**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels picked up their third straight win with a 4-2 victory over the Binghamton Rumble Ponies. **Gio Brusa** hit a two-run homer in the top of the first inning, his third home run in the last three days. In the sixth, Brusa doubled home a run and later scored on an RBI single by **Will Maddox** to open a 4-0 lead. Binghamton scored its only two runs on a homer by Patrick Mazeika in the bottom of the sixth. Richmond starter **Alfred Gutierrez** did not allow a run through his first five innings prior to the homer in the sixth, and he matched his season high with seven strikeouts over 5.1 innings and picked up his fourth win. Relievers **Frank Rubio**, **Sam Moll**, **Dillon McNamara**, **Carlos Navas** and **Melvin Adon** combined for 3.2 scoreless innings. Binghamton left 11 runners on base and went 0-for-8 with runners in scoring position.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a three-game series at NYSEG Stadium against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. It is also the last of a six-game road trip to Trenton (1-2) and Binghamton (2-0). This series is Richmond's only trip to Binghamton this year and the final set between the two teams on the season. The Rumble Ponies swept the Flying Squirrels in a three-game set at The Diamond from May 28-30. Binghamton has outscored Richmond, 22-18, on the year. This season, Richmond is 10-15 in games following a win and have strung together groups of consecutive wins six times. Richmond is looking to sweep a series for the first time this season. The Flying Squirrels have never swept a series in Binghamton. The last Richmond sweep against Binghamton was a four-game series from August 29-September 1, 2014 at The Diamond.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won three straight games, tied for the longest winning streak of the year, after losing six straight from June 13-19 and nine of 10 from June 8-19. During the current winning streak, the Flying Squirrels have hit .220 (22-for-100), scoring four runs in each game, and the pitching staff has combined for a 1.67 ERA (5 ER/27.0 IP). Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .223 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.77 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. The Flying Squirrels have lost 11 of the last 15 series, with the exceptions being two four-game splits against Akron, winning two of three at Portland and winning the current series at Binghamton. Richmond's -71 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -36). The Flying Squirrels' current three-game winning streak is tied for the longest of the season (three previous times, last - June 5-7).

**THE RUMBLE PONIES** saw their three-game winning streak snapped on Friday. After losing four straight games from June 12-15, the Rumble Ponies swept a three-game series from Tuesday through Thursday at New Hampshire. The Rumble Ponies have lost six straight home games since June 12 and 10 of 11 at home since May 27. Binghamton leads the Eastern League in hitting with a .247 batting average on the season but sits last in the league with 39 homers. The Rumble Ponies have a 3.76 team ERA, which is 10th in the league. Binghamton's roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 prospects, including **Andres Gimenez** (1), **David Peterson** (6), **Will Toffey** (15), **Ryder Ryan** (21), **Stephen Villines** (22), **Patrick Mazeika** (25), **Ali Sanchez** (26), **Quinn Brodey** (27) and **Luis Carpio** (28).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Garrett Williams** takes the mound for his 14th start of the season for the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he worked 4.0 innings at Trenton on Tuesday and allowed five runs, picking up a loss in his fifth straight decision. Over his last four starts since June 1, Williams has gone 0-2 with a 2.66 ERA (6 ER/20.1 IP), including back-to-back scoreless outings on June 6 at Portland and June 12 against Harrisburg. He made 14 starts for Richmond last season and went 2-6 with a 6.00 ERA before moving to the bullpen when the calendar turned to July. As a reliever, he posted a 5.96 ERA in 18 appearances. Williams is ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 21 Giants prospect and No. 20 by MLB.com. **For more on Williams, see page two.**

**FOR BINGHAMTON:** Left-hander **David Peterson** makes his 13th start of the season for the Rumble Ponies and his second against the Flying Squirrels. In his most recent start, Peterson set a new season high in innings pitched (7.0) and tied a season high in hits allowed (9), but surrendered two runs with no walks and six strikeouts in a win at New Hampshire on Tuesday. He last faced the Flying Squirrels on May 29 at The Diamond and allowed four runs over 4.2 innings in a no-decision. Peterson was drafted in the first round (20th overall) by the Mets in 2017 out of the University of Oregon and is ranked by MLB.com as the Mets' No. 6 prospect.

**A LITTLE RELIEF:** Over the last 12 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 1.50 ERA (7 ER/42.0 IP). On the season, Richmond's 3.94 bullpen ERA is the highest in the league. Since May 5, **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19.0 IP). In his last 13 outings since May 19, **Melvin Adon** has posted a 0.52 ERA (1 ER/17.1 IP) with eight walks and 24 strikeouts, and he has gone 6-for-7 in save attempts. **Chase Johnson** has not allowed an earned run in his last five appearances since May 31, pitching 9.1 innings. **Tyler Cyr** has worked five straight scoreless appearances since June 5, totaling 8.2 innings.

**STARTING OFF:** The Richmond starting rotation has a 3.68 ERA this season, which is fourth in the league. **Caleb Baragar** is 2-0 with a 2.27 ERA (10 ER/39.2 IP) over his last seven starts since May 19. **Brandon Lawson** has gone 1-2 with a 3.18 ERA (10 ER/28.1 IP) in his last five starts since May 28. **Garrett Williams** is 0-1 with a 2.40 ERA (4 ER/15.0 IP) in his last three starts dating back to June 6. **Alfred Gutierrez** is 4-1 with a 3.45 ERA (12 ER/31.1 IP) in his last six starts since May 26.

**OFFENSIVE OUTAGE:** Since June 9 in 12 games, the Richmond offense has combined to hit .170 (65-for-383) and scored 29 runs (2.4 runs per game). The Flying Squirrels have been held to three or less hits in five of the last 12 games. Richmond's .223 average on the season is the lowest in the league and would be the lowest in franchise history, trailing last year's .240 team average. The Eastern League has combined for a .236 batting average this year, which is the lowest of all full-season leagues in the minors. The league's average has dropped from last year's .253 average, which was the lowest since the Flying Squirrels joined the circuit in 2010.

**BRUSA BREAKING OUT:** Over the last eight games since June 14, **Gio Brusa** has hit .370 (10-for-27) with four homers, four doubles and nine RBIs. On Tuesday, he had the Flying Squirrels' only two hits. He has homered in each of his last three games and four of his last eight. Before this stretch, Brusa went 0-for-15 in his previous five games from June 8-13. Brusa is now tied for first on the team with seven home runs this season. His current eight-game hitting streak is the longest on the team this year.

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 75 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 31 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. Over the last 15 games, the team has combined for 25 steals. The Flying Squirrels have stolen 32 bases in 21 games in the month of June. Fargas has 17 steals in his 21 games this month, and his season total of 31 is the fourth-most in a single season in franchise history.

**HITS FOR HOUCHEINS:** Over his last 24 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .330 (30-for-91) with six homers, six doubles and 18 RBIs. He went 1-for-14 over four games from June 16-20, but has gone 4-for-9 in his last two games. On June 10, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 with four homers and 12 RBIs from June 3-9. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

**FREQUENT FLYERS:** In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 36 homers on the road (2nd in EL) in 36 games (1.00 per game - 2nd in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game). The Flying Squirrels have hit 13 home runs at home this season through 35 games (0.37 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games).

**EAST FEAST:** From May 28-June 23, the Flying Squirrels play 23 of 26 games against teams from the Eastern Division, with the only exclusion being the three-game series with Harrisburg from June 11-13. The Flying Squirrels are 6-13 against the East in that cross-divisional span. Richmond is 12-25 against the opposite division this year.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Webb** (5), **Quinn** (13), **Adon** (15), **Williams** (20) and **Miller** (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).
