**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels saw their season-high four-game winning streak snapped with a 5-2 loss to the Altoona Curve. Altoona pulled ahead in the second with a sac fly by Bligh Madris. In the bottom of the inning, Richmond tied the score on a double by Brett Austin and took the lead with an RBI single by Brandon Van Horn. Altoona evened the score at 2-2 in the fifth with a pinch-hit single by Bralin Jackson. In the seventh, the Curve took the lead again with an RBI groundout by Beau Sulser. Mitchell Tolman and Chris Sharpe added RBIs to extend the lead to 5-2. Making his first career start, Ryan Halstead allowed one run over four innings, the longest outing of his professional career.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. It is also the second of a seven-game homestand against Altoona (0-1) and Hartford.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** lost yesterday to snap a four-game winning streak, their longest winning streak of the year, after losing six straight from June 13-19 and nine of 10 from June 8-19. Over the last five games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .211 (35-for-166) and the pitching staff has combined for a 2.20 ERA (11 ER/45.0 IP). Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .221 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.74 team ERA, which is 11th in the circuit. Richmond's -73 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -31).

**THE CURVE** have gone 15-6 in the month of June, but dropped two of three in their last series in Hartford. Altoona's 2.66 ERA this month is the lowest in the league and they're second with a .249 team batting average in June. For the season, Altoona's .242 team batting average is third in the league and the team's 3.66 ERA is tied for eighth in the league. Altoona's roster includes three of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including Jared Oliva (9), Stephen Alemais (22 - on IL) and Blake Cederlind (30). The Curve had three players selected for the upcoming Eastern League All-Star Game: RHP James Marvel, RHP Pedro Vasquez and C Jason Delay.

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Caleb Baragar** makes his ninth start and ninth overall appearance for the Flying Squirrels this season. Last time out, Baragar allowed two earned runs over 5.1 innings in a no-decision at Trenton on Thursday. Over his last seven starts, Baragar has gone 2-0 with a 2.27 ERA (10 ER/39.2 IP). Prior to joining Richmond, Baragar made one start with Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and allowed five runs over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. He began the season with A-Adv. San Jose and went 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA in four starts and one relief outing. Baragar was drafted by the Giants in the ninth round in 2016 out of Indiana University and is in his fourth professional season. *For more on Baragar, see page two.*

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander James Marvel makes his 15th start of the season for the Curve. In his last start, Marvel worked a season-high 7.2 innings and allowed one run with a season-high nine strikeouts in a win against Harrisburg on Wednesday. He has made two starts against Richmond this season, working seven scoreless innings each time (April 20 and April 26), allowing five total hits and five total strikeouts. Marvel was selected by the Pirates in the 36th round in 2015 out of Duke University.

**SHINING STARTS:** Six members of the Flying Squirrels have been selected to represent Richmond in the Eastern League All-Star Game at The Diamond on Wednesday, July 10: RHP **Melvin Adon**, LHP **Caleb Baragar**, 3B **Jonah Arenado**, 1B **Zach Houchins**, 2B **Jalen Miller** and OF **Jacob Heyward**. Six All-Stars ties the most in franchise history and is the most of any team in the Eastern League this season. Richmond's coaching staff, led by manager **Willie Harris**, will be the staff for the Western Division All-Stars in the Eastern League All-Star Game.

**A LITTLE RELIEF:** Over the last 14 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.12 ERA (12 ER/51.0 IP). On the season, Richmond's 3.97 bullpen ERA is the highest in the league. Since May 5, **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.17 ERA (3 ER/23.0 IP). In his last 13 outings since May 19, **Melvin Adon** has posted a 0.52 ERA (1 ER/17.1 IP) with eight walks and 24 strikeouts, and he has gone 6-for-7 in save attempts. **Chase Johnson** has a 0.87 ERA (1 ER/10.1 IP) in his last six appearances since May 31. **Tyler Cyr** has worked six straight scoreless appearances since June 5, totaling 9.2 innings.

**STARTING OFF:** The Richmond starting rotation has a 3.61 ERA this season, which is fourth in the league. **Caleb Baragar** is 2-0 with a 2.27 ERA (10 ER/39.2 IP) over his last seven starts since May 19. **Brandon Lawson** has gone 1-2 with a 3.18 ERA (10 ER/28.1 IP) in his last five starts since May 28. **Garrett Williams** is 0-1 with a 1.80 ERA (4 ER/20.0 IP) in his last three starts dating back to June 6. **Alfred Gutierrez** is 4-1 with a 3.45 ERA (12 ER/31.1 IP) in his last six starts since May 26.

**OFFENSIVE OUTAGE:** Since June 9 in 14 games, the Richmond offense has combined to hit .170 (76-for-446) and scored 35 runs (2.5 runs per game). The Flying Squirrels have been held to three or less hits in five of the last 14 games. Richmond's .221 average on the season is the lowest in the league and would be the lowest in franchise history, trailing last year's .240 team average. The Eastern League has combined for a .236 batting average this year, which is the lowest of all full-season leagues in the minors. The league's average has dropped from last year's .253 average, which was the lowest since the Flying Squirrels joined the circuit in 2010.

**BRUSA BREAKING OUT:** Over the last 10 games since June 14, **Gio Brusa** has hit .324 (11-for-34) with four homers, four doubles and 10 RBIs. On Tuesday, he had the Flying Squirrels' only two hits. He homered in three games straight games from Thursday through Saturday and has four homers in his last ten games. Before this stretch, Brusa went 0-for-15 in his previous five games from June 8-13. Brusa is now tied for first on the team with seven home runs this season. His nine-game hitting streak from June 14-23 was the longest on the team this year. Brusa was named Eastern League Player of the Week for June 17-23.

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 75 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 31 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. Over the last 17 games, the team has combined for 25 steals. The Flying Squirrels have stolen 32 bases in 23 games in the month of June. Fargas has 17 steals in his 22 games this month, and his season total of 31 is the fourth-most in a single season in franchise history.

**HITS FOR HOUCHINS:** Over his last 26 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .230 (32-for-100) with six homers, six doubles and 18 RBIs. He went 1-for-14 over four games from June 16-20, but has gone 6-for-18 in his last four games. On June 10, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 with four homers and 12 RBIs from June 3-9. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

**HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T:** The Flying Squirrels have hit 13 home runs at home this season through 36 games (0.36 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game). Richmond has one homer in each of the last three home games.

**FREQUENT FLYERS:** In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 37 homers on the road (T-1st in EL) in 37 games (1.00 per game - 1st in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game). The Flying Squirrels have hit 13 home runs at home this season through 35 games (0.37 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).
