**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels avoided a sweep with a 6-2 win over the Altoona Curve at The Diamond. The Curve took a 1-0 lead in the first with an RBI single by Robbie Glendinning in the first to score Mitchell Tolman, and Glendinning drove in Tolman again with a single in the third to open a 2-0 lead. Altoona starter Cody Bolton worked through four scoreless innings in his Double-A debut before Richmond broke through in the fifth. In his Flying Squirrels debut, **Peter Maris** hit a pinch-hit single to get Richmond on the board. **Johneswy Fargas** gave the Flying Squirrels a 4-2 lead with a bases-clearing, three-run triple. **Jacob Heyward** brought in a run with a fielder's choice in the sixth and **Hamlet Marte** added an RBI single to extend the Flying Squirrels' lead to 6-2. **Brandon Beachy** worked 5.0 innings and allowed two runs to pick up his third win of the season.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the first of a four-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is also the fourth of a seven-game homestand against Altoona (1-2) and Hartford. The Yard Goats are playing their second and final series in Richmond this season. The Flying Squirrels opened the season against the Yard Goats and won the first three games before dropping the finale. Richmond dropped two of three in Hartford from April 15-17. The two teams meet for one more series, a three-game set in Hartford from July 15-17. The Flying Squirrels are 11-16 this season in games following a win and 4-5 on Thursdays.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 5-2 in the last seven games after losing nine of the previous ten games from June 8-19. Richmond won the final four games of the last road trip, their longest winning streak of the year, and swept Binghamton in three games to finish the trip, their first series sweep of the season. Over the last seven games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .207 (47-for-227) and the pitching staff has combined for a 2.57 ERA (18 ER/63.0 IP). Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .221 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.74 team ERA, which is ninth in the circuit. Richmond's -73 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -36).

**THE YARD GOATS** are 4-10 in their last 14 games since June 11 and dropped two of three in their last series at Bowie. Hartford is in a stretch of playing 21 straight games against Western Division opponents, and they are currently in the sixth of seven series in that span. For the season, the Yard Goats rank 11th in the league with a .221 team batting average. Hartford's pitching staff has combined for a 2.92 ERA this season, which is tops in the league. Hartford's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Colorado Rockies prospects, including Colton Welker (2), Tyler Nevin (6), Justin Lawrence (12), Reid Humphreys (17 - on IL), Vince Fernandez (24 - suspended) and Bret Boswell (25). Welker is also ranked as the No. 57 overall prospect and No. 6 third-base prospect in baseball. Hartford landed four players in the upcoming Eastern League All-Star Game, including Welker, Alan Trejo, Logan Cozart and Alexander Guillen.

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Brandon Lawson** makes his 12th start with the Flying Squirrels and his first against Hartford. Last time out, he allowed three runs over 6.0 innings in a loss at Trenton last Tuesday. He has worked at least 5.0 innings in eight of his last nine starts. Over his last five starts since May 28, Lawson has gone 1-2 with a 3.07 ERA (10 ER/29.1 IP). For the season, Lawson has the lowest swinging strike percentage (5.9%) and fourth-lowest strikeout percentage (12.6%) of all pitchers in the Eastern League with at least 50 innings pitched. Lawson was signed as a minor-league free agent by the Giants on April 23 after being released by the Tampa Bay Rays near the end of spring training. He was originally drafted by the Rays in the 12th round in 2016 out of the University of South Florida and reached Double-A for 14 outings (five starts) last season with the Montgomery Biscuits. **For more on Lawson, see page two.**

**FOR HARTFORD:** Right-hander Matt Dennis makes the second Double-A start of his career. In his Double-A debut on Saturday, Dennis pitched 4.0 innings and allowed one run in a no-decision against Altoona. He began the season with A-Adv. Lancaster and went 2-3 with a 5.60 ERA in seven starts and nine relief outings. Dennis was drafted by the Rockies in the 14th round in 2016 out of Bradley.

**SHINING STARTS:** Six members of the Flying Squirrels have been selected to represent Richmond in the Eastern League All-Star Game at The Diamond on Wednesday, July 10: RHP **Melvin Adon**, LHP **Caleb Baragar**, 3B **Jonah Arenado**, 1B **Zach Houchins**, 2B **Jalen Miller** and OF **Jacob Heyward**. Six All-Stars ties the most in franchise history and is the most of any team in the Eastern League this season. Richmond's coaching staff, led by manager **Willie Harris**, will be the staff for the Western Division All-Stars in the Eastern League All-Star Game.

**A LITTLE RELIEF:** Over the last 16 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 1.96 ERA (13 ER/59.2 IP). On the season, Richmond's 3.89 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. Since May 5, **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.17 ERA (3 ER/23.0 IP). In his last 14 outings since May 19, **Melvin Adon** has posted a 0.93 ERA (2 ER/19.1 IP) with nine walks and 25 strikeouts, and he has gone 6-for-7 in save attempts. **Chase Johnson** has a 0.69 ERA (1 ER/13.0 IP) in his last seven appearances since May 31. **Tyler Cyr** has worked six straight scoreless appearances since June 5, totaling 9.2 innings.

**STARTING OFF:** The Richmond starting rotation has a 3.67 ERA this season, which is fourth in the league. **Caleb Baragar** is 2-1 with a 2.86 ERA (14 ER/44.0 IP) over his last eight starts since May 19. **Brandon Lawson** has gone 1-2 with a 3.18 ERA (10 ER/28.1 IP) in his last five starts since May 28. **Garrett Williams** is 0-1 with a 1.80 ERA (4 ER/20.0 IP) in his last three starts dating back to June 6. **Alfred Gutierrez** is 4-1 with a 3.45 ERA (12 ER/31.1 IP) in his last six starts since May 26. **Brandon Beachy** is 2-0 with a 2.46 ERA (3 ER/11.0 IP) in his last two starts since June 21.

**OFFENSIVE OUTAGE:** Since June 9 in 16 games, the Richmond offense has combined to hit .174 (88-for-507) and scored 42 runs (2.6 runs per game). The Flying Squirrels have been held to three or less hits in five of the last 16 games. Richmond's .221 average on the season is the lowest in the league and would be the lowest in franchise history, trailing last year's .240 team average.

**BRUSA BREAKING OUT:** Over the last 11 games since June 14, **Gio Brusa** has hit .342 (13-for-38) with five homers, five doubles and 11 RBIs. He homered in three games straight games from Thursday through Saturday and has four homers in his last six games. Before this stretch, Brusa went 0-for-15 in his previous five games from June 8-13. Brusa is now tied for first on the team with eight home runs this season. His nine-game hitting streak from June 14-23 was the longest on the team this year. Brusa was named Eastern League Player of the Week for June 17-23.

**GRAND LARCENY:** This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 76 stolen bases. **Johneswy Fargas** leads the league with 31 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. Over the last 19 games, the team has combined for 26 steals. The Flying Squirrels have stolen 33 bases in 25 games in the month of June. Fargas has 17 steals in his 24 games this month, and his season total of 31 is the fourth-most in a single season in franchise history.

**HITS FOR HOUCHINS:** Over his last 28 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .306 (33-for-108) with six homers, six doubles and 18 RBIs. He has hit 9-for-39 (.231) over his last ten games since June 16. On June 10, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 with four homers and 12 RBIs from June 3-9. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

**HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T:** The Flying Squirrels have hit 14 home runs at home this season through 38 games (0.37 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game). Richmond has one homer in each of the last three home games.

**FREQUENT FLYERS:** In 2019, the Flying Squirrels have hit 37 homers on the road (T-1st in EL) in 37 games (1.00 per game - 1st in EL). Last year, the Flying Squirrels hit 59 homers in 70 road games (0.84 per game), which is the second-highest for a season in team history behind the 2013 season (63 HR/71 Road Games/0.88 per game). The Flying Squirrels have hit 13 home runs at home this season through 35 games (0.37 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), left-handed pitcher **Conner Menez** (25) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20) and Miller (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).

### THIS DATE IN HISTORY
