**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels picked up their fourth straight win with a 4-3 victory in Binghamton over the Rumble Ponies. **Jonah Arenado** hit a triple in the fourth inning to give Richmond a 1-0 lead. **Jalen Miller** hit a solo homer in the sixth. In the bottom of the sixth, **Barrett Barnes** hit brought in a run to close the gap to one and the Rumble Ponies tied the score in the seventh with a single by **Luis Carpio**. **Gio Brusa** put Richmond back ahead with an RBI single in the eighth and **Arenado** added a sac fly to pull ahead, 4-2. **Ali Sanchez** scored on a wild pitch in the eighth, but the Flying Squirrels held Binghamton off the board the rest of the way. Richmond starter **Garrett Williams** worked 5.0 scoreless innings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a three-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. It is also the first of a seven-game homestand against Altoona and Hartford. Binghamton has outscored Richmond, 22-18, on the year. This season, Richmond is 11-15 in games following a win and have strung together groups of consecutive wins six times.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won four straight games, their longest winning streak of the year, after losing six straight from June 13-19 and nine of 10 from June 8-19. During the current winning streak, the Flying Squirrels have hit .206 (27-for-131), scoring four runs in each game, and the pitching staff has combined for a 2.00 ERA (8 ER/36.0 IP). Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .222 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.76 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. Richmond's -70 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -35).

**THE CURVE** have gone 14-6 in the month of June, but dropped two of three in their last series in Hartford. Altoona's 2.69 ERA this month is the lowest in the league and they're second with a .250 team batting average in June. For the season, Altoona's .242 team batting average is third in the league and the team's 3.68 ERA is ninth in the league. Altoona's roster includes three of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including **Jared Oliva** (9), **Stephen Alemas** (22 - on IL) and **Blake Cederlind** (30). The Curve had three players selected for the upcoming Eastern League All-Star Game: RHP James Marvel, RHP Pedro Vasquez and C Jason Delay.

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Ryan Halstead** makes his first start of the season for the Flying Squirrels. It is the first start of his professional career. Halstead has made 19 appearances for the Flying Squirrels in relief this year. Over his last 12 appearances since May 5, Halstead has gone 1-2 with a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19.0 IP). Halstead went 4-4 with a 2.72 ERA in 32 relief appearances for the Flying Squirrels in 2018. A former closer at Indiana University, Halstead was selected by the Giants in the 21st round of the 2015 MLB Draft.

**FOR ALTOONA:** Left-hander **Brandon Waddell** makes his second start of the season for the Curve. In his last outing, he pitched 4.0 innings and allowed one run on two hits against Harrisburg on Tuesday. He began the season with Triple-A Indianapolis and went 1-2 with an 8.70 ERA in 21 outings. In parts of four seasons with the Curve, Waddell has gone 12-13 with a 3.61 ERA in 47 outings (44 starts). Waddell was drafted in the fifth round in 2015 out of the University of Virginia, where he helped lead the Cavaliers to the 2015 NCAA College World Series national championship.

**SHINING STARTS:** Six members of the Flying Squirrels have been selected to represent Richmond in the Eastern League All-Star Game at The Diamond on Wednesday, July 10: RHP **Melvin Adon**, LHP **Caleb Baragar**, 3B **Jonah Arenado**, 1B **Zach Houchins**, 2B **Jalen Miller** and OF **Jacob Heyward**. Six All-Stars ties the most in franchise history and is the most of any team in the Eastern League this season. Richmond's coaching staff, led by manager **Willie Harris**, will be the staff for the Western Division All-Stars in the Eastern League All-Star Game.

**A LITTLE RELIEF:** Over the last 13 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 1.96 ERA (10 ER/46.0 IP). On the season, Richmond's 3.98 bullpen ERA is the highest in the league. Since May 5, **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19.0 IP). In his last 13 outings since May 19, **Melvin Adon** has posted a 0.52 ERA (1 ER/17.1 IP) with eight walks and 24 strikeouts, and he has gone 6-for-7 in save attempts. **Chase Johnson** has a 0.87 ERA (1 ER/10.1 IP) in his last six appearances since May 31. **Tyler Cyr** has worked five straight scoreless appearances since June 5, totaling 8.2 innings.

**STARTING OFF:** The Richmond starting rotation has a 3.63 ERA this season, which is fourth in the league. **Caleb Baragar** is 2-0 with a 2.27 ERA (10 ER/39.2 IP) over his last seven starts since May 19. **Brandon Lawson** has gone 1-2 with a 3.18 ERA (10 ER/28.1 IP) in his last five starts since May 28. **Garrett Williams** is 0-1 with a 1.80 ERA (4 ER/20.0 IP) in his last three starts dating back to June 6. **Alfred Gutierrez** is 4-1 with a 3.45 ERA (12 ER/31.1 IP) in his last six starts since May 26.

**OFFENSIVE OUTAGE:** Since June 9 in 13 games, the Richmond offense has combined to hit .169 (70-for-414) and scored 33 runs (2.5 runs per game). The Flying Squirrels have been held to three or less hits in five of the last 13 games. Richmond's .222 average on the season is the lowest in the league and would be the lowest in franchise history, trailing last year's .240 team average. The Eastern League has combined for a .236 batting average this year, which is the lowest of all full-season leagues in the minors. The league's average has dropped from last year's .253 average, which was the lowest since the Flying Squirrels joined the circuit in 2010.

**BRUSA BREAKING OUT:** Over the last nine games since June 14, **Gio Brusa** has hit .367 (11-for-30) with four homers, four doubles and 10 RBIs. On Tuesday, he had the Flying Squirrels' only two hits. He homered in three games straight games from Thursday through Saturday and has four homers in his last nine games. Before this stretch, Brusa went 0-for-15 in his previous five games from June 8-13. Brusa is now tied for first on the team with seven home runs this season. His current nine-game hitting streak is the longest on the team this year. Brusa was named Eastern League Player of the Week for June 17-23.

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 75 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 31 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. Over the last 16 games, the team has combined for 25 steals. The Flying Squirrels have stolen 32 bases in 22 games in the month of June. Fargas has 17 steals in his 21 games this month, and his season total of 31 is the fourth-most in a single season in franchise history.

**HITS FOR HOUCHINS:** Over his last 25 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .326 (31-for-95) with six homers, six doubles and 18 RBIs. He went 1-for-14 over four games from June 16-20, but has gone 5-for-13 in his last three games. On June 10, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 with four homers and 12 RBIs from June 3-9. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

**HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T:** The Flying Squirrels have hit 13 home runs at home this season through 35 games (0.37 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game). Richmond has one homer in each of the last three home games.

**FREQUENT FLYERS:** In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 37 homers on the road (T-1st in EL) in 37 games (1.00 per game - 1st in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game). The Flying Squirrels have hit 13 home runs at home this season through 35 games (0.37 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Webb** (5), **Quinn** (13), **Adon** (15), **Williams** (20) and **Miller** (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).
