped their sixth straight game with a 4-2 loss to the Trenton Thunder. **Jalen Miller** brought in a run in the first inning with a groundout to give Richmond a 1-0 lead. In the fifth, Ben Ruta, Mandy Alvarez and Brandon Wagner strung together two-out hits to bring in three runs and put the Thunder ahead, 3-1. Ruta grounded into a double play in the seventh to extend the lead to 4-1. **Gio Brusa** doubled home a run in the eighth to close within two runs. In the ninth, the Flying Squirrels put runners at second and third, but Will Carter picked up a strikeout to end the game. Richmond starter **Brandon Lawson** worked 6.0 innings and allowed three runs.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a three-game series at ARM & HAMMER Park against the Trenton Thunder, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is also the third of a six-game road trip to Trenton (0-2) and Binghamton. The two teams met for a three-game series in Richmond from May 6-8, a three-game sweep by the Thunder. On the year, the Thunder have outscored the Flying Squirrels, 31-7. This series is the only visit to Trenton this season for the Flying Squirrels and the final series between these two teams. Richmond's current six-game losing streak is tied for the longest this year (last - April 20-26). The Flying Squirrels' current five-game losing streak to Trenton is tied for its longest in team history against the Thunder (last - April 11-May 3, 2013).

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost nine of the last 10 since June 8 in New Hampshire after winning four of the previous five games from June 3-7. Over the last 10 games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .157 (50-for-318) and have scored 21 runs. Since May 2, the Flying Squirrels have gone 12-33. The Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .223 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.86 team ERA, which is tied for 11th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost 11 of the last 14 series, with the exceptions being two four-game splits against Akron and winning two of three at Portland. Richmond's -77 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -30). Richmond is 0-29 when trailing through five innings, the only team in the league without at least one win in such games, and 0-33 when trailing through seven innings.

**THE THUNDER** clinched the EL East's first-half crown with Tuesday's win over the Flying Squirrels. Trenton is ranked tied for second in the league with a .243 team batting average and sixth with a 3.49 ERA. Trenton's roster includes six of MLB.com's Top-30 prospects, including Albert Abreu (3), Deivi Garcia (4), Trevor Stephan (8), Nick Nelson (11), Garrett Whitlock (16) and Domingo Acevedo (22).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Caleb Baragar** makes his eighth start and ninth overall appearance for the Flying Squirrels this season. Last time out, Baragar allowed one run on three hits over 5.0 innings in a no-decision against New Hampshire on Friday. Over his last six starts, Baragar has gone 2-0 with a 2.10 ERA (8 ER/34.1 IP). Prior to joining Richmond, Baragar made one start with Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. He began the season with A-Adv. San Jose and went 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA in four starts and one relief outing. Baragar was drafted by the Giants in the ninth round in 2016 out of Indiana University and is in his fourth professional season. **For more on Baragar, see page two.**

**FOR TRENTON:** Right-hander Nick Nelson makes his fifth start of the season for the Thunder and his sixth overall this season. In his most recent start, Nelson pitched 5.0 scoreless innings at Binghamton on Thursday and picked up a win. He began the season with Trenton and made two starts before being placed on the IL on April 19. He was activated and assigned to A-Adv. Tampa, where he made one start and returned to Trenton's roster on June 7. Nelson was drafted by the Yankees in the fourth round in 2016 and is currently ranked by MLB.com as their No. 11 prospect.

**THERE'S ALWAYS NEXT YEAR HALF:** The Flying Squirrels finished the Eastern League's first half with a 23-44 record, worst in the league. Beginning yesterday, records across the league reset and the second half of the league's first-ever split season began. This year is the league's first season using a split-season format, and the postseason participants are clinched with the divisional champions of the first and second halves of the season. Prior to this year, the Eastern League was the only full-season league below Triple-A not adopting the split-season format, and playoff teams were decided by each division's champion and one runner-up wild-card team from each division. Harrisburg and Trenton clinched the league's first-half titles.

**BELOW SEA LEVEL:** The Flying Squirrels' overall record currently sits 22 games under .500, tied for the lowest in team history. The team has gone 22 games under .500 three previous times, all during the 2016 season (June 27, July 23 and August 10) and has never been 23 games under. The current record is the worst in team history through 68 games.

**HITS FOR HOUCHINS:** Over his last 21 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .329 (26-for-79) with six homers, five doubles and 18 RBIs, but is 1-for-11 in his last four games. He has collected multiple hits in 10 of those 21 games. On June 10, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 (11-for-26) with four homers, two doubles, three walks, 12 RBIs and eight runs scored over seven games from June 3-9, with multiple hits in five of those games. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

**BRUSA BREAKING OUT:** Over the last five games, **Gio Brusa** has hit .375 (6-for-16) with three doubles, a homer and three RBIs. On Tuesday, he had the Flying Squirrels' only two hits. Before this stretch, Brusa went 0-for-15 in his previous five games from June 8-13.

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 70 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 27 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. Over the last 12 games, the team has combined for 20 steals. The Flying Squirrels have stolen 27 bases in 18 games in the month of June. Fargas has 14 steals in his 18 games this month.

**FREQUENT FLYERS:** In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 33 homers on the road (T-2nd in EL) in 33 games (1.00 per game - 1st in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game). The Flying Squirrels have hit 13 home runs at home this season through 35 games (0.37 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games).

**HOLD ON:** In losing 17 of their last 23 games, the Flying Squirrels have held a lead at some point in all but six of those games, including four-run leads in two of the losses. On the year, the Flying Squirrels are 16-20 when scoring first. The Flying Squirrels have lost three games this year when leading after eight innings, tied with New Hampshire for the most in the league, and have lost eight games when tied after eight innings, most in the league.

**EAST FEAST:** From May 28-June 23, the Flying Squirrels play 23 of 26 games against teams from the Eastern Division, with the only exclusion being the three-game series with Harrisburg from June 11-13. The Flying Squirrels are 5-13 against the East in that cross-divisional span. Richmond is 11-25 against the opposite division this year.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).
