YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped a six-game losing streak with a 4-3 win over the Trenton Thunder at ARM & HAMMER Park. **Jacob Heyward** drove in the go-ahead run with a single in the eighth inning. Richmond starter **Caleb Baragar** set a new season high with eight strikeouts, allowing two runs over 5.1 innings on two hits, including a two-run homer by Wendell Rijo in the fourth. In the sixth, **Jonah Arenado** got the Flying Squirrels on the board with an RBI single and **Gio Brusa** gave Richmond a 3-2 lead with a two-run homer. Trenton tied the score in the bottom of the sixth on a passed ball. **Melvin Adon** picked up his eighth save with a 1-2-3 ninth inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a three-game series at NYSEG Stadium against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. It is also the fourth of a six-game road trip to Trenton (1-2) and Binghamton. This series is Richmond's only trip to Binghamton this year and the final set between the two teams on the season. The Rumble Ponies swept the Flying Squirrels in a three-game set at The Diamond from May 28-30. Binghamton has outscored Richmond, 20-10, on the year. This season, Richmond is 8-15 in games following a win and have strung together groups of consecutive wins five times.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost nine of the last 11 since June 8 in New Hampshire after winning four of the previous five games from June 3-7. Over the last 11 games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .153 (53-for-346) and have scored 25 runs. Since May 2, the Flying Squirrels have gone 13-33. The Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .221 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.83 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost 11 of the last 14 series, with the exceptions being two four-game splits against Akron and winning two of three at Portland. Richmond's -76 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -30).

THE RUMBLE PONIES are the only team in the Eastern Division that has not yet lost a second-half game. After losing four straight games from June 12-15, the Rumble Ponies swept a three-game series from Tuesday through Thursday at New Hampshire. Binghamton leads the Eastern League in hitting with a .248 batting average on the season but sits last in the league with 38 homers. The Rumble Ponies have a 3.79 team ERA, which is 10th in the league. Binghamton's roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 prospects, including Andres Gimenez (1), David Peterson (6), Will Toffey (15), Ryder Ryan (21), Stephen Villines (22), Patrick Mazeika (25), Ali Sanchez (26), Quinn Brodey (27) and Luis Carpio (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Brandon Beachy** makes his sixth start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his seventh overall appearance. Last time out, Beachy allowed a season-high six runs, but set a new season high with eight strikeouts. Four of the runs scored in the third inning, and he closed the outing with two scoreless frames. Beachy made his MLB debut with the Atlanta Braves in 2010 and spent three seasons in the Majors with them, totaling 46 starts with a 14-11 record and 3.23 ERA. His best season came in 2012, when he went 5-5 with a 2.00 ERA over 13 starts, posting the best ERA in the majors until his season ended with an elbow injury, requiring Tommy John surgery. He returned in 2013 but had to undergo Tommy John surgery again prior to the 2014 season. Beachy signed with the Dodgers in 2015 and briefly returned to the majors that year. He was held to one appearance in 2016 and did not pitch at all in 2017. Last year, he made 12 appearances for the independent New Britain Bees, going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA in 12 appearances (two starts). **For more on Beachy, see page two.**

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Harol Gonzalez makes his 11th start of the season for the Rumble Ponies and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He pitched at The Diamond on May 28 and allowed one unearned run over 7.0 innings, his longest start of the season. Last time out, he matched a season high with nine strikeouts over 6.0 innings and allowed three runs in a loss against Altoona last Friday. Gonzalez made nine starts for Binghamton last season and went 0-9 with a 7.79 ERA.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 10 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 1.78 ERA (7 ER/35.1 IP). On the season, Richmond's 4.04 bullpen ERA is the highest in the league. Since May 5, **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19.0 IP). In his last 12 outings since May 19, **Melvin Adon** has posted a 0.55 ERA (4 ER/15.0 IP) with eight walks and 22 strikeouts, and he has gone 5-for-6 in save attempts. **Chase Johnson** has not allowed an earned run in his last five appearances since May 31, pitching 9.1 innings. **Tyler Cyr** has worked four straight scoreless appearances since June 5, totaling 7.2 innings.

STARTING OFF: The Richmond starting rotation has a 3.72 ERA this season, which is tied for fourth in the league. **Caleb Baragar** is 2-0 with a 2.27 ERA (10 ER/39.2 IP) over his last seven starts since May 19. **Brandon Lawson** has gone 1-2 with a 3.18 ERA (10 ER/28.1 IP) in his last five starts since May 28. **Garrett Williams** is 0-1 with a 2.40 ERA (4 ER/15.0 IP) in his last three starts dating back to June 6. **Alfred Gutierrez** is 3-1 with a 3.46 ERA (10 ER/26.0 IP) in his last five starts since May 26.

OFFENSIVE OUTAGE: Since June 9 in 10 games, the Richmond offense has combined to hit .148 (46-for-311) and scored 21 runs (2.1 runs per game). The Flying Squirrels have been held to three or less hits in five of the last 10 games. Richmond .221 average on the season is the lowest in the league and would be the lowest in franchise history, trailing last year's .240 team average. The Eastern League has combined for a .236 batting average this year, which is the lowest of all full-season leagues in the minors. The league's average has dropped from last year's .253 average, which was the lowest since the Flying Squirrels joined the circuit in 2010.

BRUSA BREAKING OUT: Over the last six games, **Gio Brusa** has hit .368 (7-for-19) with two homers, three doubles and five RBIs. On Tuesday, he had the Flying Squirrels' only two hits. Before this stretch, Brusa went 0-for-15 in his previous five games from June 8-13.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 72 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 29 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. Over the last 13 games, the team has combined for 22 steals. The Flying Squirrels have stolen 29 bases in 19 games in the month of June. Fargas has 16 steals in his 19 games this month.

HITS FOR HOUCHINS: Over his last 22 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .317 (26-for-82) with six homers, five doubles and 18 RBIs, but is 1-for-14 in his last five games. On June 10, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 with four homers and 12 RBIs from June 3-9. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

FREQUENT FLYERS: In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 34 homers on the road (T-2nd in EL) in 34 games (1.00 per game - T-1st in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game). The Flying Squirrels have hit 13 home runs at home this season through 35 games (0.37 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games).

HOLD ON: In losing 17 of their last 24 games, the Flying Squirrels have held a lead at some point in all but six of those games, including four-run leads in two of the losses. On the year, the Flying Squirrels are 16-20 when scoring first. The Flying Squirrels have lost three games this year when leading after eight innings, tied with New Hampshire for the most in the league, and have lost eight games when tied after eight innings, most in the league.

EAST FEAST: From May 28-June 23, the Flying Squirrels play 23 of 26 games against teams from the Eastern Division, with the only exclusion being the three-game series with Harrisburg from June 11-13. The Flying Squirrels are 6-13 against the East in that cross-divisional span. Richmond is 12-25 against the opposite division this year.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).

- Attended Northwestern High School in Kokomo, Ind.
- Attended Indiana Wesleyan University, where he was a third baseman and a closer
- Originally signed by the Braves as a non-drafted free agent in 2008
- Made MLB debut with Atlanta on Sept. 20, 2010
- In 2011, led Braves staff and ranked second among MLB rookies with 169 strikeouts, the most by a Braves rookie in modern-era franchise history at the time and 10.74 K/9 IP was fourth all-time among rookie starting pitchers (min. 25 starts) in MLB history behind Kerry Wood (1998), Dwight Gooden (1984) and Hideo Nomo (1995)
- Made 13 MLB starts in 2012 and went 5-5 with a 2.00 ERA (T-1st in MLB at time) and .171 BAA (1st in MLB) before being placed on DL on 6/16, undergoing Tommy John surgery on 6/21
- Had second Tommy John surgery in March 2014
- Signed with Dodgers for 2015 and made two MLB starts
- Limited to one appearance in AZL in 2016 with elbow injury
- Made only 25 total appearances from 2014-2017
