YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels evened the series with a 3-2 win over the Hartford Yard Goats. In the second inning, Hartford scored the game's first run with a sac fly by Bret Boswell. The Flying Squirrels tied the score in the third with an RBI single by Johneshwy Fargas. In the sixth, Fargas put Richmond ahead with an RBI double and Zach Houchins opened the lead to 3-1 with an RBI single. Hartford scored a run in the ninth with an RBI single by Mylz Jones, but Melvin Adon closed out his team-leading tenth save. Alfred Gutierrez allowed one run over a season-high six innings of work for his fifth win of the year.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a four-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is also the sixth of a seven-game homestand against Altoona (1-2) and Hartford (1-1). The Yard Goats are playing their second and final series in Richmond this season. The Flying Squirrels opened the season against the Yard Goats and won the first three games before dropping the finale. Richmond dropped two of three in Hartford from April 15-17. The two teams meet for one more series, a three-game set in Hartford from July 15-17.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 6-3 in the last nine games after losing nine of the previous ten games from June 8-19. Richmond won the final four games of the last road trip, their longest winning streak of the year, and swept Binghamton in three games to finish the trip, their first series sweep of the season. Over the last nine games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .224 (66-for-295) and the pitching staff has combined for a 2.74 ERA (25 ER/82.0 IP). Overall this season, the Richmond offense ranks last in the league with a .222 batting average. The pitching staff has combined for a 3.73 team ERA, which is tenth in the circuit. Richmond's -73 run differential is last in the league (next closest is Portland at -42).

THE YARD GOATS are 5-11 in their last 16 games since June 11 and dropped two of three in their last series at Bowie. Hartford is in a stretch of playing 21 straight games against Western Division opponents, and they are currently in the sixth of seven series in that span. For the season, the Yard Goats rank tied for tenth in the league with a .226 team batting average. Hartford's pitching staff has combined for a 2.94 ERA this season, which is tops in the league. Hartford's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Colorado Rockies prospects, including Colton Welker (2), Tyler Nevin (6), Justin Lawrence (12), Reid Humphreys (17 - on IL), Vince Fernandez (24 - suspended) and Bret Boswell (25). Welker is also ranked as the No. 57 overall prospect and No. 6 third-base prospect in baseball. Hartford landed four players in the upcoming Eastern League All-Star Game, including Welker, Alan Trejo, Logan Cozart and Alexander Guillen.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Garrett Williams** takes the mound for his 15th start of the season for the Flying Squirrels and his second against Hartford. Last time out, Williams pitched five scoreless innings and allowed one hit on Sunday in a win at Binghamton. Over his last four starts since June 6, Williams has gone 0-1 with a 1.80 ERA (4 ER/20.0 IP) and has thrown three scoreless outings. He faced Hartford in his season debut on April 6 and pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in a no-decision. On the year, Williams has pitched five scoreless starts. In 2018, he only had one start in which he did not allow a run. He made 14 starts for Richmond last season and went 2-6 with a 6.00 ERA before moving to the bullpen when the calendar turned to July. As a reliever, he posted a 5.96 ERA in 18 appearances. Williams is ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 21 Giants prospect and No. 20 by MLB.com. **For more on Williams, see page two.**

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander Brandon Gold makes his 16th start of the season for the Yard Goats and his third against the Flying Squirrels. In his most recent start, he worked a season-high 6.1 innings and allowed two runs on 10 hits in a win at Bowie on Monday. He faced the Flying Squirrels on April 6 and pitched five scoreless innings in a no-decision at The Diamond and again on April 16 in Hartford, allowing three runs over six innings in a win. Gold was drafted in the 12th round in 2016 by the Rockies out of Georgia Tech.

SHINING STARTS: Six members of the Flying Squirrels have been selected to represent Richmond in the Eastern League All-Star Game at The Diamond on Wednesday, July 10: RHP **Melvin Adon**, LHP **Caleb Baragar**, 3B **Jonah Arenado**, 1B **Zach Houchins**, 2B **Jalen Miller** and OF **Jacob Heyward**. Six All-Stars ties the most in franchise history and is the most of any team in the Eastern League this season. Richmond's coaching staff, led by manager **Willie Harris**, will be the staff for the Western Division All-Stars in the Eastern League All-Star Game.

A LITTLE RELIEF: Over the last 18 games since June 9, the Richmond bullpen has combined to post a 2.16 ERA (16 ER/66.2 IP). On the season, Richmond's 3.89 bullpen ERA is the second-highest in the league. Since May 5, **Ryan Halstead** has gone 1-2 with a 1.17 ERA (3 ER/23.0 IP). In his last 14 outings since May 19, **Melvin Adon** has posted a 1.33 ERA (3 ER/20.1 IP) with nine walks and 27 strikeouts, and he has gone 7-for-8 in save attempts. **Chase Johnson** has a 0.69 ERA (1 ER/13.0 IP) in his last seven appearances since May 31. **Tyler Cyr** has a 1.58 ERA (2 ER/11.1 IP) in his last seven appearances since June 5.

STARTING OFF: The Richmond starting rotation has a 3.64 ERA this season, which is fourth in the league. **Caleb Baragar** is 2-1 with a 2.86 ERA (14 ER/44.0 IP) over his last eight starts since May 19. **Brandon Lawson** has gone 1-2 with a 3.41 ERA (13 ER/34.1 IP) in his last six starts since May 28. **Garrett Williams** is 0-1 with a 1.80 ERA (4 ER/20.0 IP) in his last three starts dating back to June 6. **Alfred Gutierrez** is 5-1 with a 3.13 ERA (13 ER/37.1 IP) in his last seven starts since May 26. **Brandon Beachy** is 2-0 with a 2.46 ERA (3 ER/11.0 IP) in his last two starts since June 21.

TROUBLE AT HOME: Since May 22, the Flying Squirrels have gone 3-13 in the last 16 home games at The Diamond. In that same time frame, the Flying Squirrels have gone 11-9 in road games. Richmond has lost five consecutive home series dating back to a four-game split against Akron from May 16-19. They lost the previous four home series from April 18-May 8. The only home series win for the Flying Squirrels was the first one of the season, when they won three-of-four against Hartford from April 4-7.

THE NEW GUYS: On Tuesday, **Bryce Johnson** and **Peter Maris** were assigned to the Flying Squirrels from A-Adv. San Jose. After going 0-for-4 in his Double-A debut on Wednesday, Johnson has hit .556 (5-for-9) with a homer, a triple, a double and a RBI in his last two games. Maris collected a pinch-hit RBI single in his Flying Squirrels debut on Wednesday and added a clutch RBI single on Friday night.

BRUSA BREAKING OUT: Over the last 12 games since June 14, **Gio Brusa** has hit .333 (14-for-42) with five homers, five doubles and 12 RBIs. He homered in three games straight games from June 20-23 and has four homers in his last seven games. Before this stretch, Brusa went 0-for-15 in his previous five games from June 8-13. Brusa is now second on the team with eight home runs this season. His nine-game hitting streak from June 14-23 was the longest on the team this year. Brusa was named Eastern League Player of the Week for June 17-23.

GRAND LARCENY: This season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Eastern League with 79 stolen bases. **Johneshwy Fargas** leads the league with 33 steals this year, followed by **Jalen Miller** with 18. Over the last 21 games, the team has combined for 29 steals. The Flying Squirrels have stolen 36 bases in 27 games in the month of June. Fargas has 19 steals in his 26 games this month, and his season total of 33 is tied for fourth-most in a single season in franchise history.

HITS FOR HOUCHINS: Over his last 30 games since May 29, **Zach Houchins** has hit .313 (36-for-115) with six homers, six doubles and 20 RBIs. He has multiple hits in four of his last eight games since June 21 and his 15 multi-hit games with Richmond are tied for first on the team. On June 10, Houchins was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .423 with four homers and 12 RBIs from June 3-9. He began the season in the Angels organization with Double-A Mobile, but was released on May 8. In his first nine games with the Flying Squirrels, Houchins hit .097 (3-for-31).

HOME IS WHERE THE HOMERS AREN'T: The Flying Squirrels have hit 16 home runs at home this season through 40 games (0.40 per game), down from last year's pace of 0.55 homers per home game (38 HR/69 Home Games). The Flying Squirrels have ranked last in the league in home runs hit at home each of the last two seasons and three of the last four years. Entering 2019, the Flying Squirrels averaged 0.49 home runs per home game for the franchise's first nine seasons. The lowest single-season home homer rate was in 2015 (20 HR/71 Home Games/0.28 per game). Richmond has one homer in each of the last three home games.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels' roster features six of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including right-handed pitcher **Logan Webb** (6), right-handed pitcher **Melvin Adon** (12), outfielder **Heath Quinn** (15), left-handed pitcher **Garrett Williams** (21), infielder **Ryan Howard** (24) and infielder **Jalen Miller** (30). Six players are also on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects, including Webb (5), Quinn (13), Adon (15), Williams (20), Howard (27), Miller (28) and **Jacob Heyward** (30).
