**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels dropped their second straight game with a 5-1 loss to the Altoona Curve. **Gio Brusa** gave the Flying Squirrels a 1-0 lead in the second inning, his fourth home run in the last six games. Altoona pulled ahead in the fifth with a two-run double by Robbie Glendinning and added two more runs on a single by Bligh Madris. In the eighth, Brett Pope scored on a wild pitch by **Melvin Adon**. Richmond starter **Caleb Baragar** allowed a season-high four earned runs over 4.1 innings, his shortest start with Richmond. Reliever **Chase Johnson** worked 2.2 scoreless inning and struck out four. Altoona starter James Marvel pitched seven innings and allowed one run on four hits with eight strikeouts, improving to 3-0 with a 0.43 ERA in three starts against the Flying Squirrels this season.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. It is also the second of a seven-game homestand against Altoona (0-2) and Hartford. This series marks the Curve's third and final trip to The Diamond this season. The two teams also meet up for two more four-game series in Altoona from July 25-28 and August 5-8. The Flying Squirrels are 15-31 this season in games following a loss and 4-7 on Wednesdays.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have dropped back-to-back games to open the homestand after winning the final four games of the last road trip to Trenton and Binghamton, their longest winning streak of the year. The Flying Squirrels lost nine of the previous 10 games from June 8-19. Over the last six games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .203 (40-for-197) and the pitching staff has combined for a 2.67 ERA (16 ER/54.0 IP). Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .220 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.76 team ERA, which is tied for tenth in the circuit. Richmond's .77 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -31).

**THE CURVE** have gone 16-6 in the month of June and have won two straight games. Altoona's 2.58 ERA this month is the lowest in the league and they're second with a .252 team batting average in June. For the season, Altoona's .243 team batting average is third in the league and the team's 3.62 ERA is tied for eighth in the league. Altoona's roster includes three of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including Jared Oliva (9), Stephen Alemais (22 - on IL) and Blake Cederlind (30). The Curve had three players selected for the upcoming Eastern League All-Star Game: RHP James Marvel, RHP Pedro Vasquez and C Jason Delay.

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Brandon Beachy** makes his seventh start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his eighth overall appearance. Last time out, Beachy allowed one run over 6.0 innings in a win at Binghamton on Friday, his second straight start working 6.0 innings. Beachy made his MLB debut with the Atlanta Braves in 2010 and spent three seasons in the Majors with them, totaling 46 starts with a 14-11 record and 3.23 ERA. His best season came in 2012, when he went 5-5 with a 2.00 ERA over 13 starts, posting the best ERA in the majors until his season ended with an elbow injury, requiring Tommy John surgery. He returned in 2013 but had to undergo Tommy John surgery again prior to the 2014 season. Beachy signed with the Dodgers in 2015 and briefly returned to the majors that year. He was held to one appearance in 2016 and did not pitch at all in 2017. Last year, he made 12 appearances for the independent New Britain Bees, going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA in 12 appearances (two starts). **For more on Beachy, see page two.**

**FOR ALTOONA:** Left-hander Domingo Robles makes his sixth start of the season with Altoona. He began the year with A-Adv. Bradenton and went 5-5 with a 2.61 ERA in 10 starts. He was promoted to Altoona on May 28. Last time out, he pitched 4.0 innings and allowed five runs on seven hits in his shortest start this season. Robles split the 2018 season with Bradenton and Single-A West Virginia, going 9-9 with a 3.33 ERA in 26 starts.

**SHINING STARTS:** Six members of the Flying Squirrels have been selected to represent Richmond in the Eastern League All-Star Game at The Diamond on Wednesday, July 10: RHP **Melvin Adon**, LHP **Caleb Baragar**, 3B **Jonah Arenado**, 1B **Zach Houchins**, 2B **Jalen Miller** and OF **Jacob Heyward**. Six All-Stars ties the most in franchise history and is the most of any team in the Eastern League this season. Richmond's coaching staff, led by manager **Willie Harris**, will be the staff for the Western Division All-Stars in the Eastern League All-Star Game.

**A LITTLE RELIEF:** Over the last 15 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.10 ERA (13 ER/55.2 IP). On the season, Richmond's 3.94 bullpen ERA is the highest in the league. Since May 5, **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.17 ERA (3 ER/23.0 IP). In his last 14 outings since May 19, **Melvin Adon** has posted a 0.93 ERA (2 ER/19.1 IP) with nine walks and 25 strikeouts, and he has gone 6-for-7 in save attempts. **Chase Johnson** has a 0.69 ERA (1 ER/13.0 IP) in his last seven appearances since May 31. **Tyler Cyr** has worked six straight scoreless appearances since June 5, totaling 9.2 innings.

**STARTING OFF:** The Richmond starting rotation has a 3.67 ERA this season, which is fourth in the league. **Caleb Baragar** is 2-1 with a 2.86 ERA (14 ER/44.0 IP) over his last eight starts since May 19. **Brandon Lawson** has gone 1-2 with a 3.18 ERA (10 ER/28.1 IP) in his last five starts since May 28. **Garrett Williams** is 0-1 with a 1.80 ERA (4 ER/20.0 IP) in his last three starts dating back to June 6. **Alfred Gutierrez** is 4-1 with a 3.45 ERA (12 ER/31.1 IP) in his last six starts since May 26.

**OFFENSIVE OUTAGE:** Since June 9 in 15 games, the Richmond offense has combined to hit .170 (81-for-477) and scored 36 runs (2.4 runs per game). The Flying Squirrels have been held to three or less hits in five of the last 15 games. Richmond's .220 average on the season is the lowest in the league and would be the lowest in franchise history, trailing last year's .240 team average. The Eastern League has combined for a .236 batting average this year, which is the lowest of all full-season leagues in the minors. The league's average has dropped from last year's .253 average, which was the lowest since the Flying Squirrels joined the circuit in 2010.

**BRUSA BREAKING OUT:** Over the last 11 games since June 14, **Gio Brusa** has hit .342 (13-for-38) with five homers, five doubles and 11 RBIs. He homered in three games straight games from Thursday through Saturday and has four homers in his last six games. Before this stretch, Brusa went 0-for-15 in his previous five games from June 8-13. Brusa is now tied for first on the team with eight home runs this season. His nine-game hitting streak from June 14-23 was the longest on the team this year. Brusa was named Eastern League Player of the Week for June 17-23.

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 75 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 31 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. Over the last 18 games, the team has combined for 25 steals. The Flying Squirrels have stolen 32 bases in 24 games in the month of June. Fargas has 17 steals in his 23 games this month, and his season total of 31 is the fourth-most in a single season in franchise history.

**HITS FOR HOUCHINS:** Over his last 27 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .308 (32-for-104) with six homers, six doubles and 18 RBIs. He has hit 7-for-36 (.195) over his last nine games since June 16. On June 10, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 with four homers and 12 RBIs from June 3-9. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

**HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T:** The Flying Squirrels have hit 14 home runs at home this season through 37 games (0.38 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game). Richmond has one homer in each of the last three home games.

**FREQUENT FLYERS:** In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 37 homers on the road (T-1st in EL) in 37 games (1.00 per game - 1st in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game). The Flying Squirrels have hit 13 home runs at home this season through 35 games (0.37 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).

- Brandon Alan Beachy

- Attended Northwestern High School in Kokomo, Ind.

- Attended Indiana Wesleyan University, where he was a third

- Originally signed by the Braves as a non-drafted free agent in 2008

- Made MLB debut with Atlanta on Sept. 20, 2010

- In 2011, led Braves staff and ranked second among MLB rookies with 169 strikeouts, the most by a Braves rookie in modern-era franchise history at the time and 10.74 K/9 IP was fourth all-time among rookie starting pitchers (min. 25 starts) in MLB history behind Kerry Wood (1998), Dwight Gooden (1984) and Hideo Nomo (1995)

- Made 13 MLB starts in 2012 and went 5-5 with a 2.00 ERA (T-1st in MLB at time) and .171 BAA (1st in MLB) before being placed on DL on 6/16, undergoing Tommy John surgery on 6/21

- Had second Tommy John surgery in March 2014

- Signed with Dodgers for 2015 and made two MLB starts

- Limited to one appearance in AZL in 2016 with elbow injury

- Made only 25 total appearances from 2014-2017

- Spent 2018 season with independent New Britain Bees of the Atlantic League and made 12 appearances (2 starts), going 0-1 with a 3.55 ERA in 12.2 IP
